



Insurance Coverage, by Race and EthnicityPercent




Delayed Medical Care due to Cost





Dental Care in the Past Year, by Race/Ethnicity Percent





Avoidable Hospitalizations


Avoidable Emergency Department Visits




Primary Care Physicians Rate per 10,000 Population


Nurse Practitioners

















Opioid Prescriptions Dispensed








Adults Who Experienced 14 or More Poor Mental Health Days in the Past Month, by Sex


Depression Among Adults, by Sex







Rate per 100,000 females




New Cases of Female Breast Cancer, by Race/Ethnicity Rate per 100,000 females


New Cases of Cancer Among Males




Stroke Deaths, by Sex and Race/Ethnicity





Leading Causes of Premature Death Before Age 75, by Race/Ethnicity










Households Receiving Food Stamps/SNAP, by Race/Ethnicity






Population With a Disability, by Age Group *Percent*


Population With a Disability, by Type









Educational Attainment Among Those 25+






On-Time Graduation Rate Percent






COVID-19 Deaths, by Race/Ethnicity

Complete Primary Series of COVID-19 Vaccine, by Age Group *Percent*





Chronic Hepatitis C, by County







People living with HIV/AIDS (Prevalence), by Race/Ethnicity



Continuum of Care Status





New Gonorrhea Infections, by Age Group (Incidence)





Overall Injury Deaths, by County











Rate per 100,000 population




Homicides, by Age Group








Suicides, by County

Suicides, by Age Group




Suicides in Spartanburg County, by Race and Sex Rate per 100,000 population





Infant deaths per 1,000 live births














Teen Births, by Race/Ethnicity
















Breastfeeding Initiation, by Race and Ethnicity
