



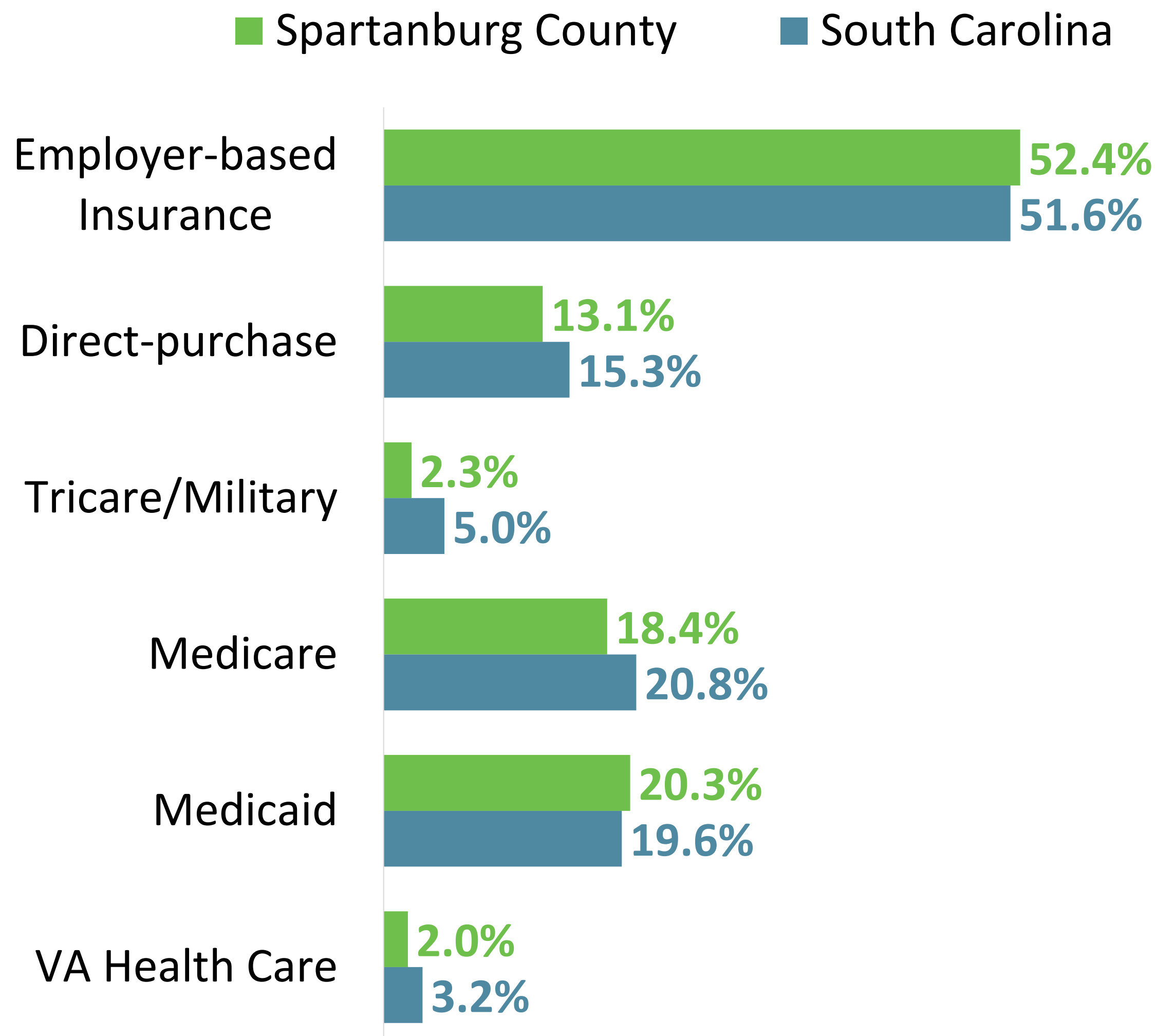

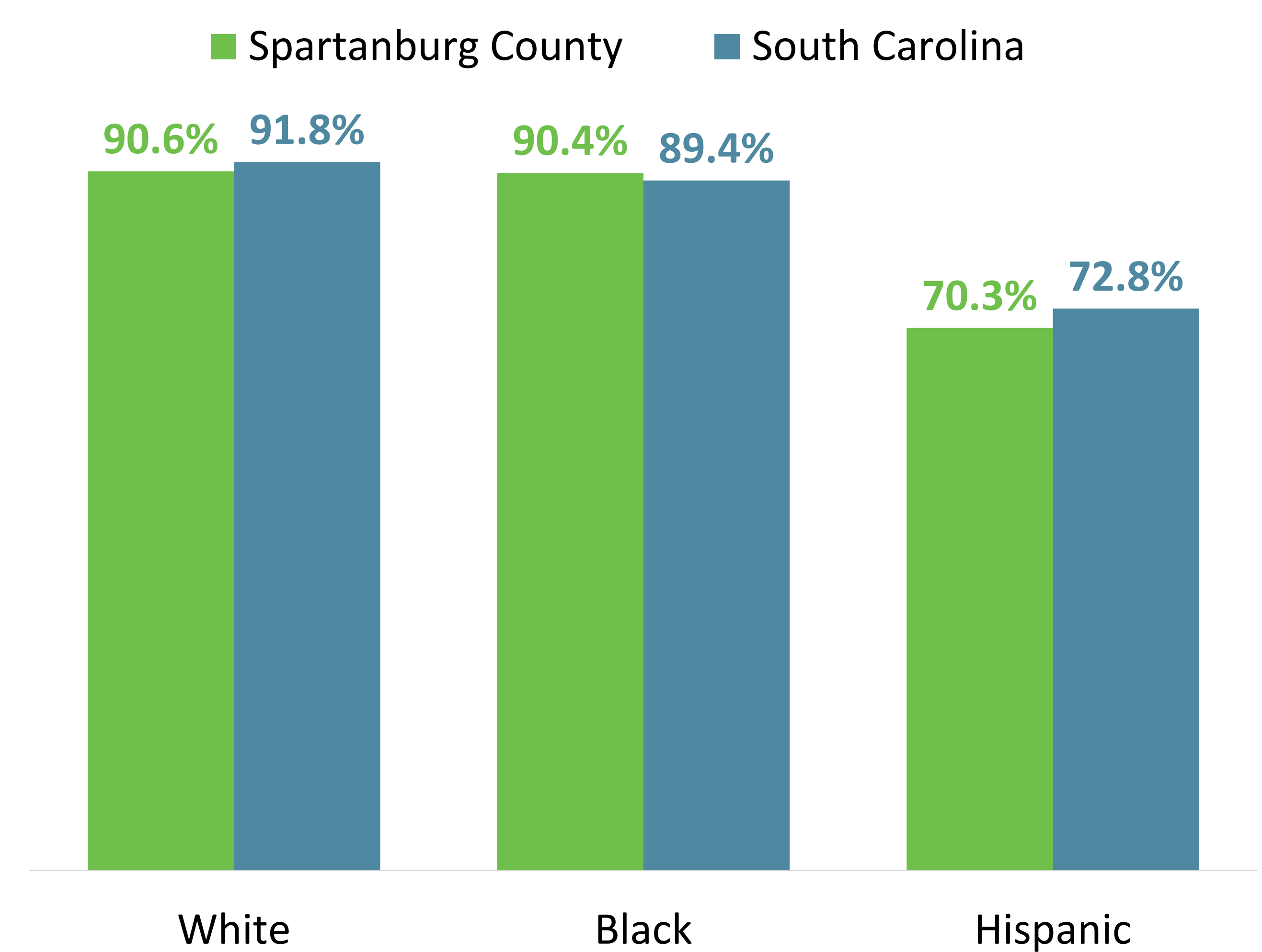

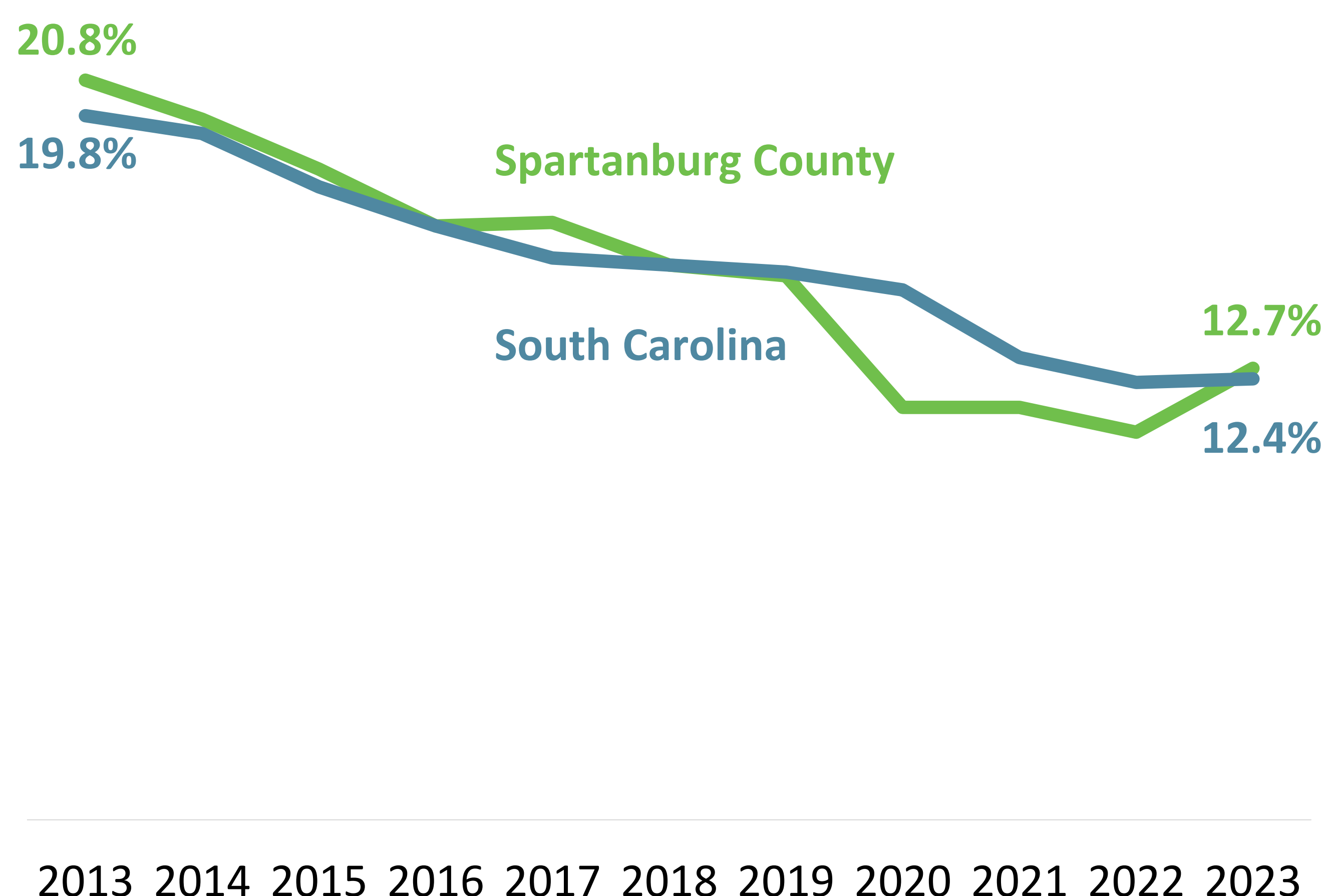

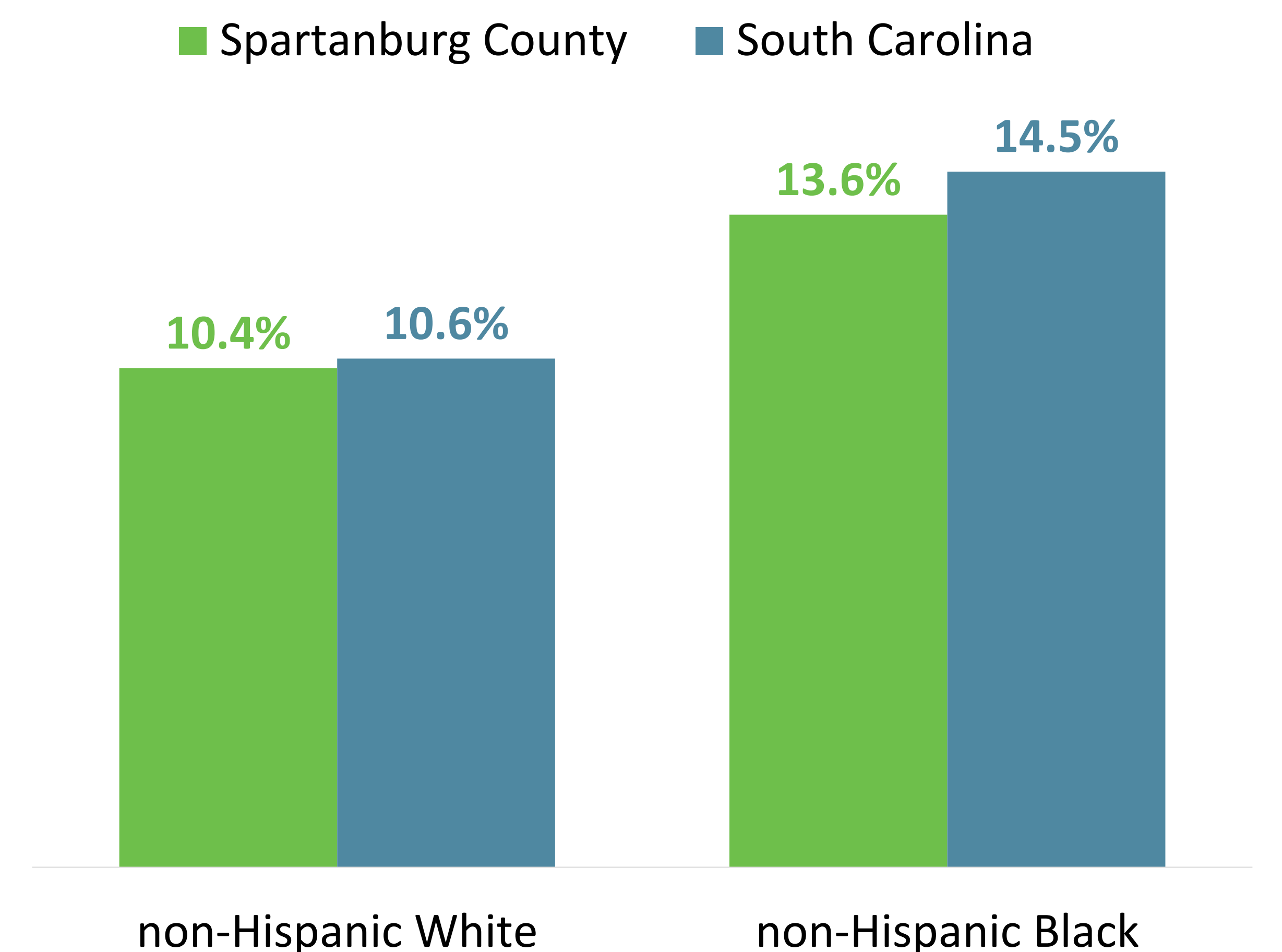

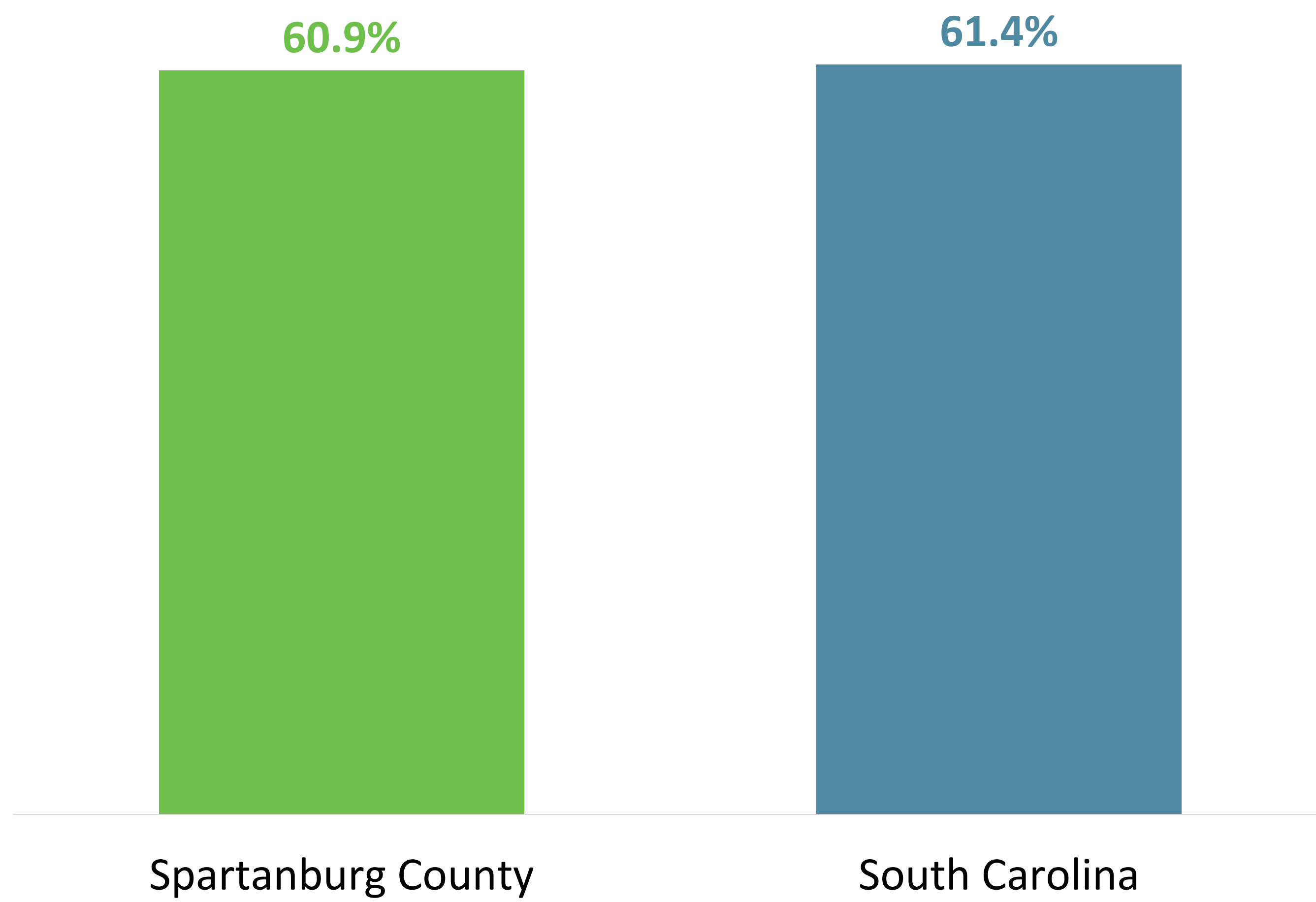

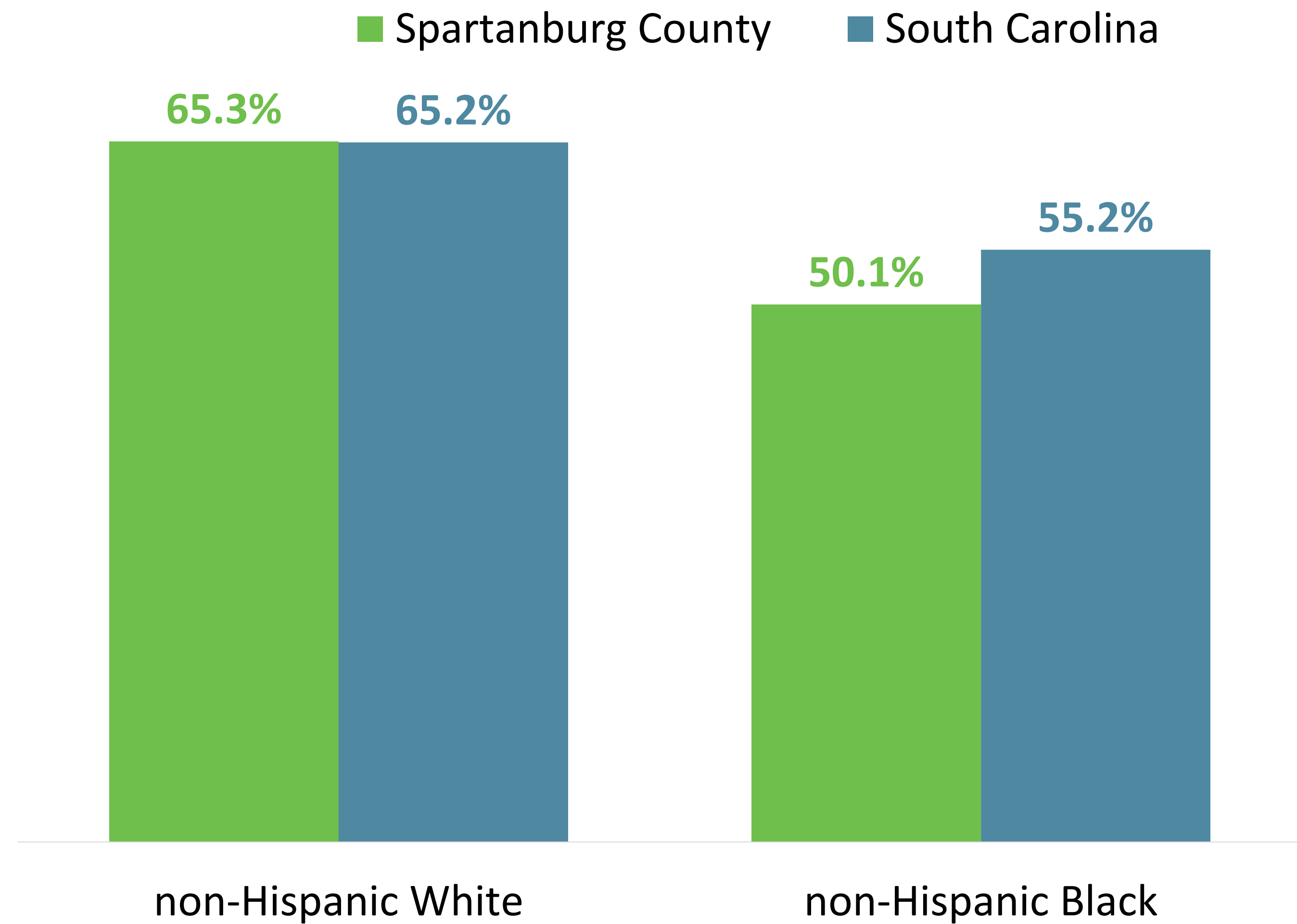

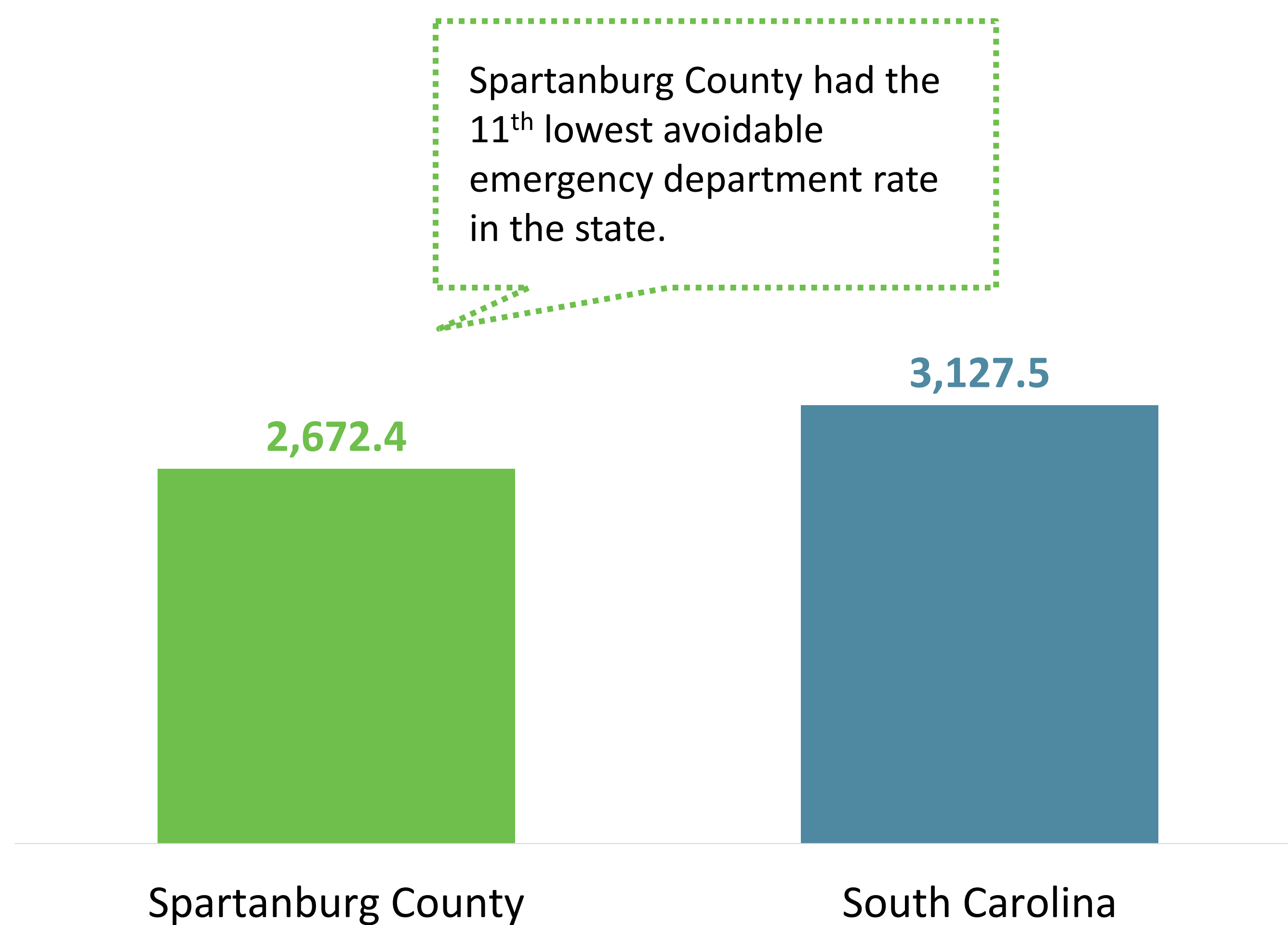
Dental Care in the Past Year, by Race/Ethnicity

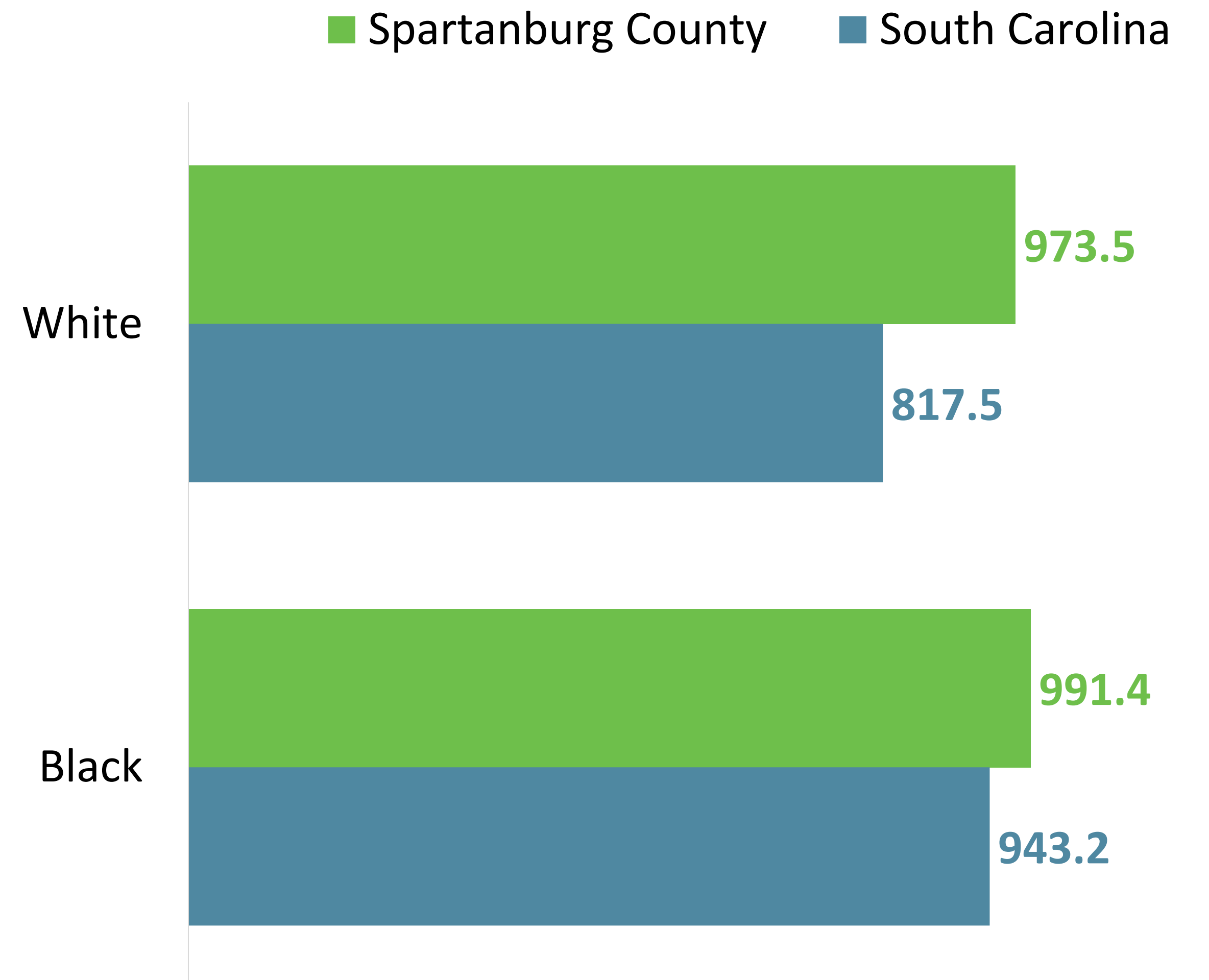
Avoidable Hospitalizations

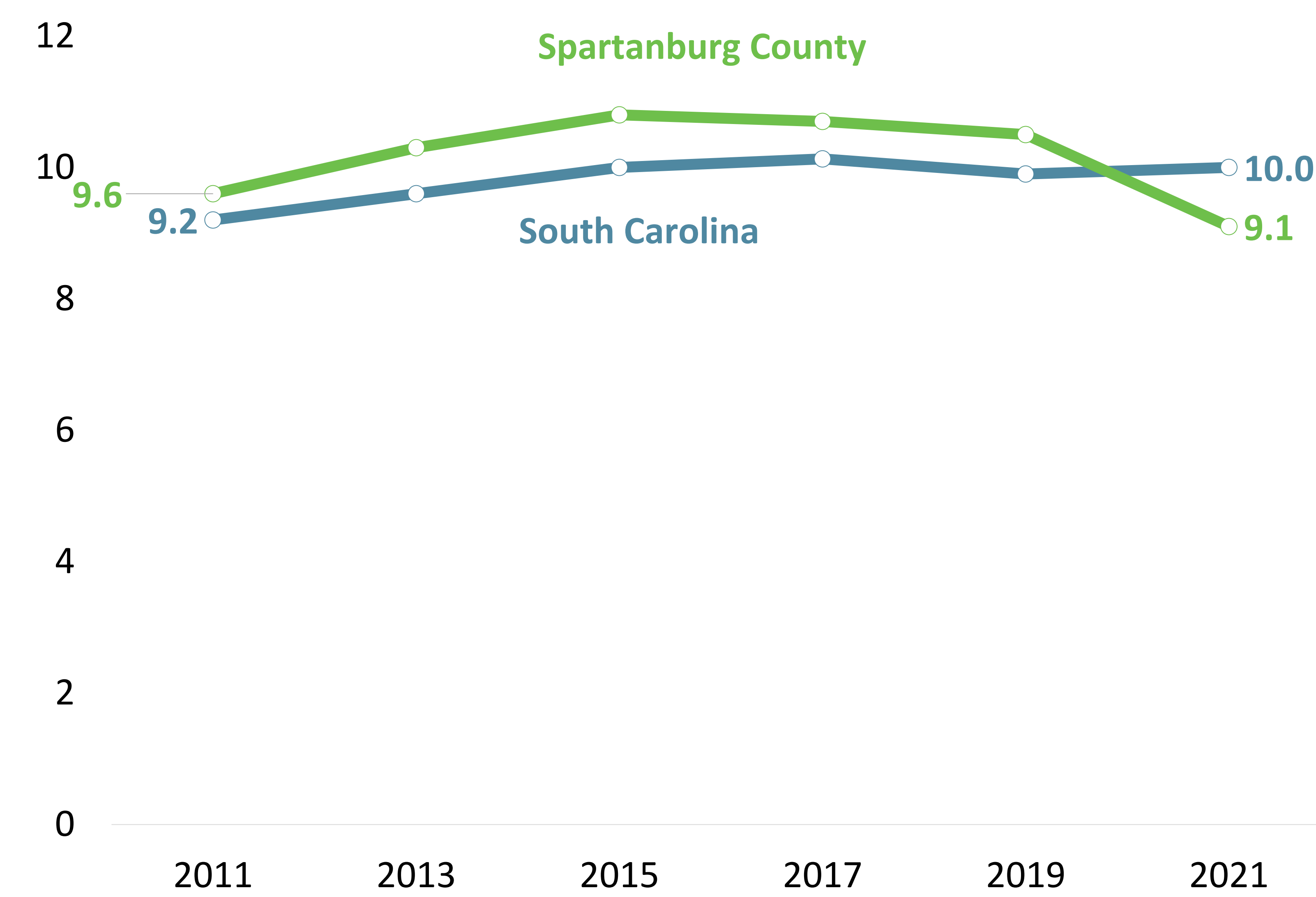

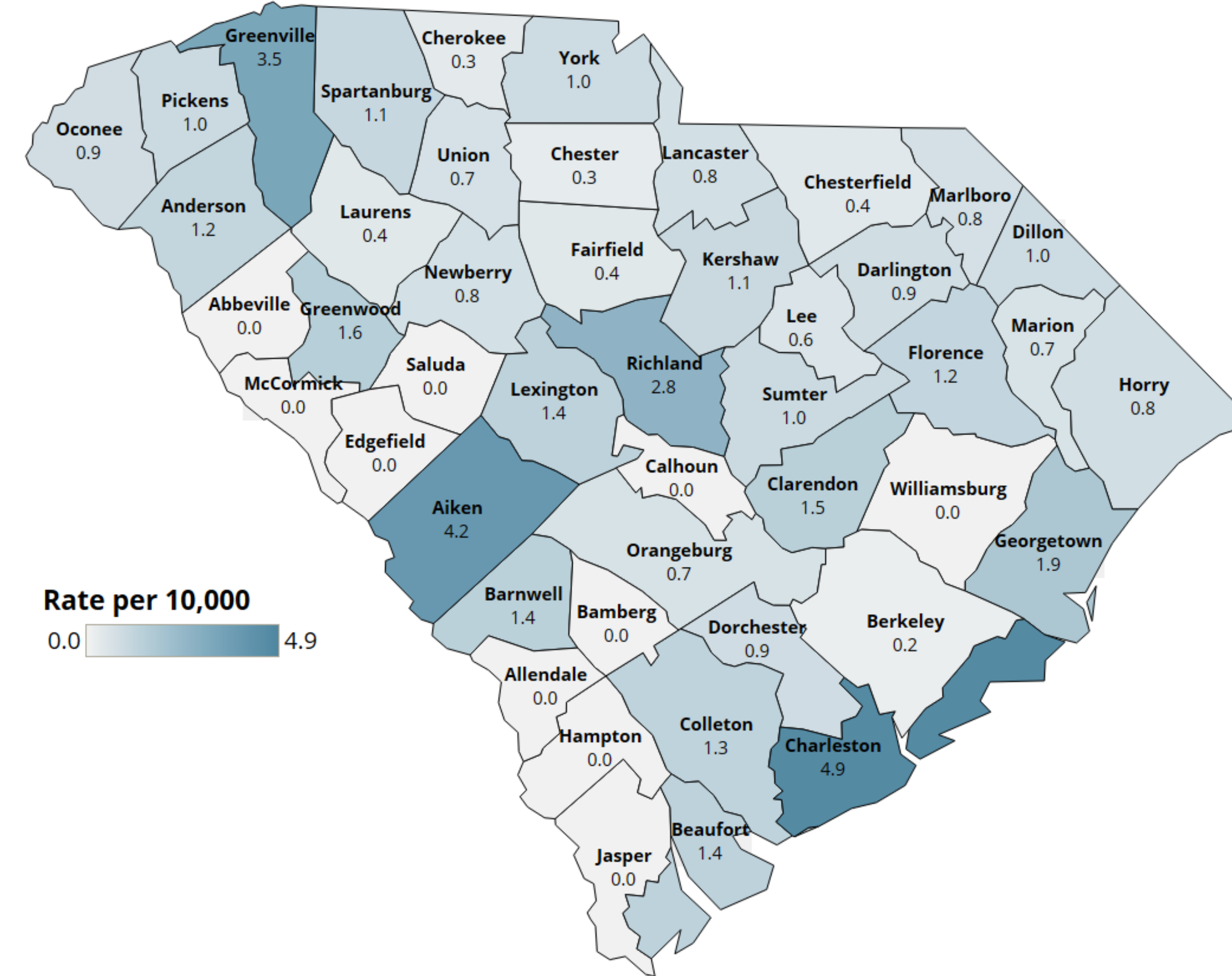

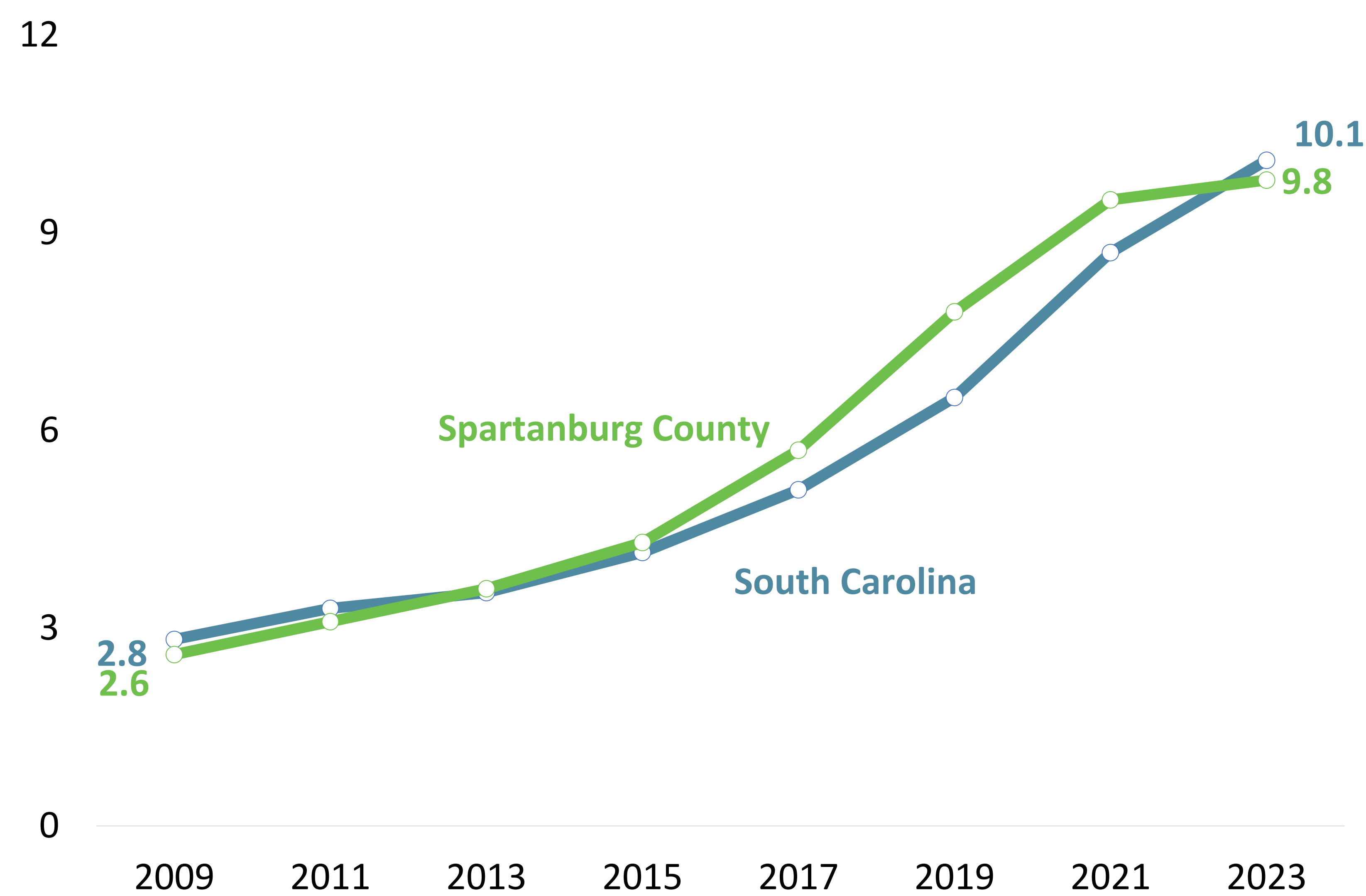

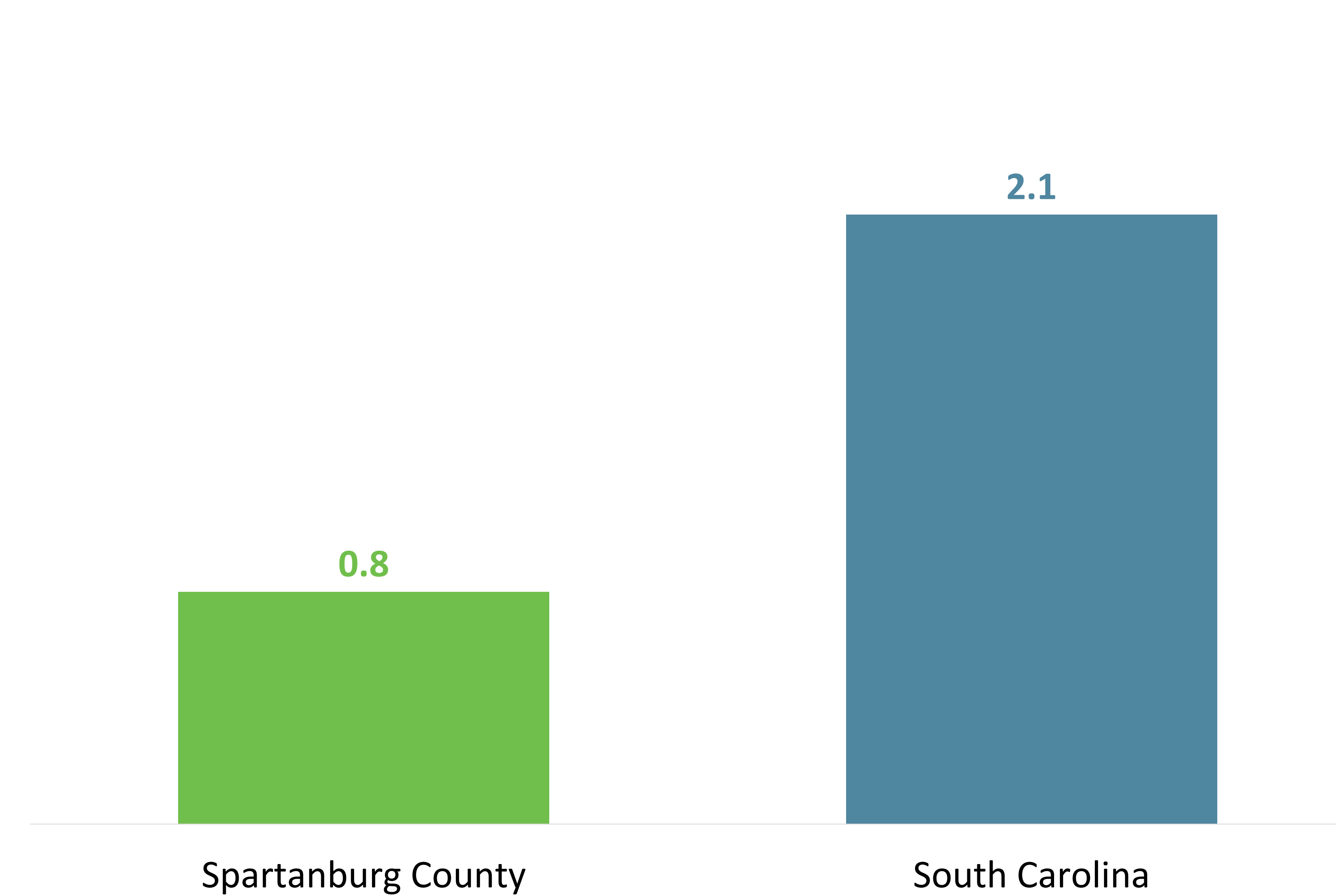

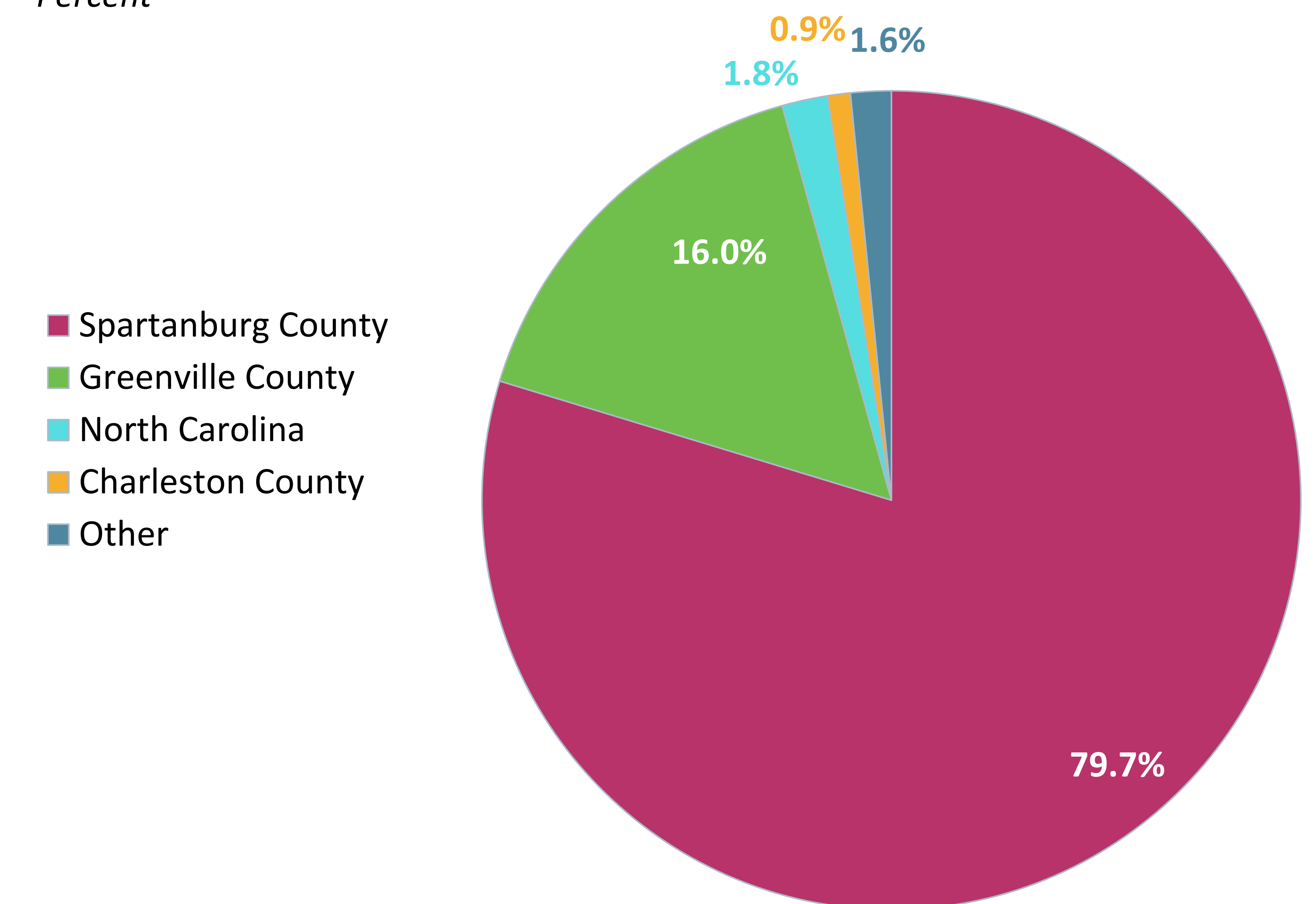

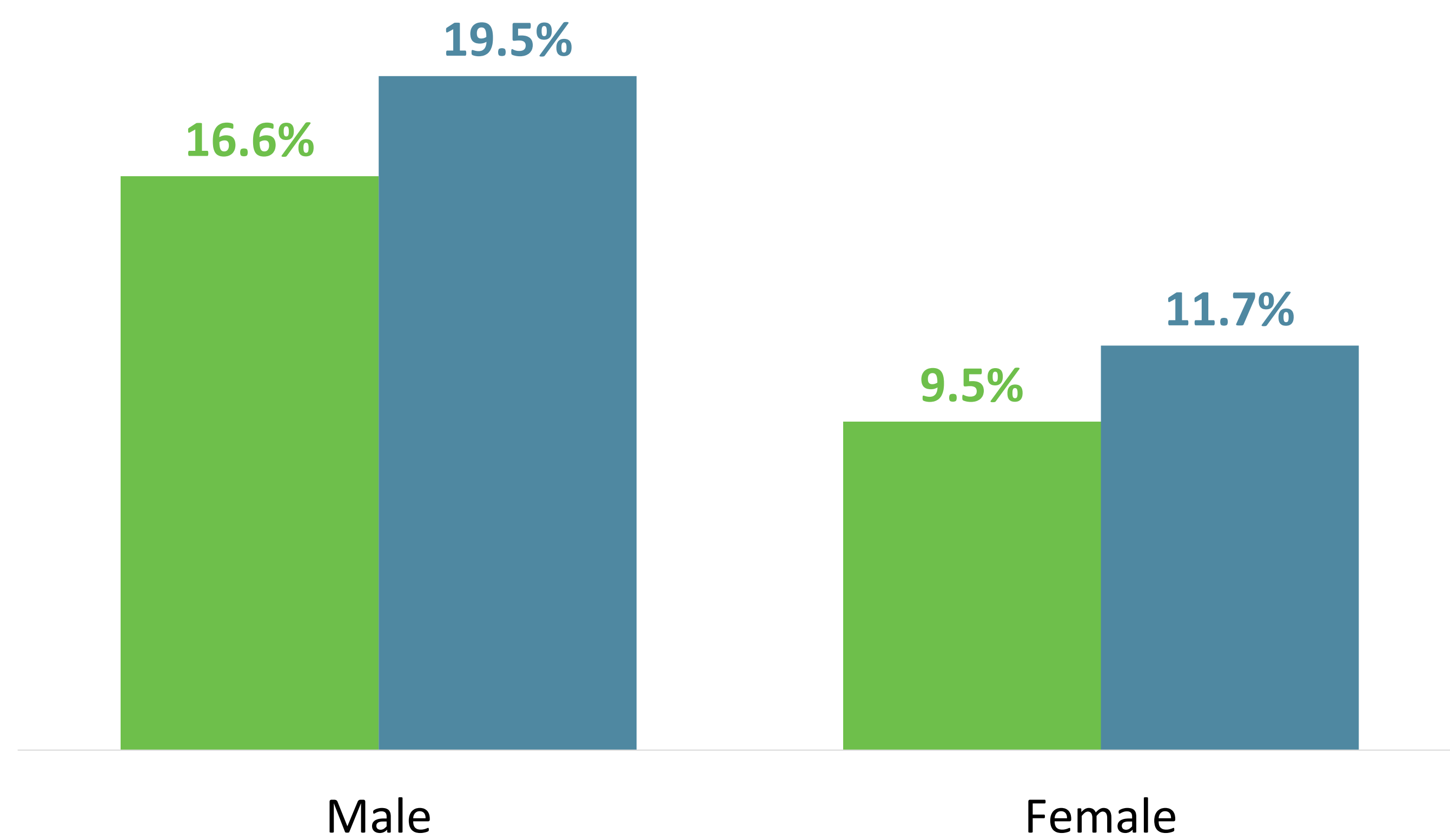

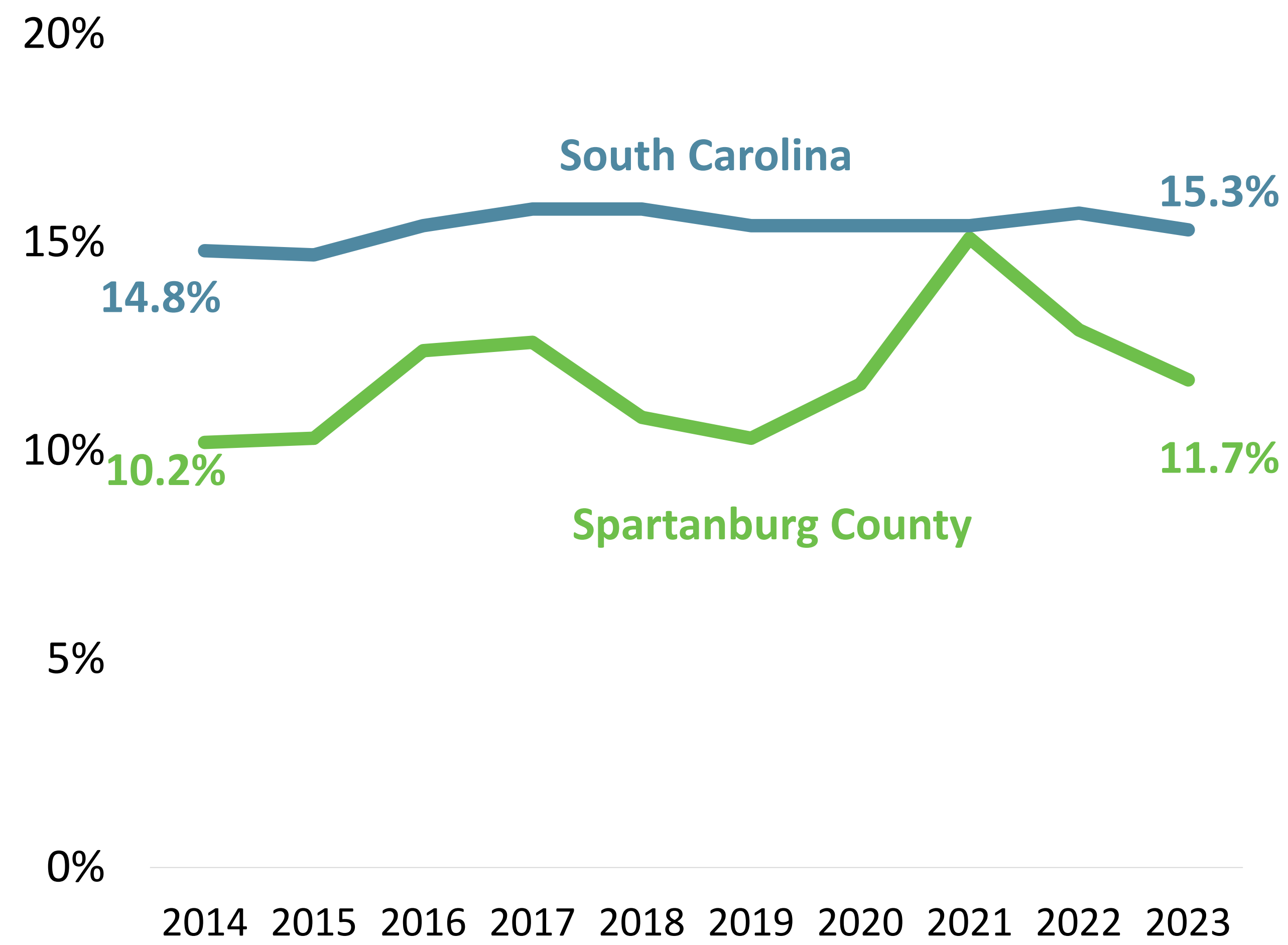

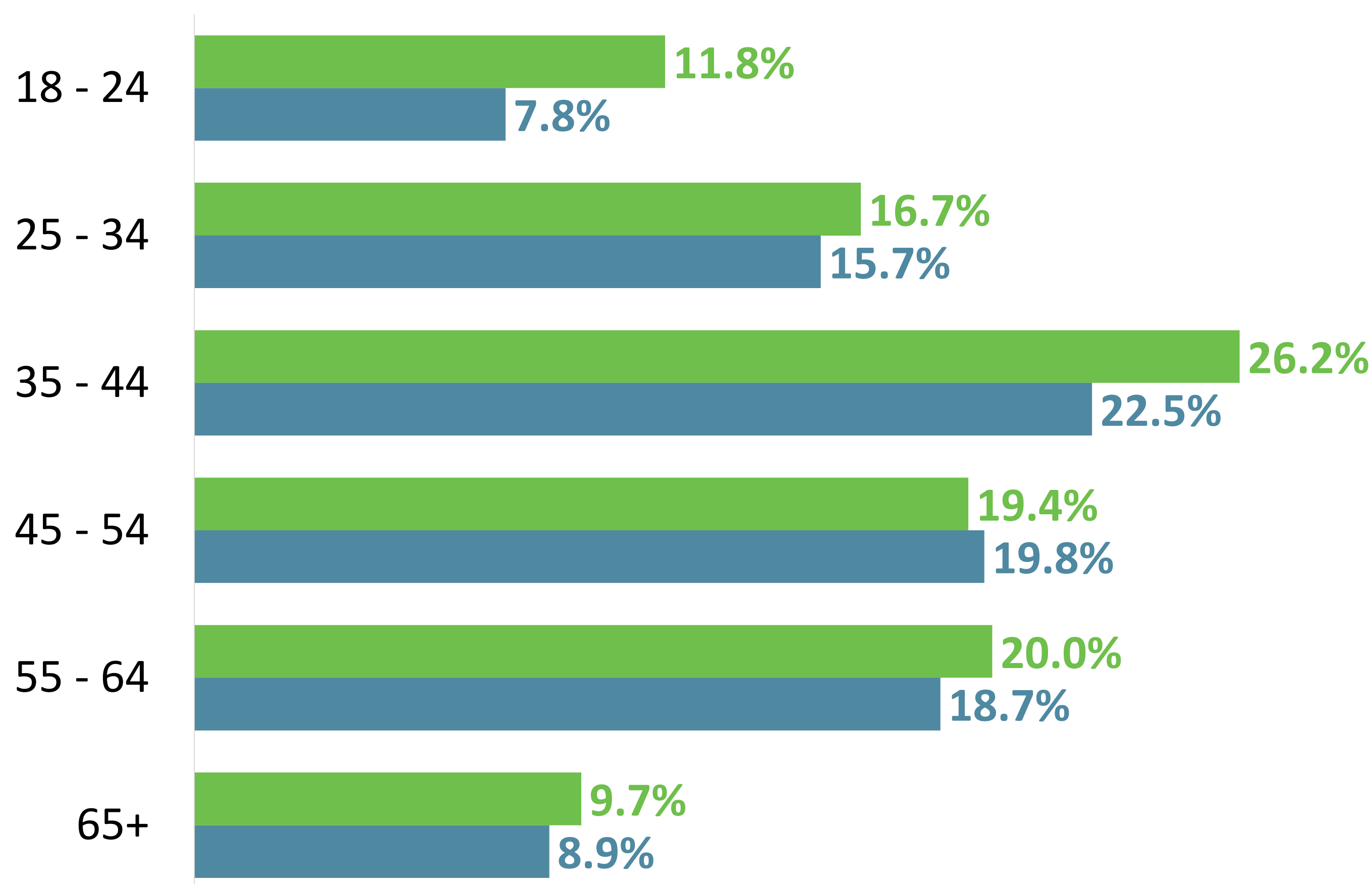

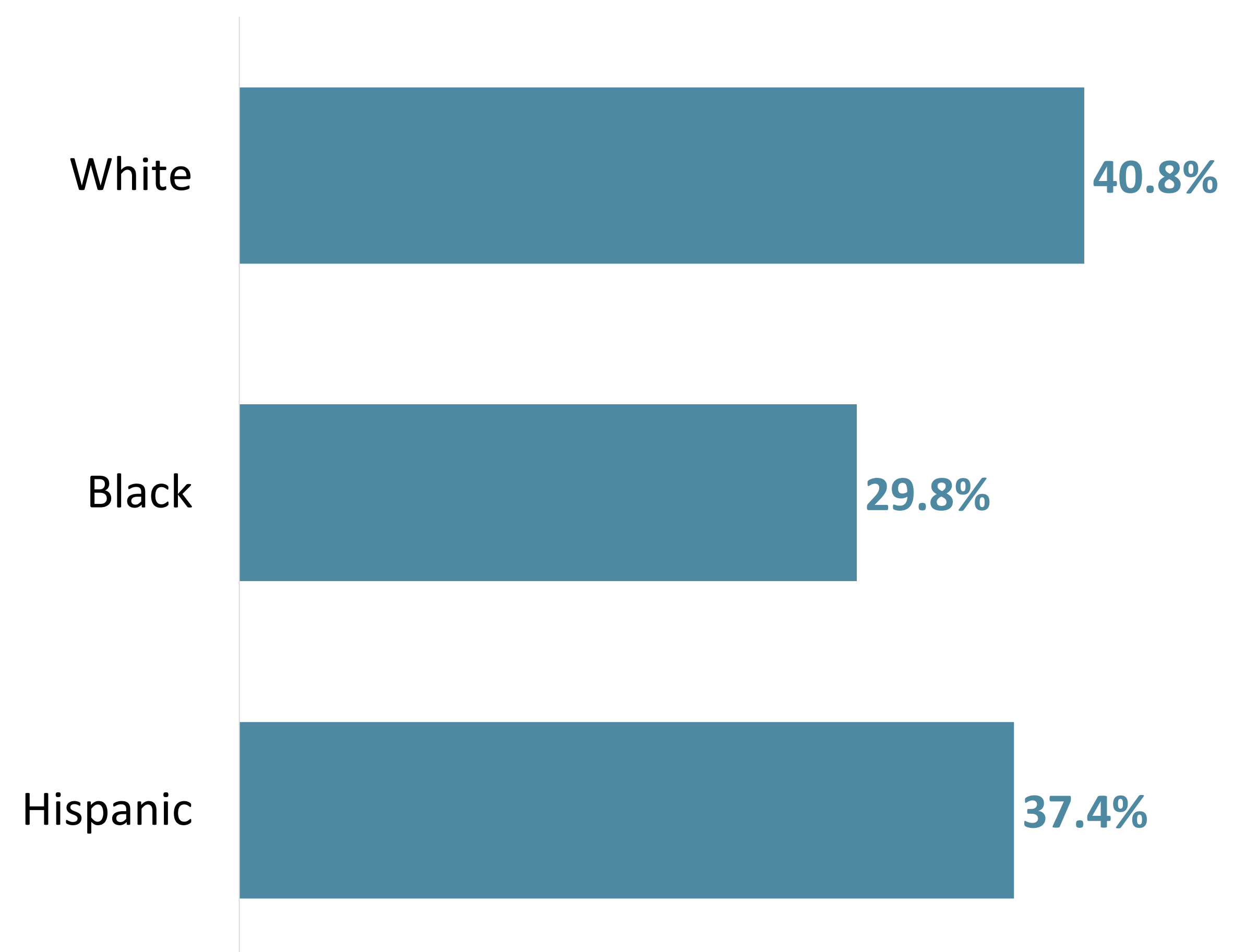

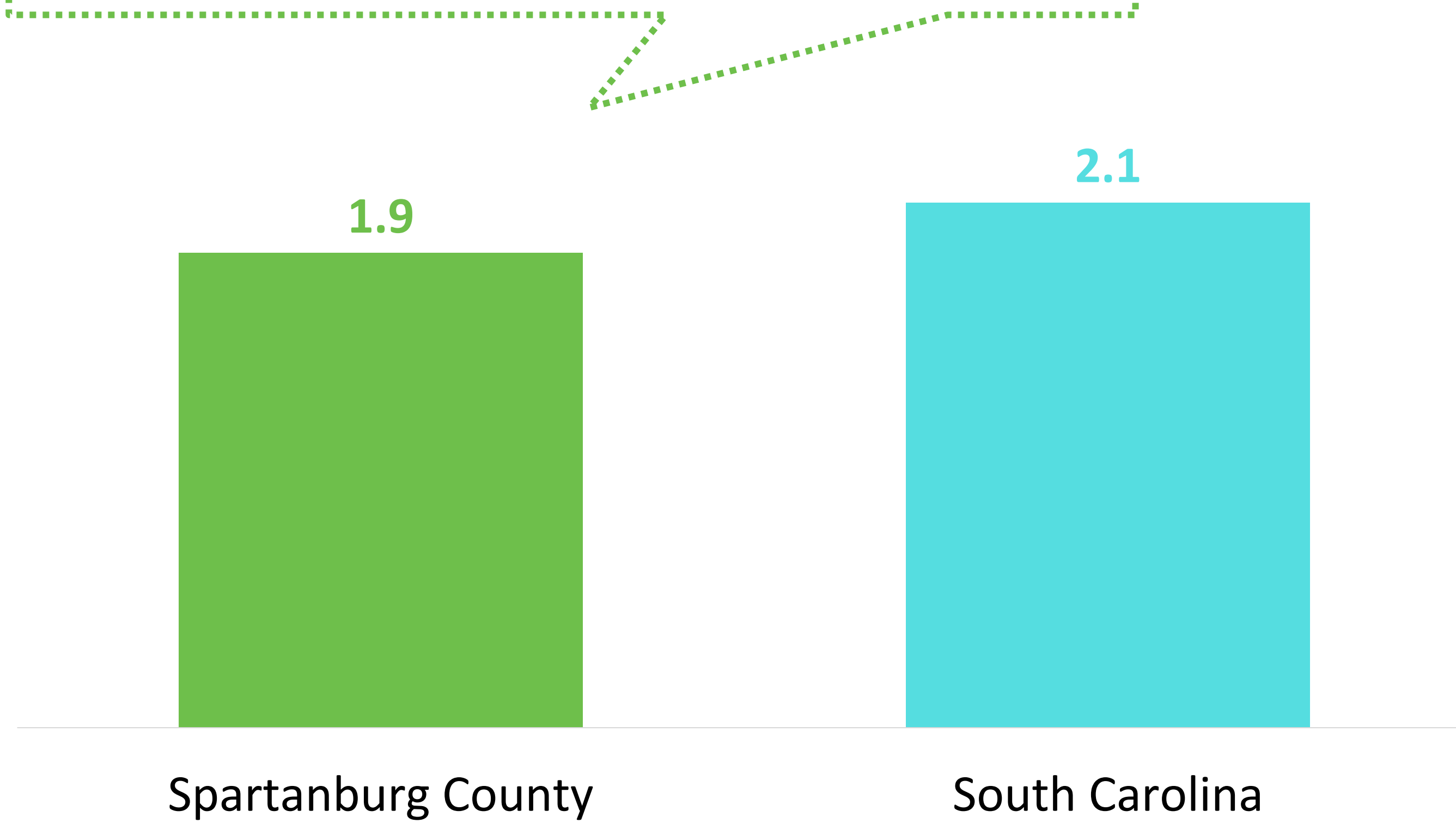

In 2023, Spartanburg County had the **19th lowest** rate of Naloxone administrations in the state with 671 doses being administered by EMS personnel.

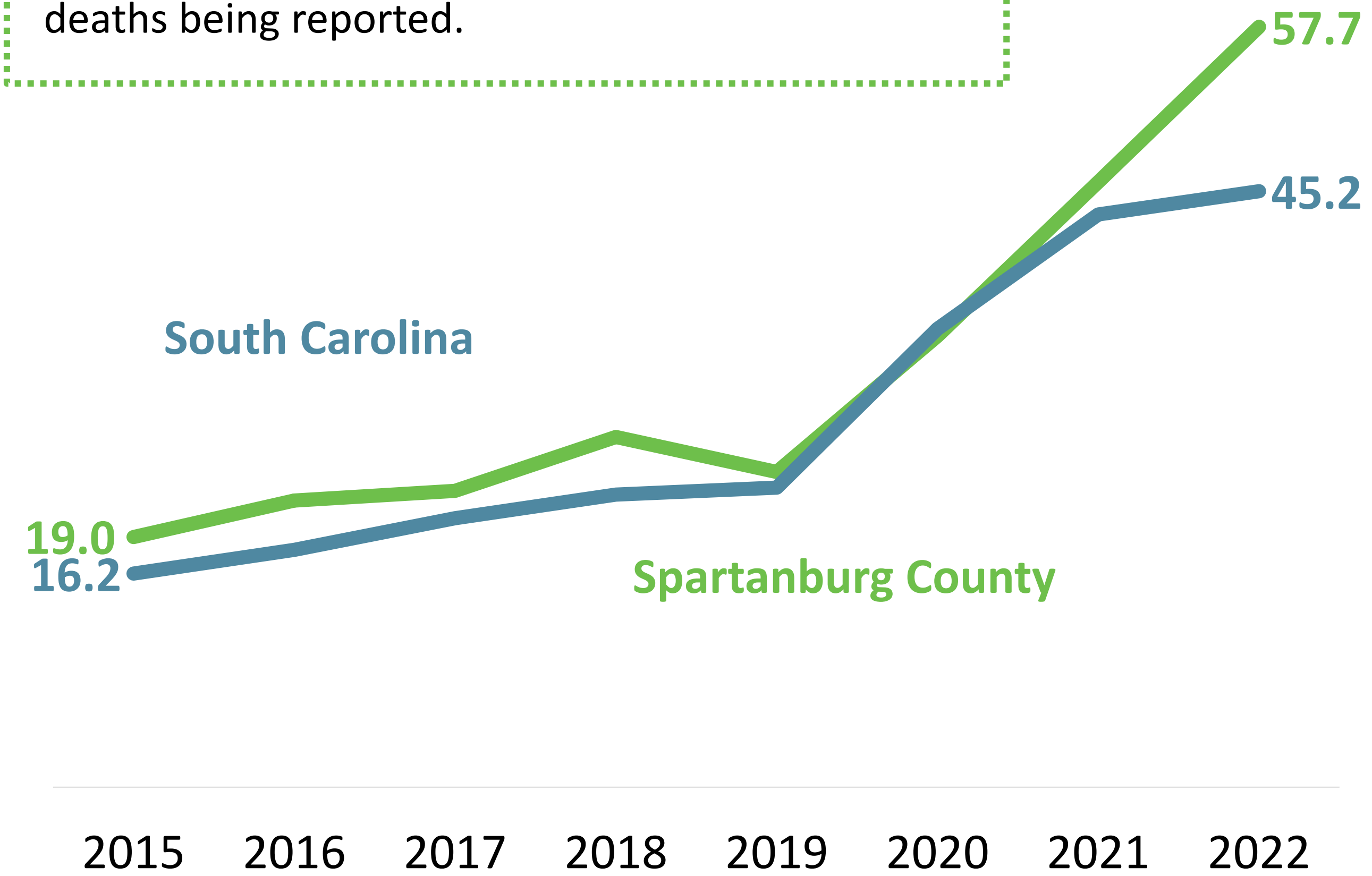

Rate per 100,000 population

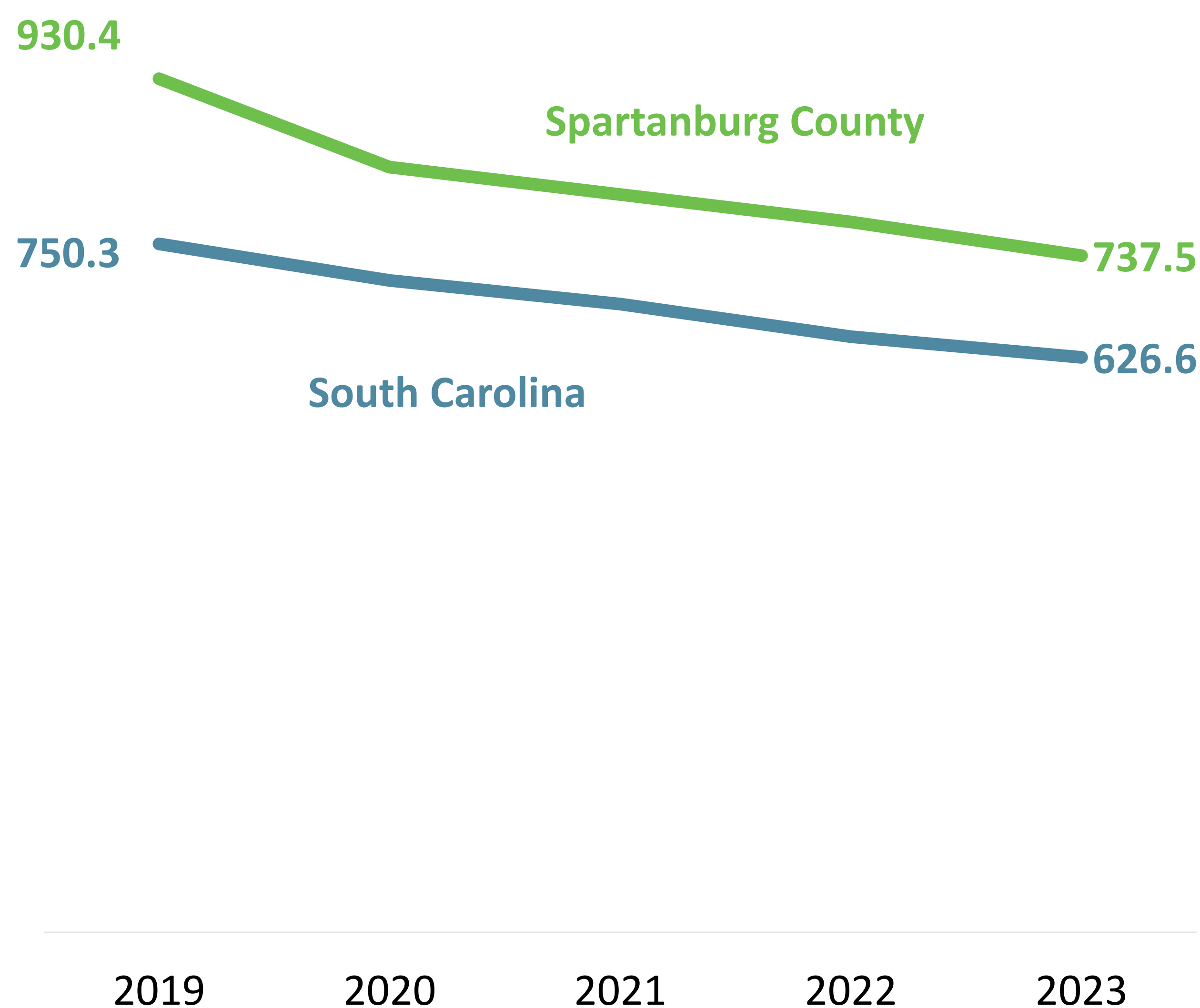

Opioid Prescriptions Dispensed

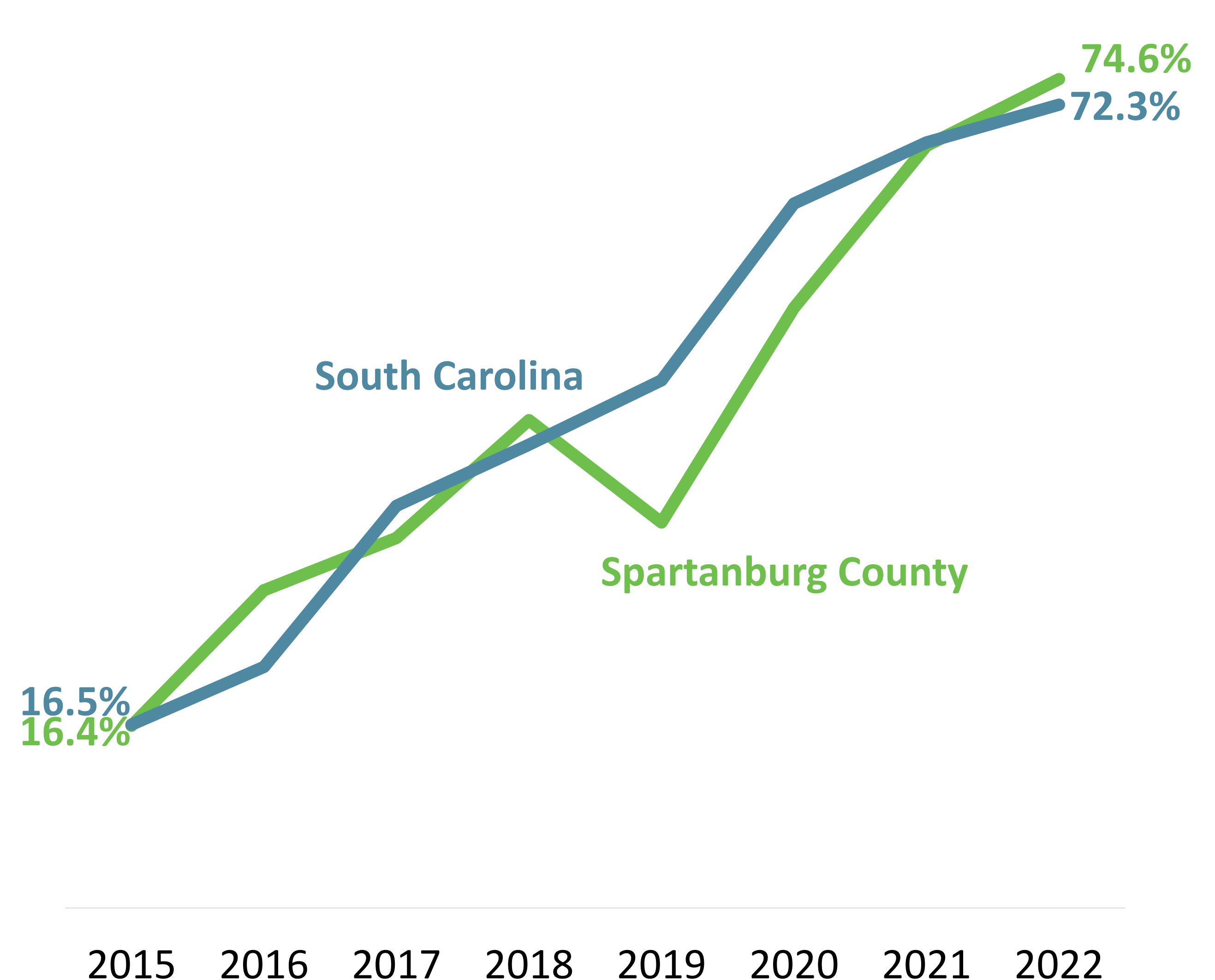

Percent



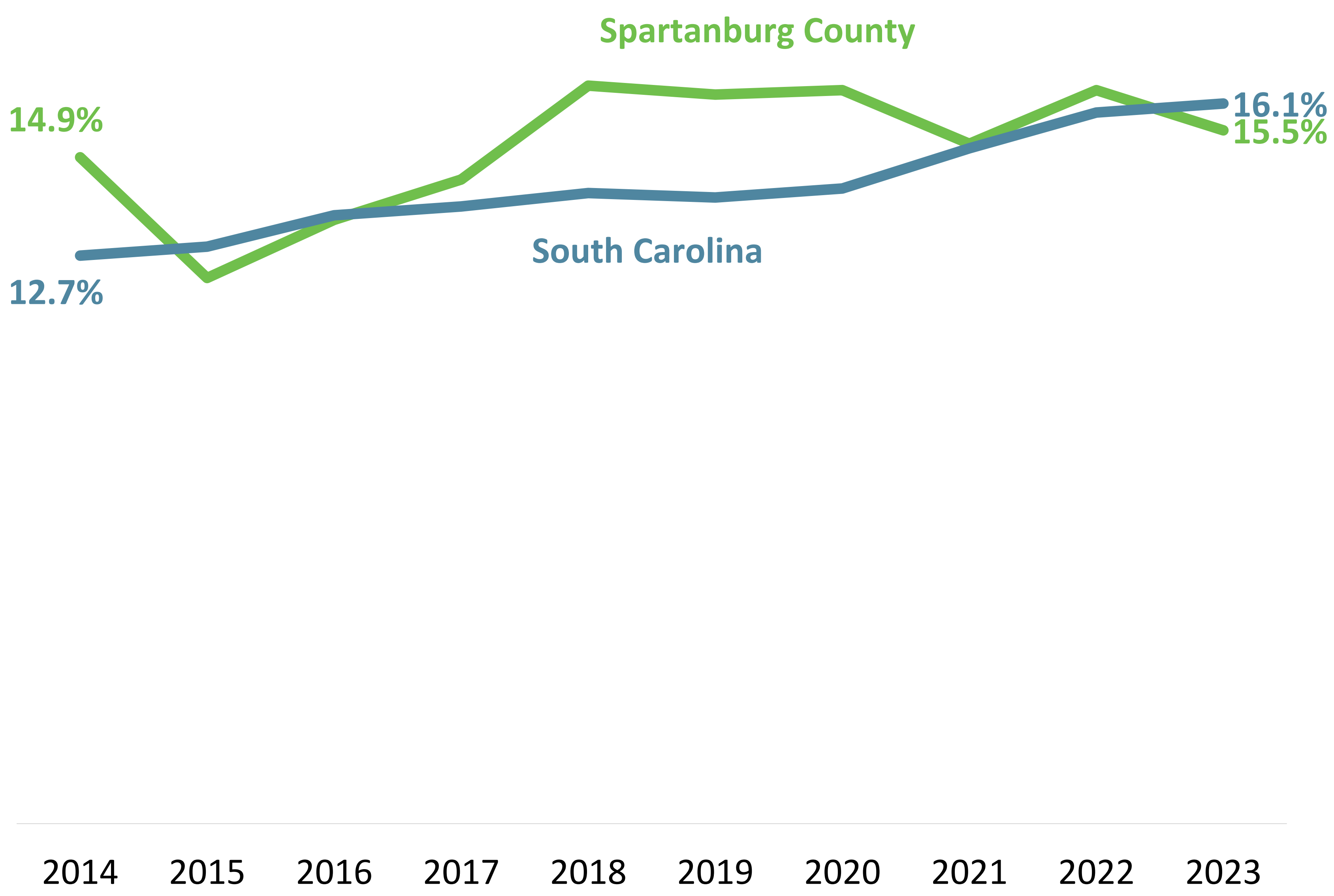

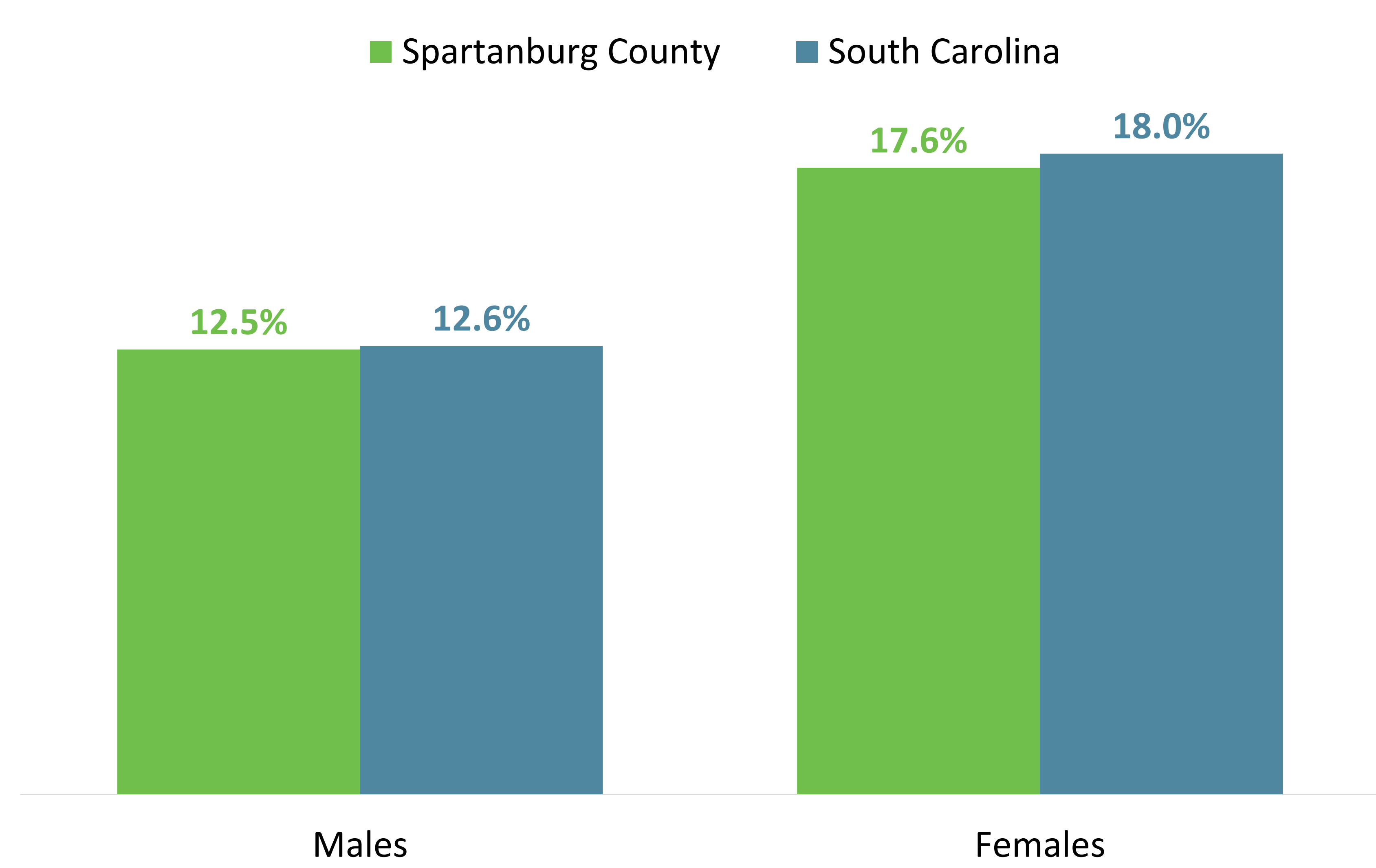

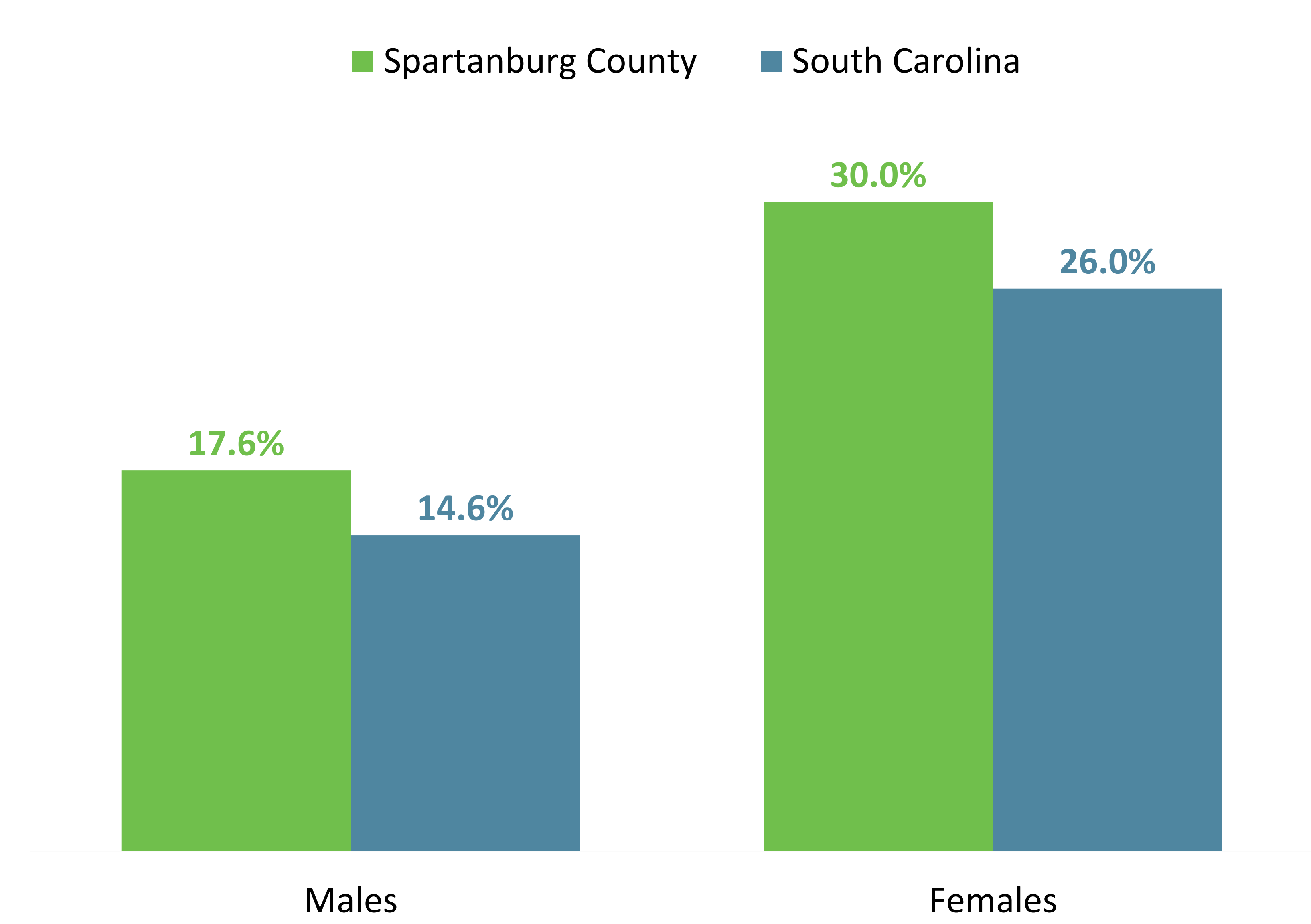
Adults Who Experienced 14 or More Poor Mental Health Days in the Past Month, by Sex

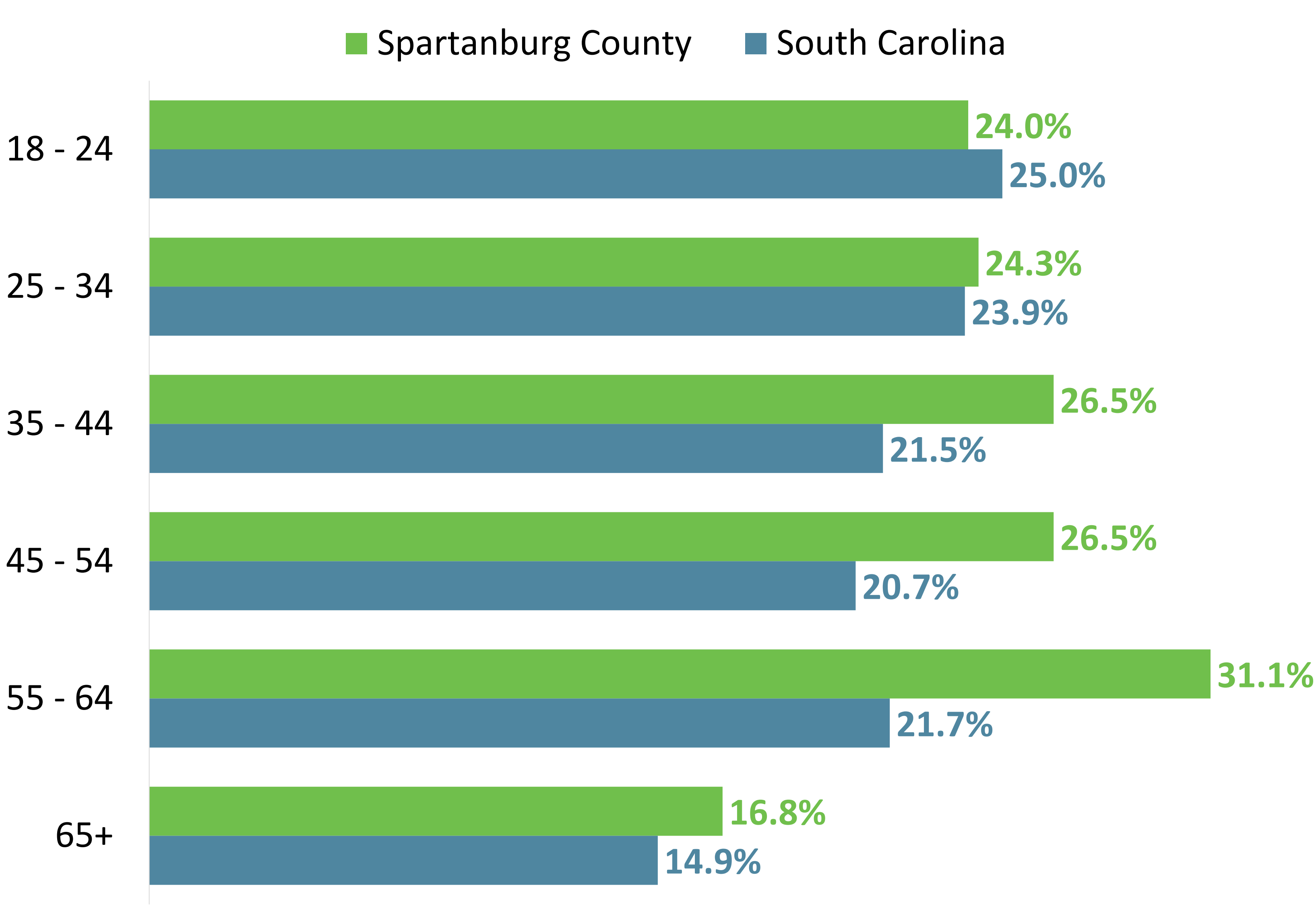

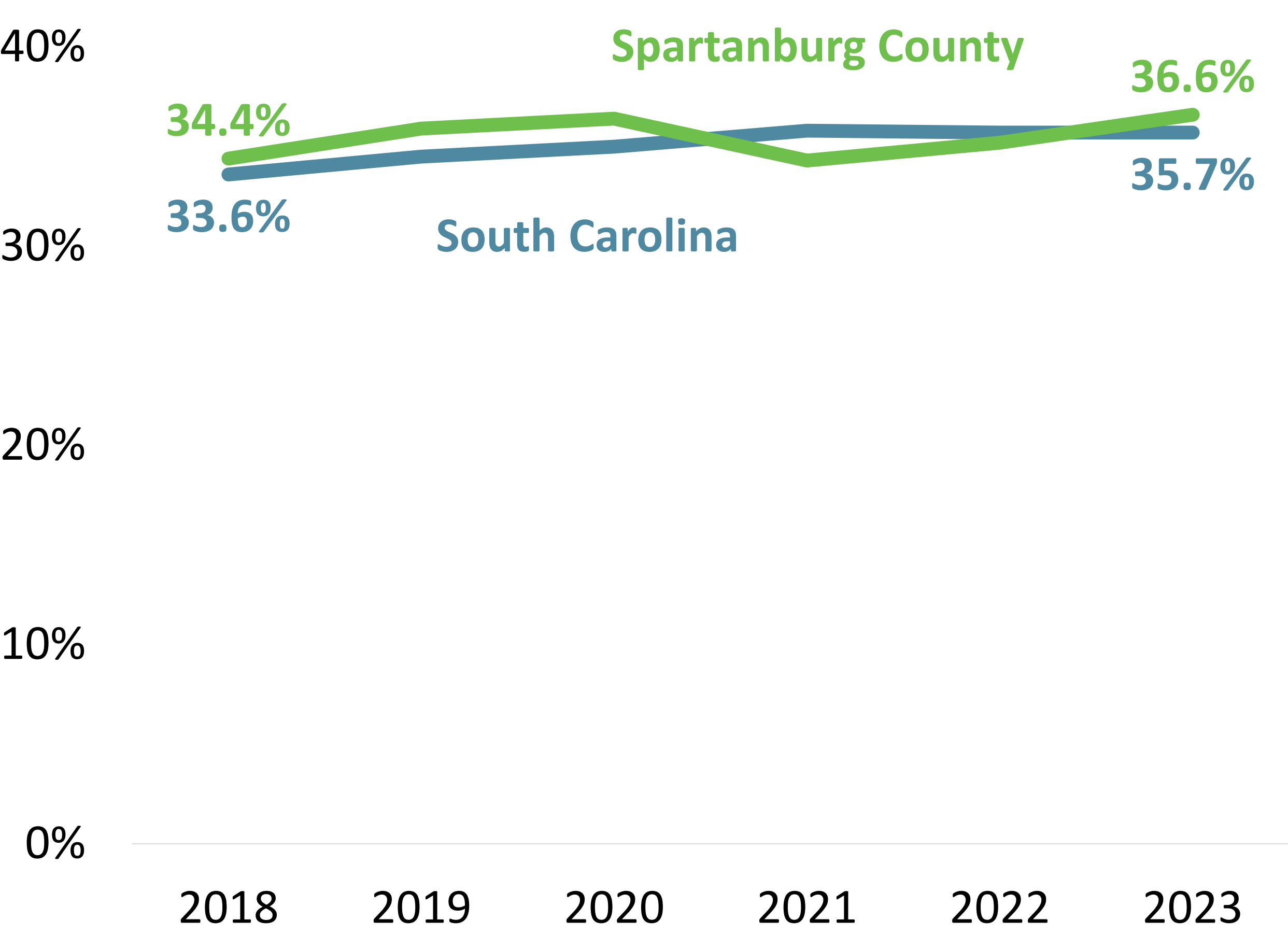

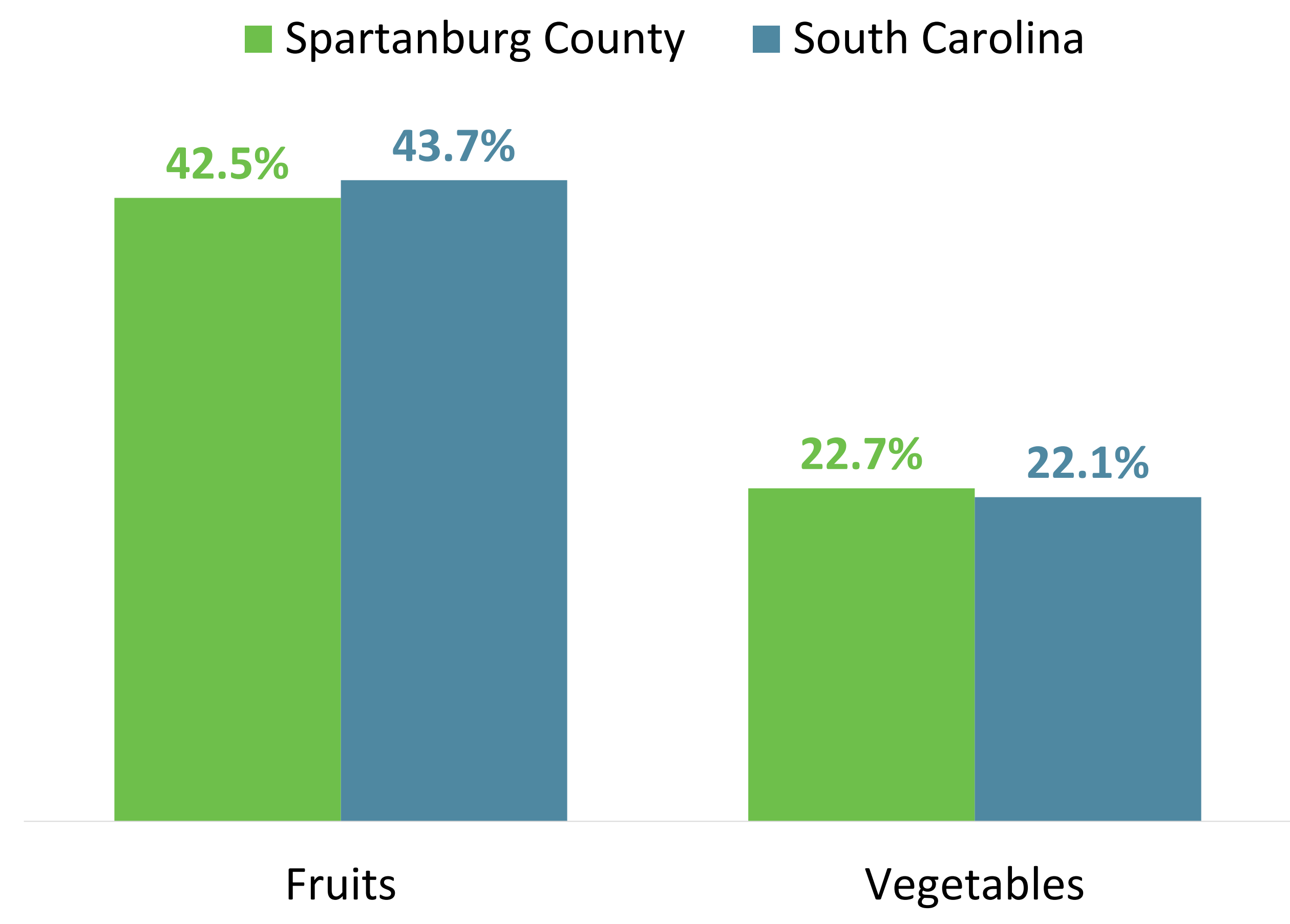

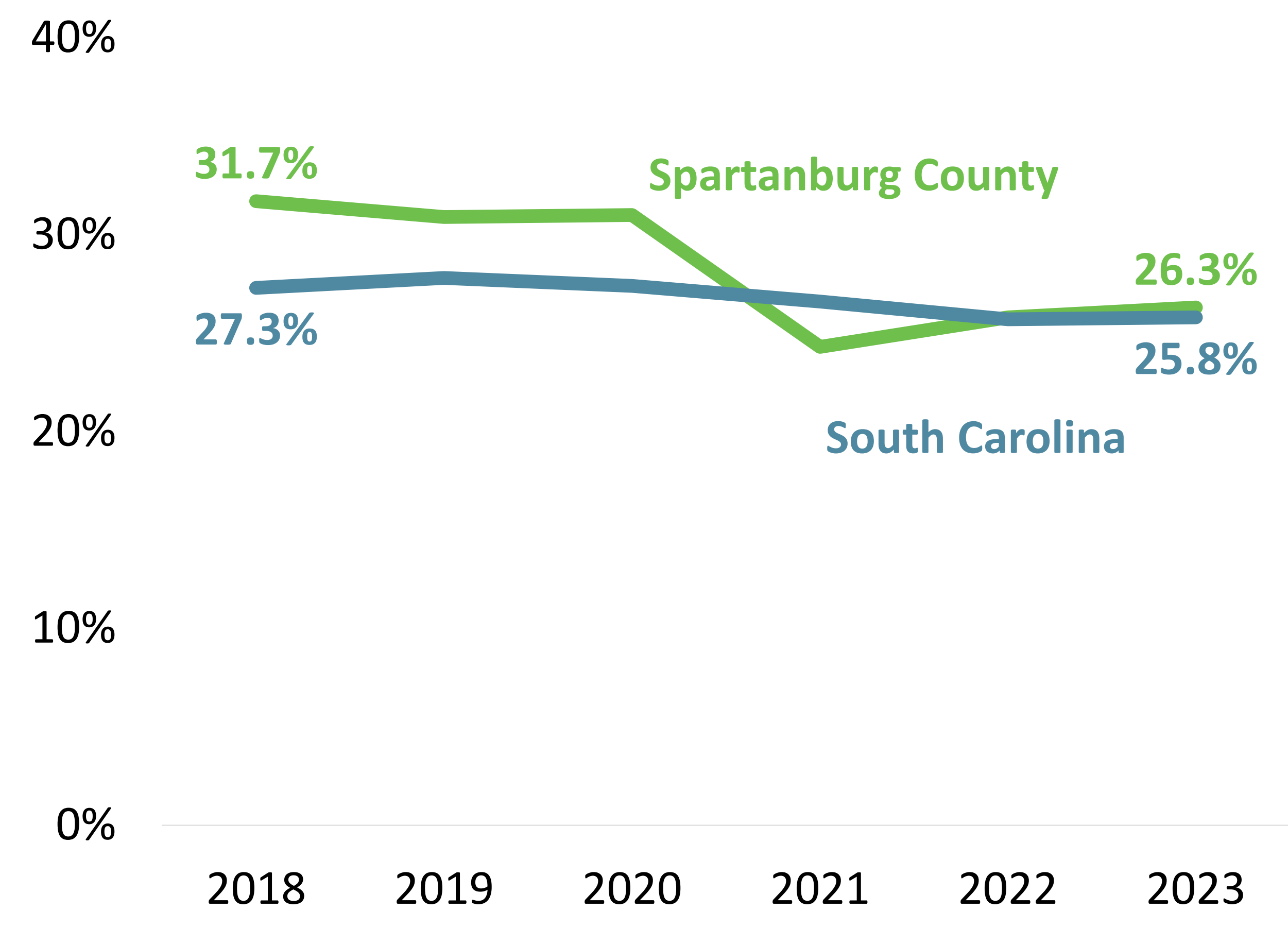
Adults Who Did Not Eat Fruit and Vegetables at Least Once a Day

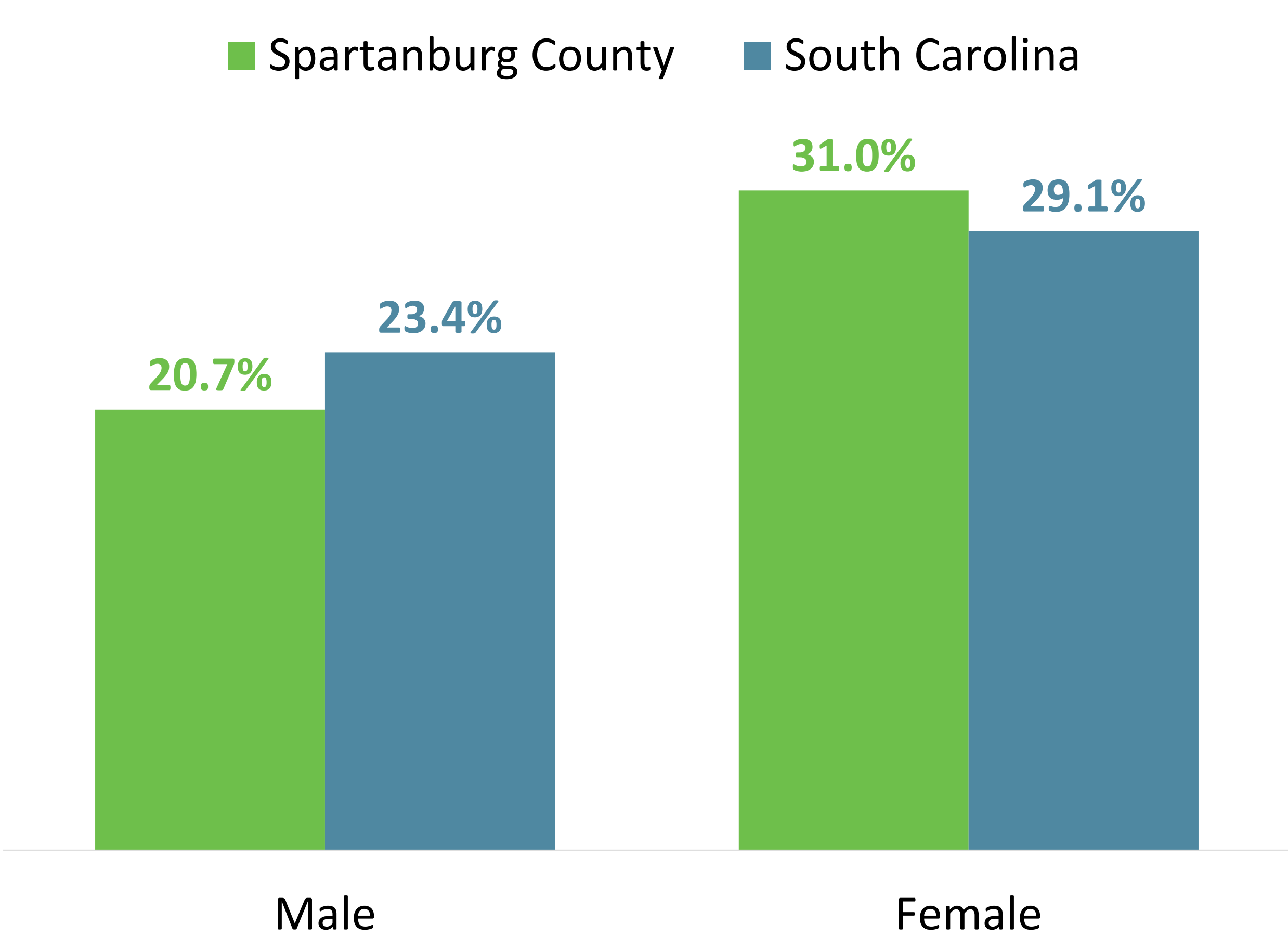
Physical Activity

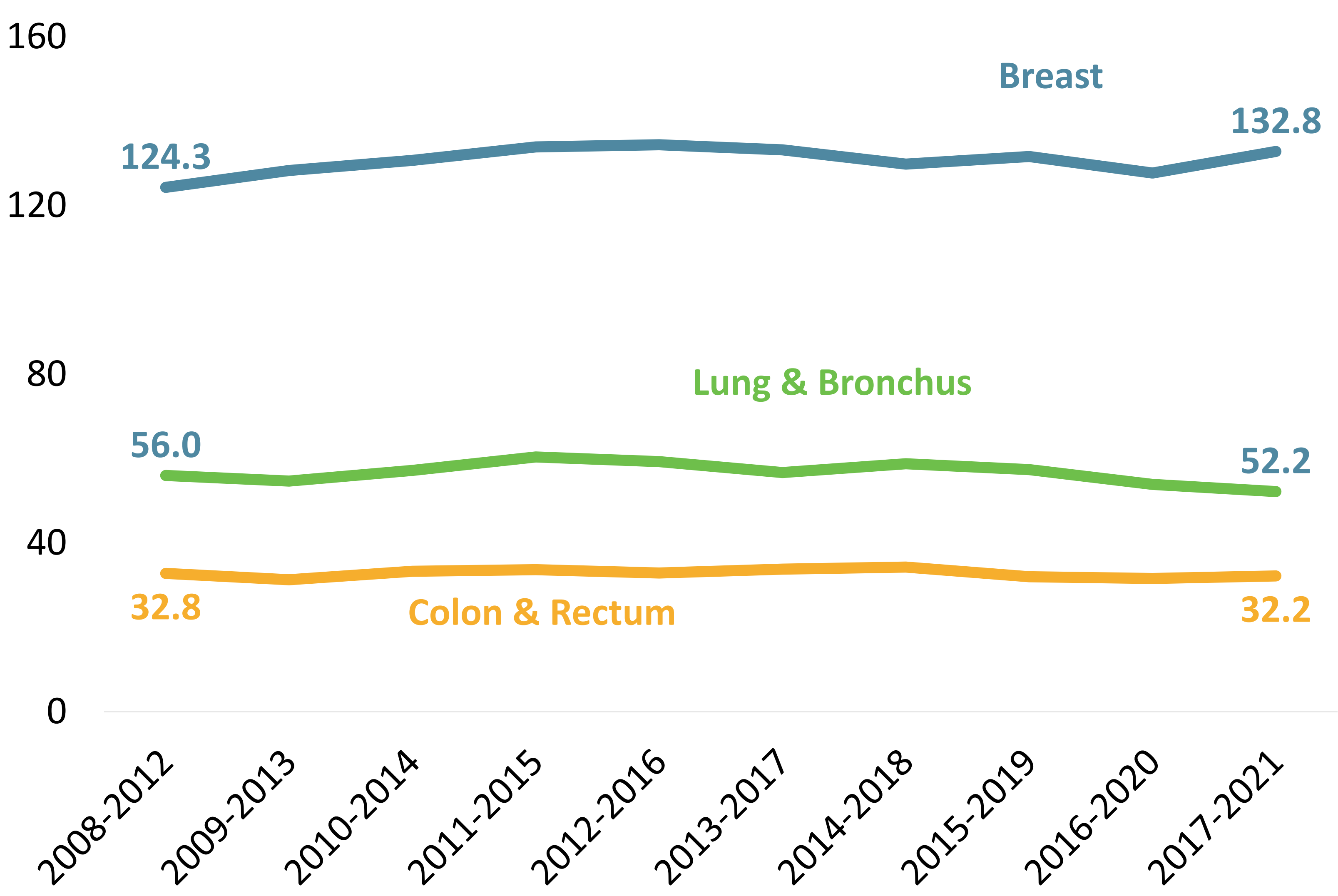

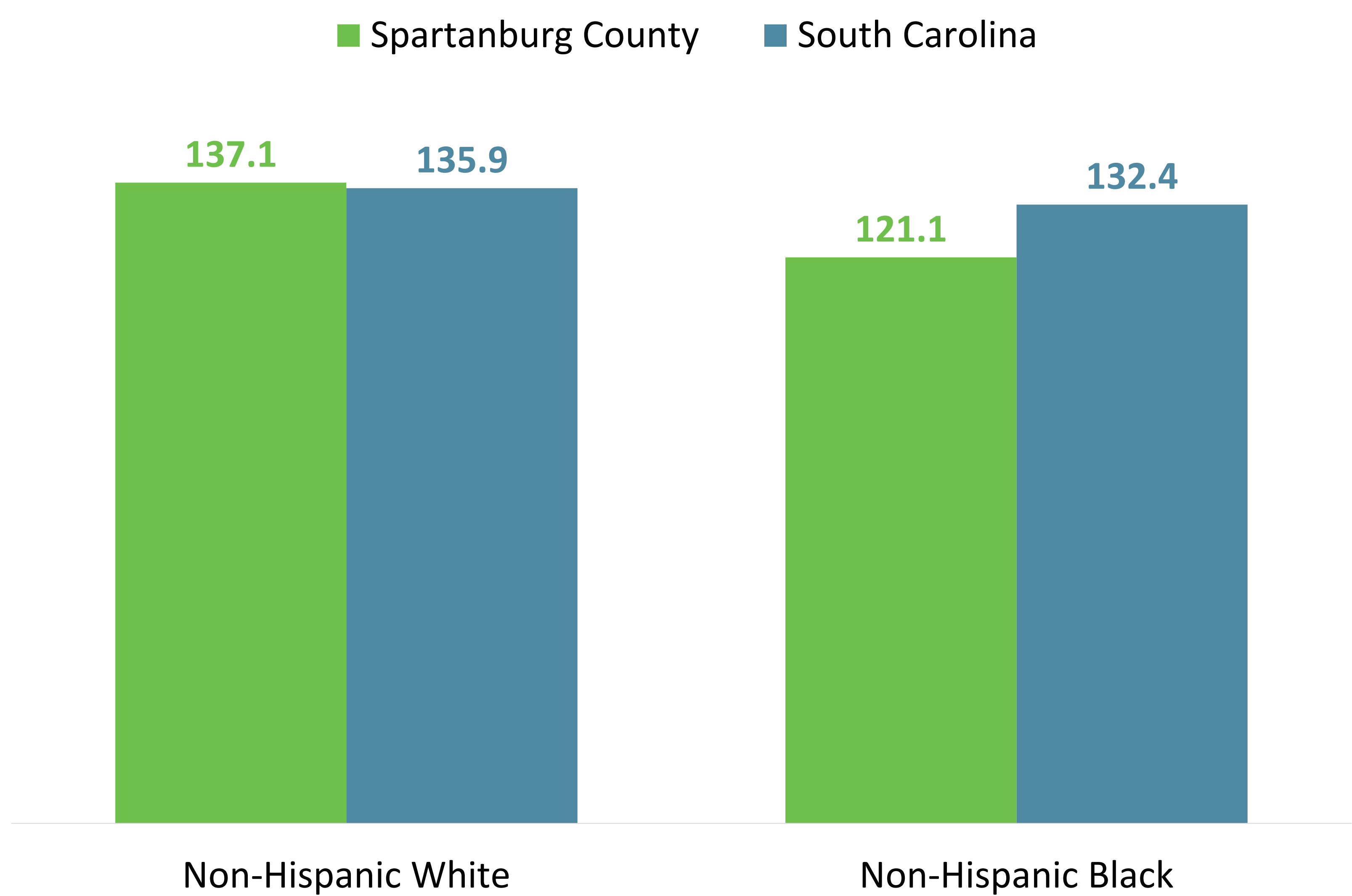

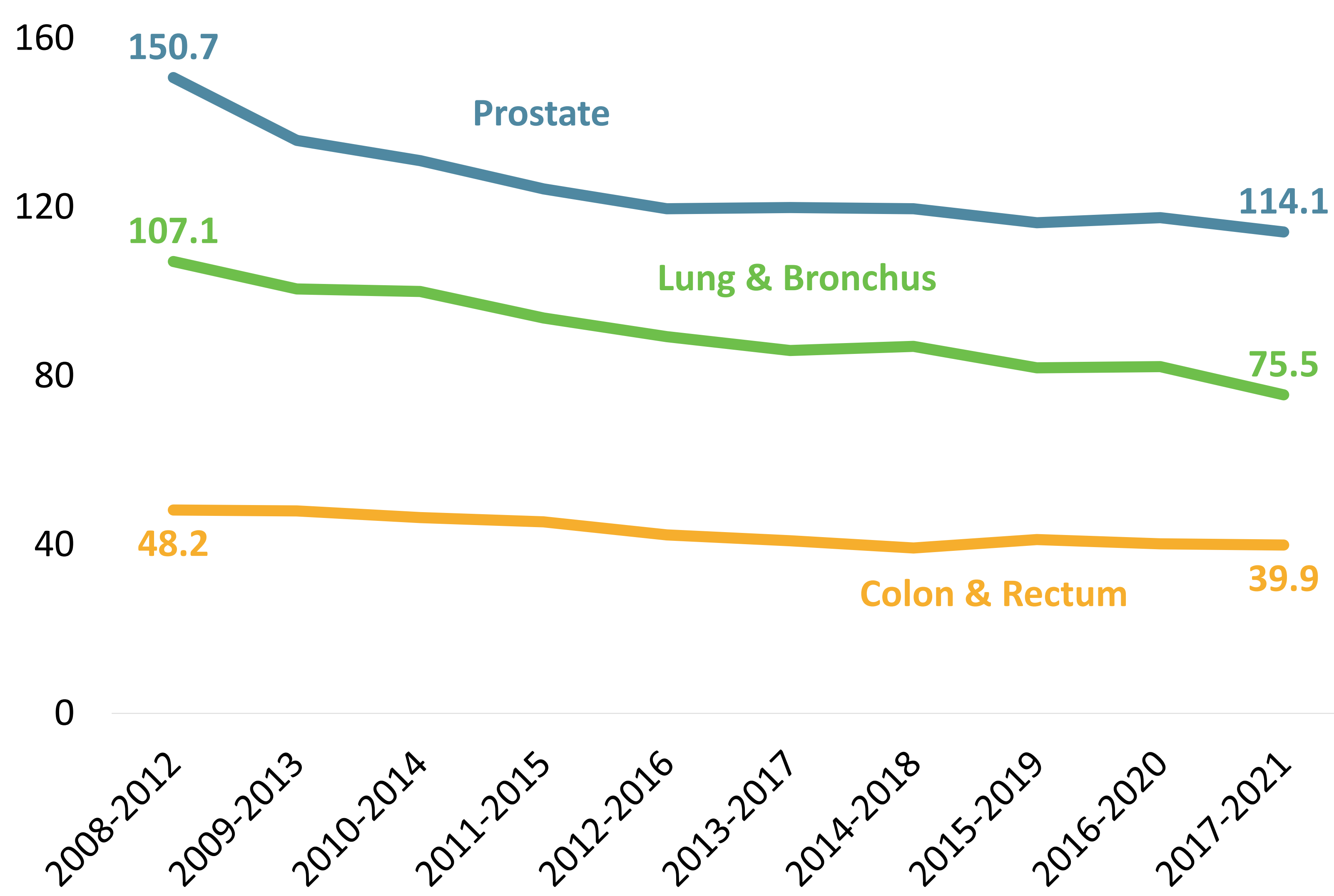

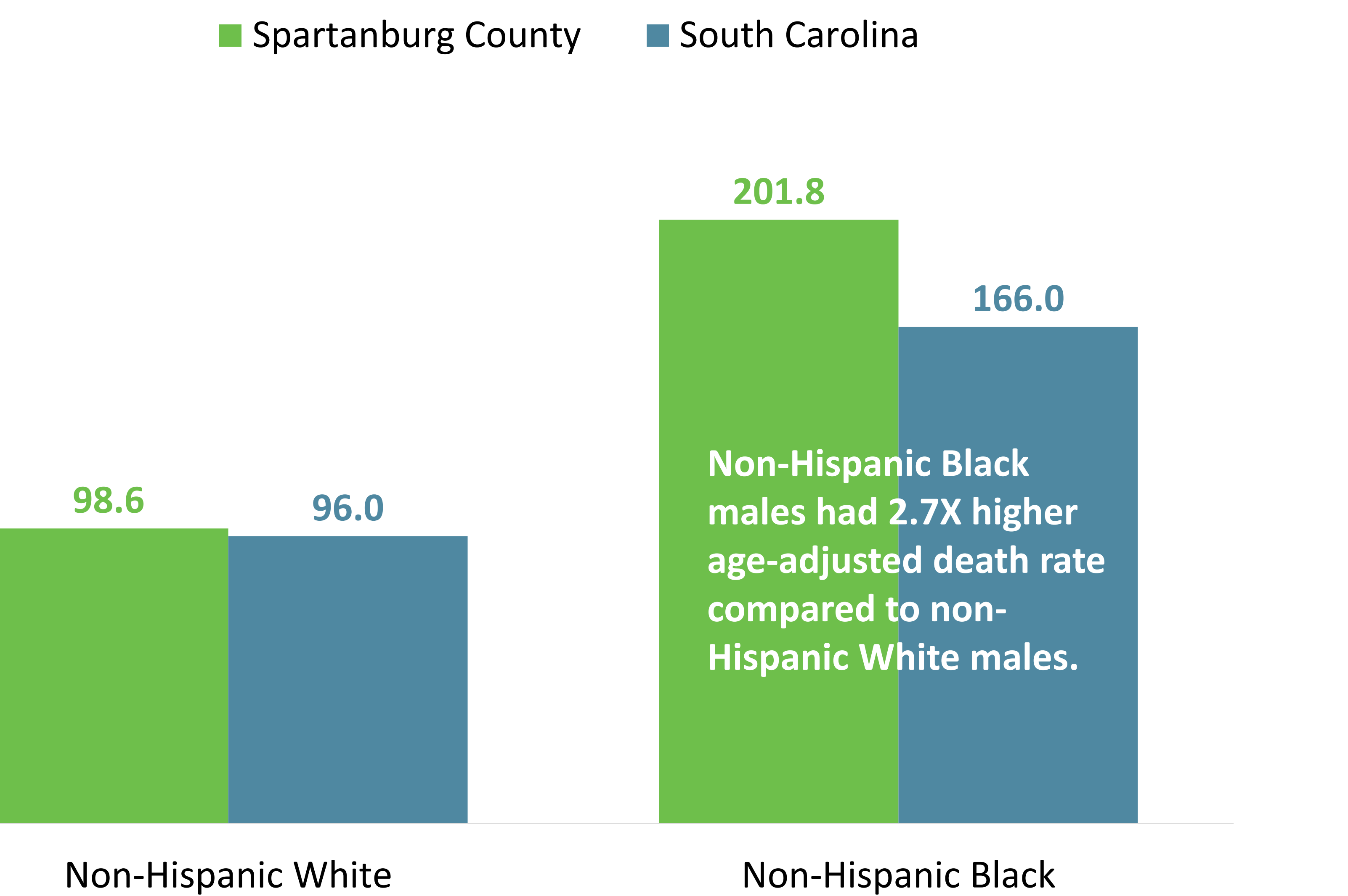

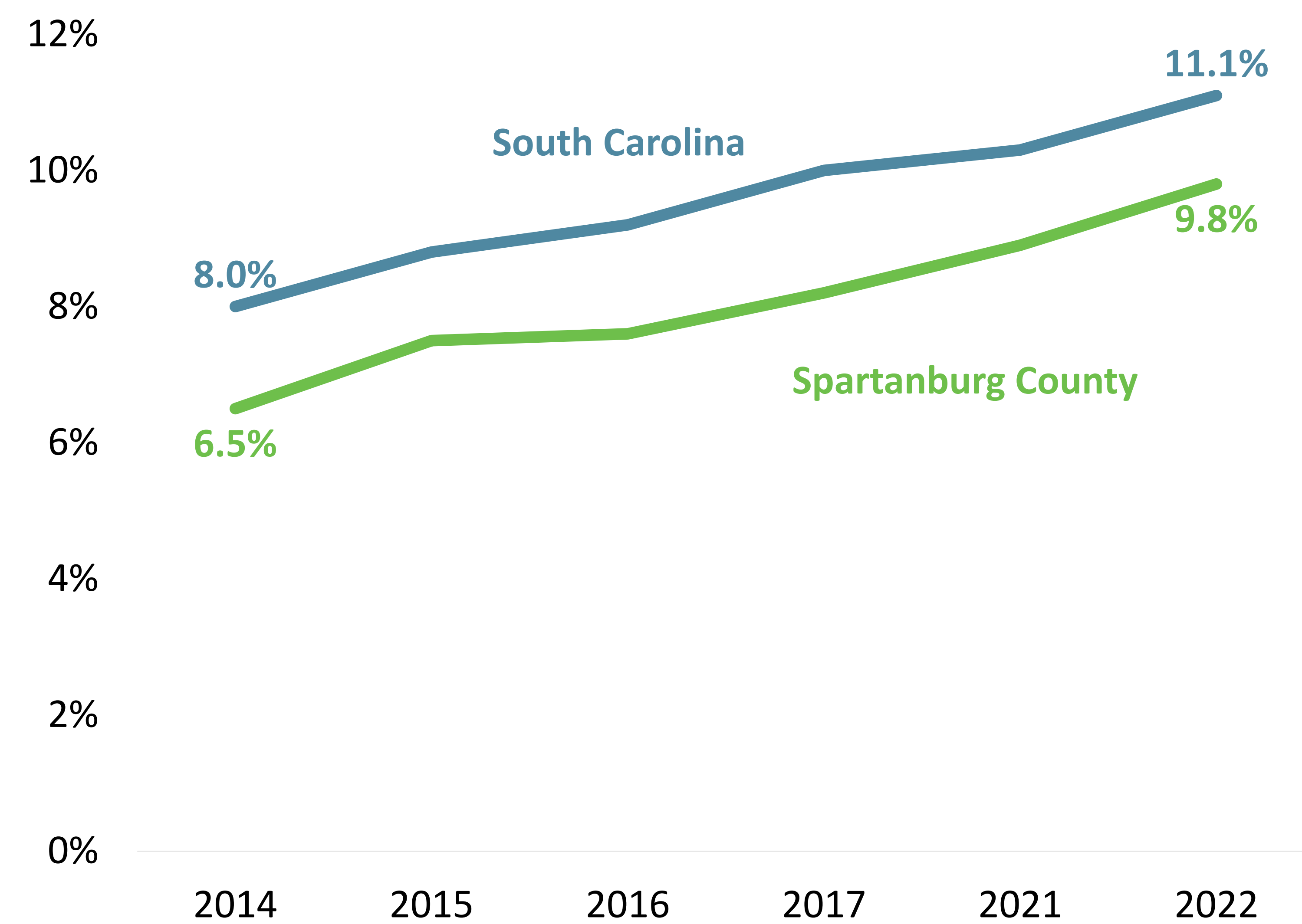

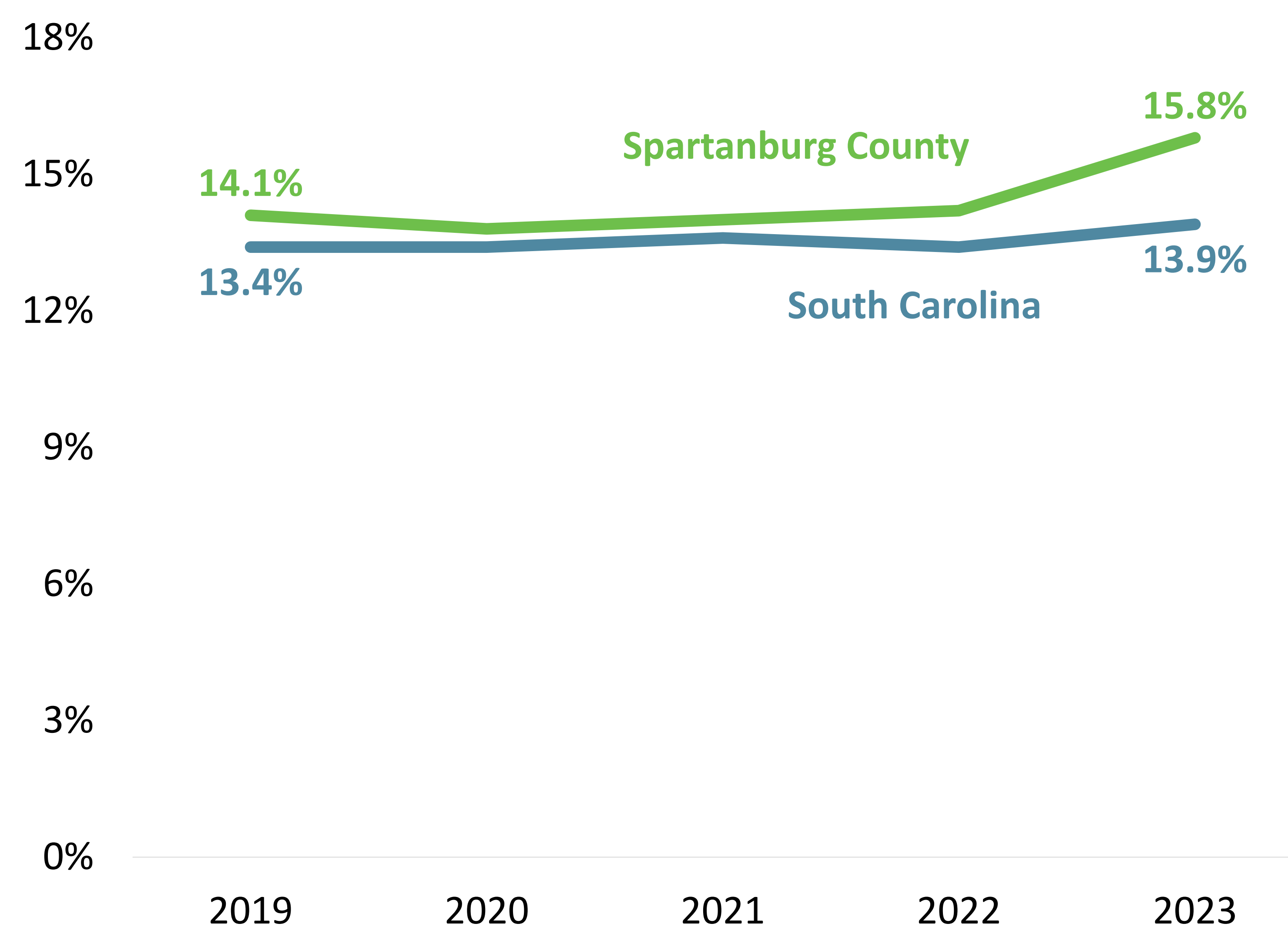

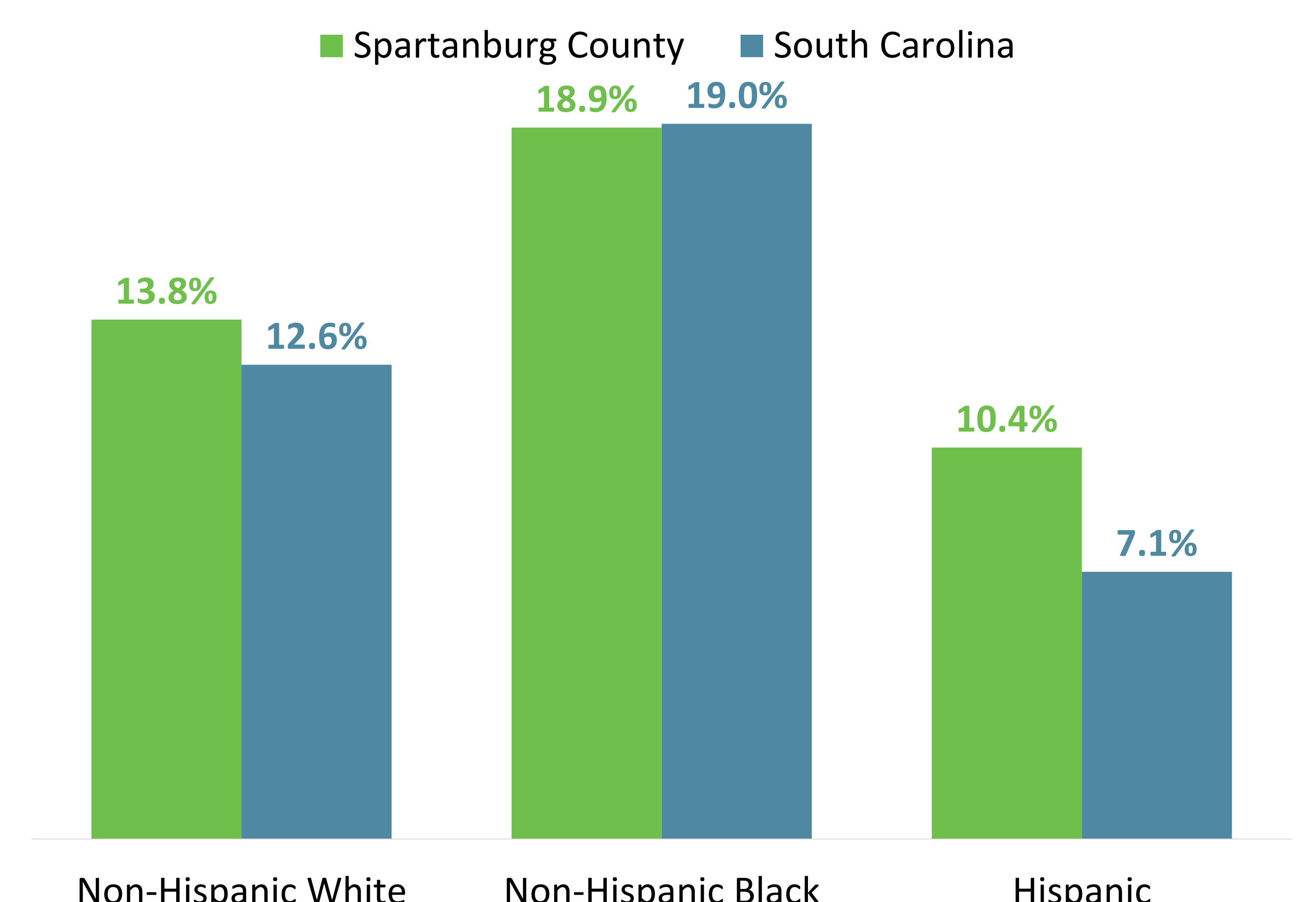

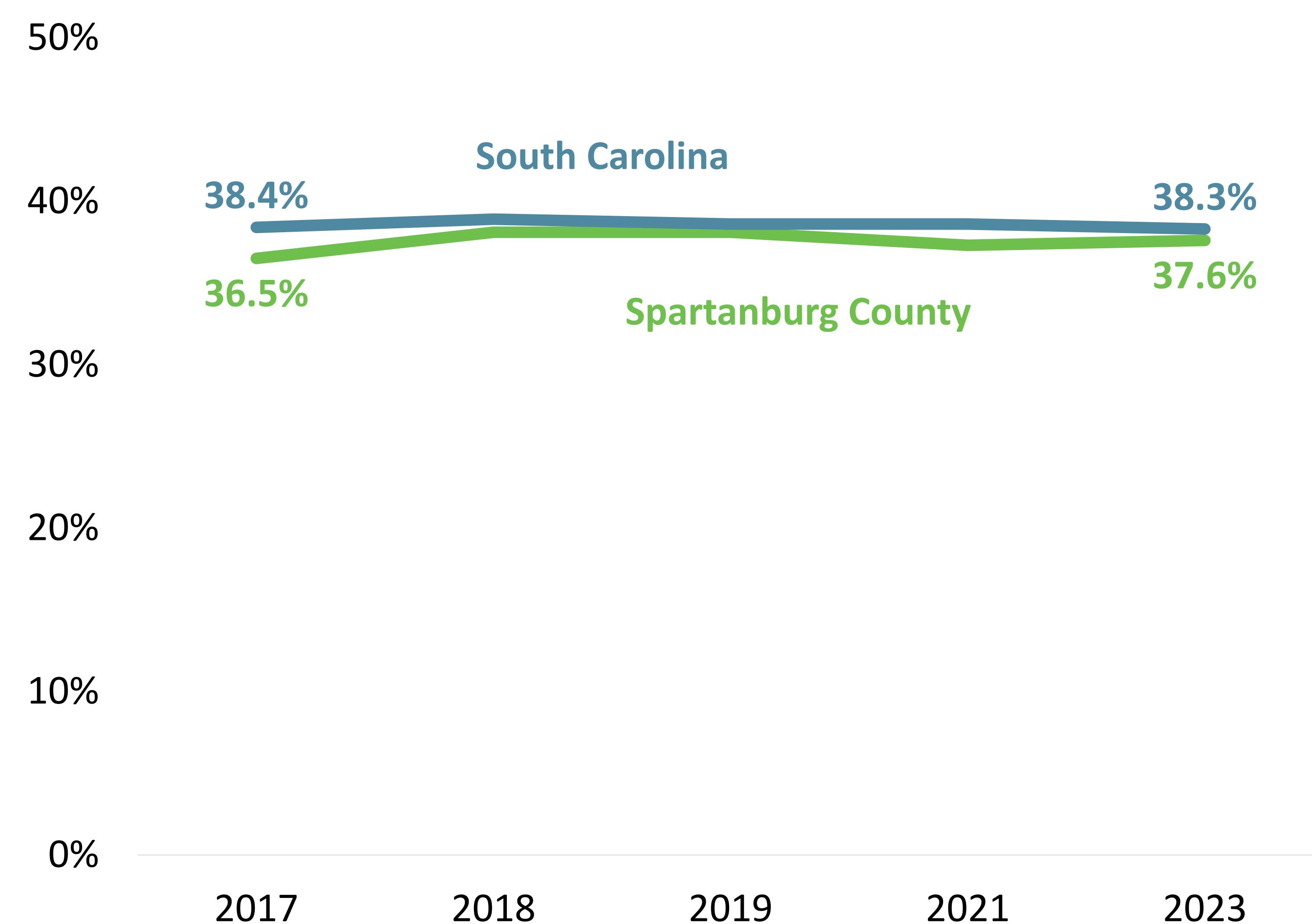
Adults with Diabetes, by Race/Ethnicity

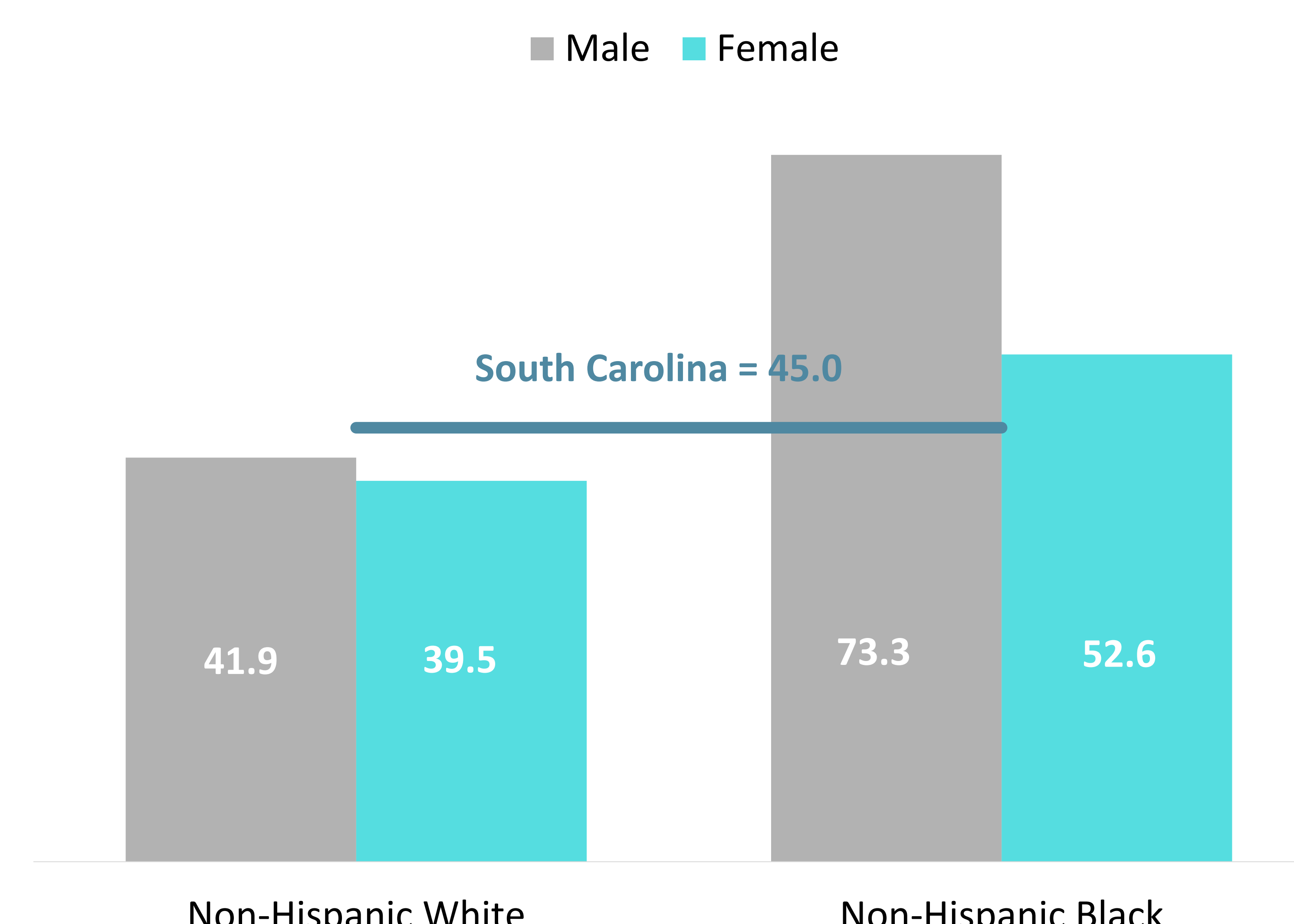

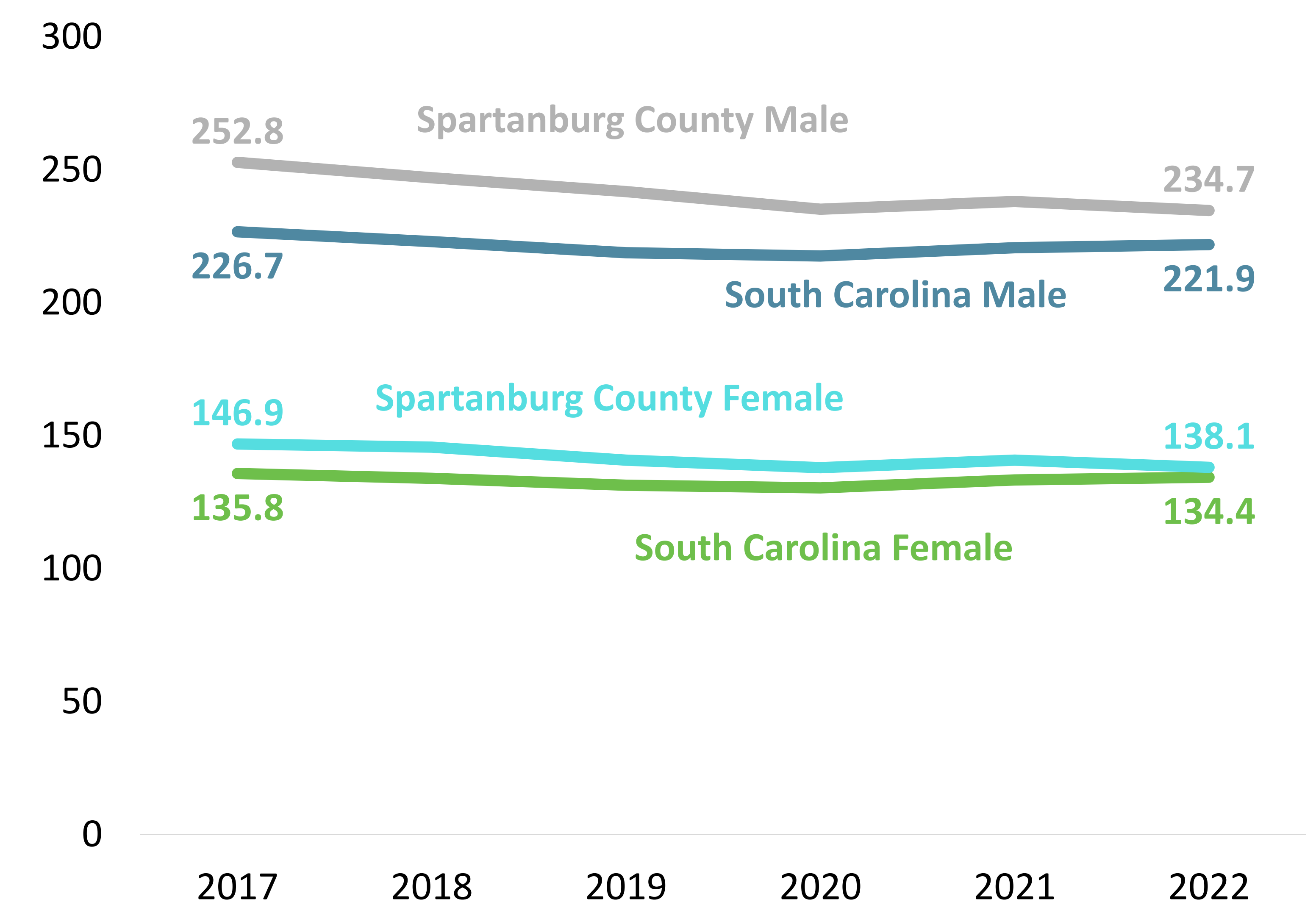
Stroke Deaths, by Sex and Race/Ethnicity

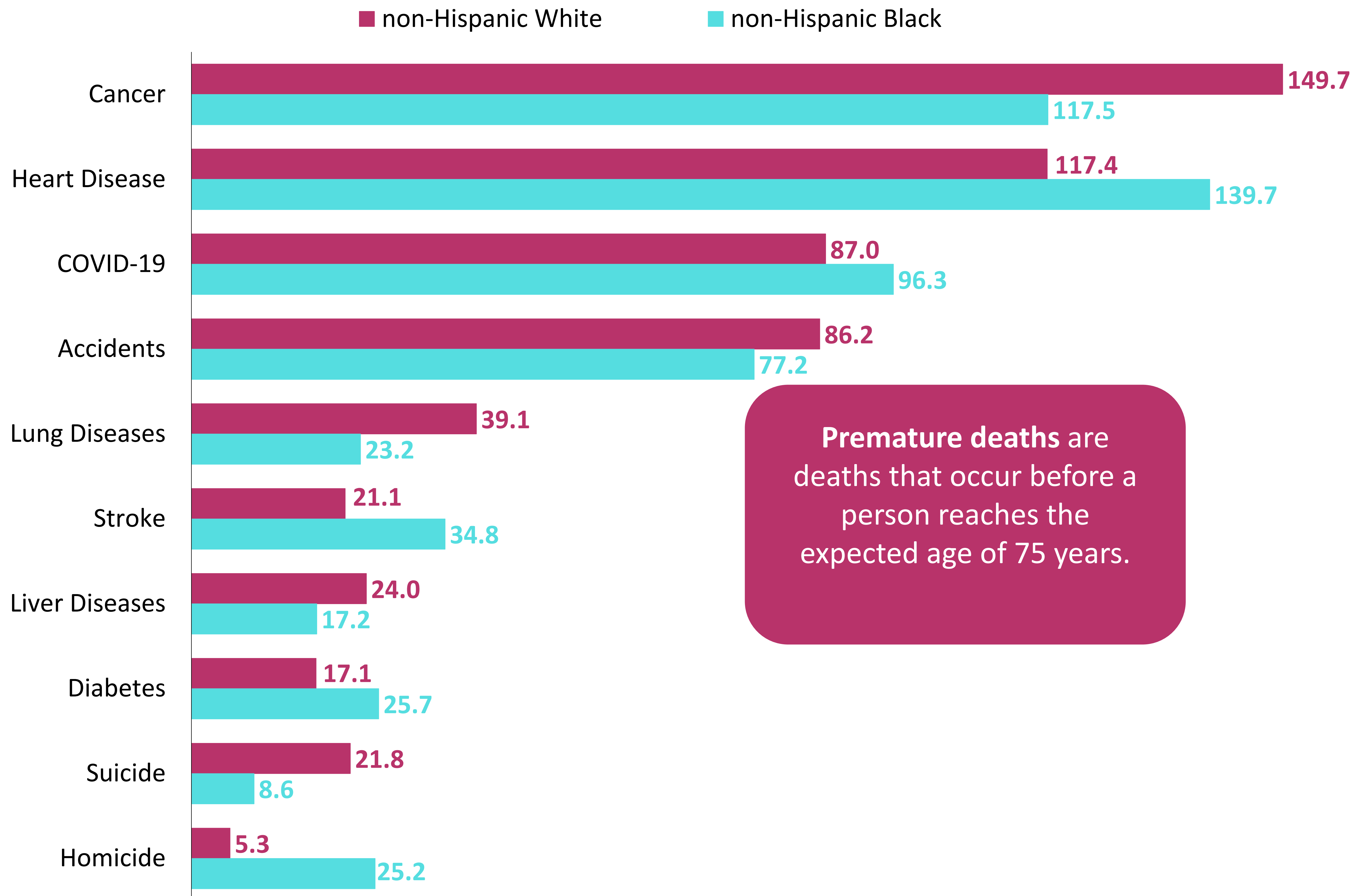

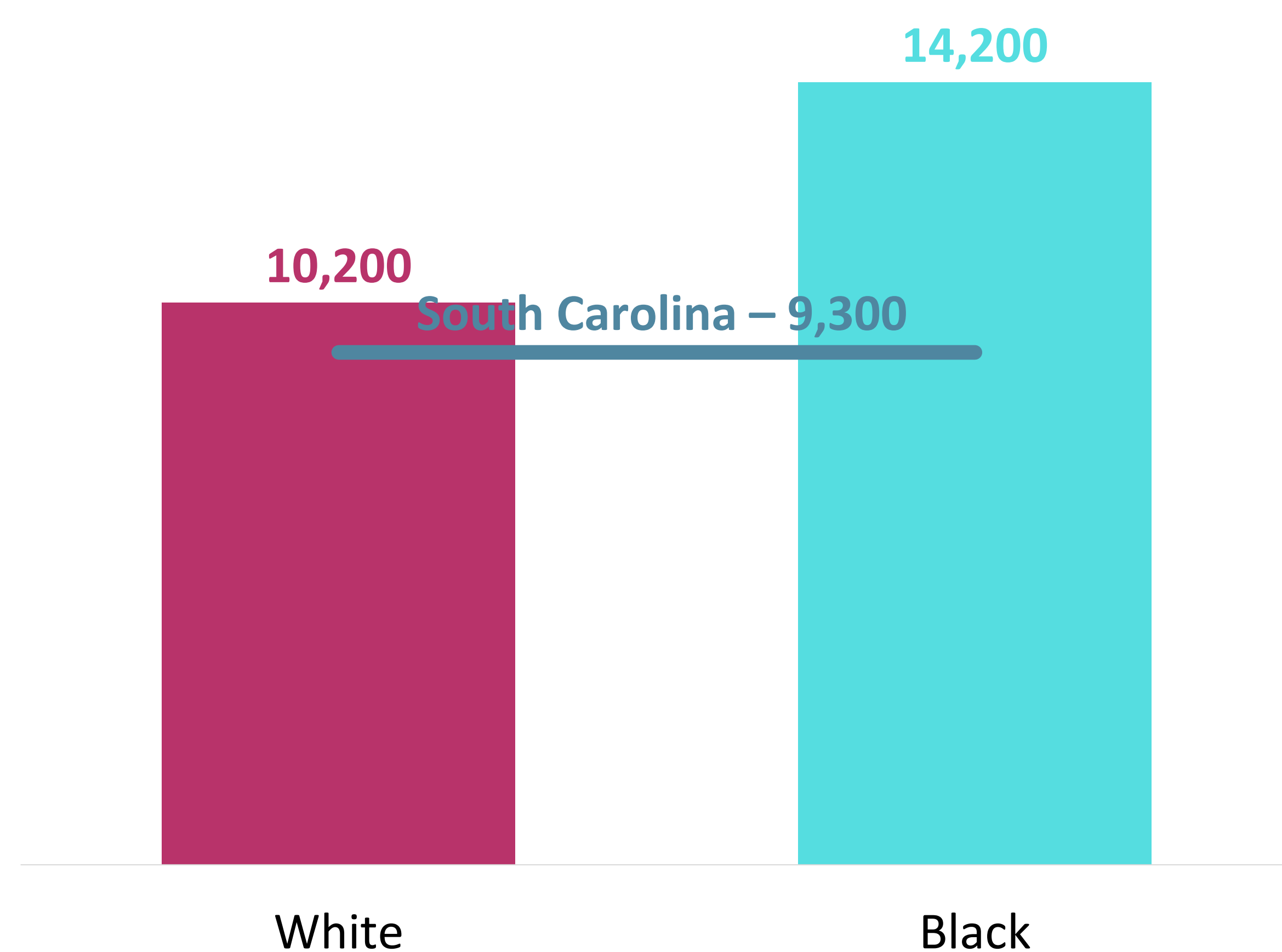

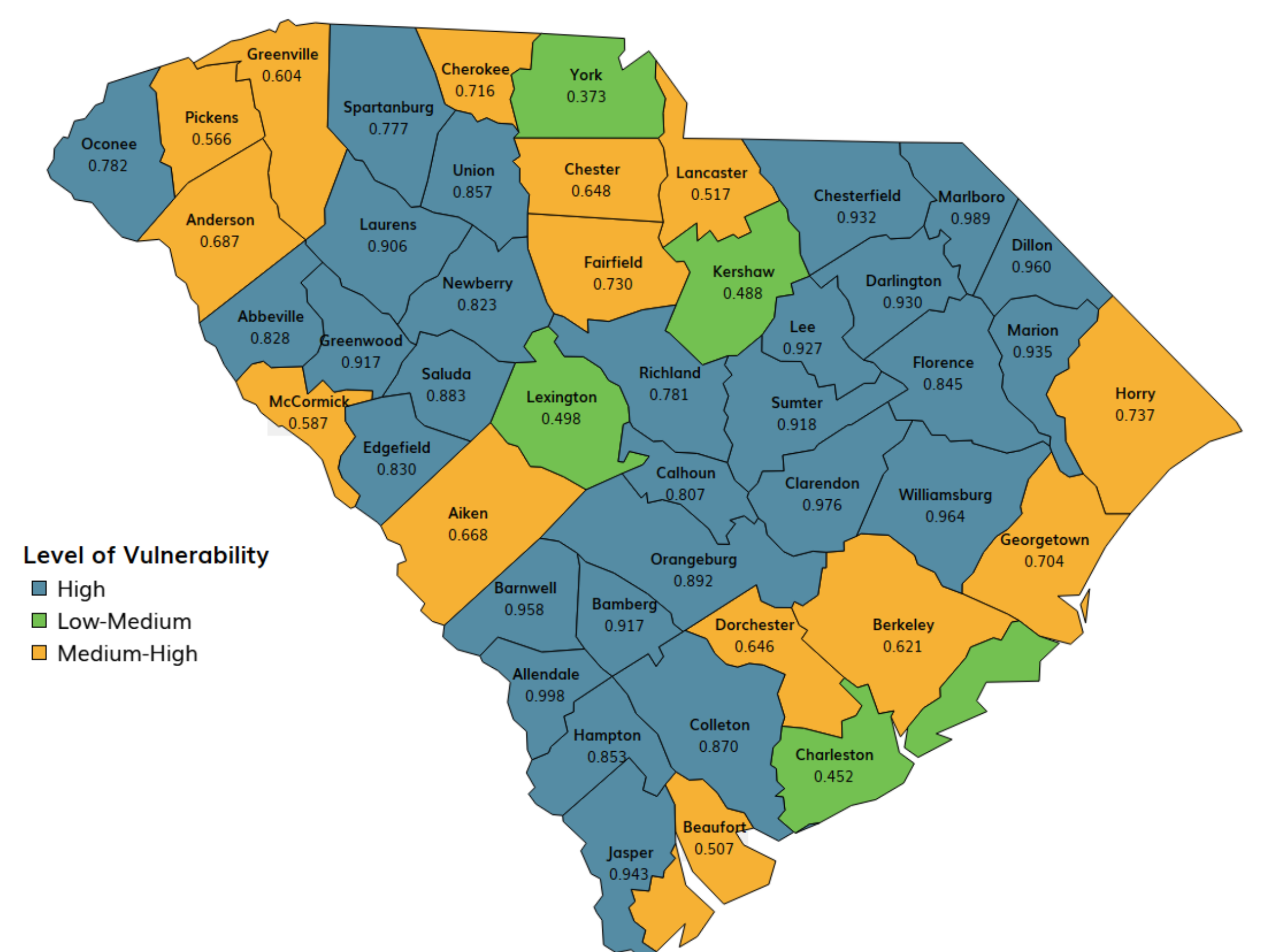

Social Vulnerability Index, by County

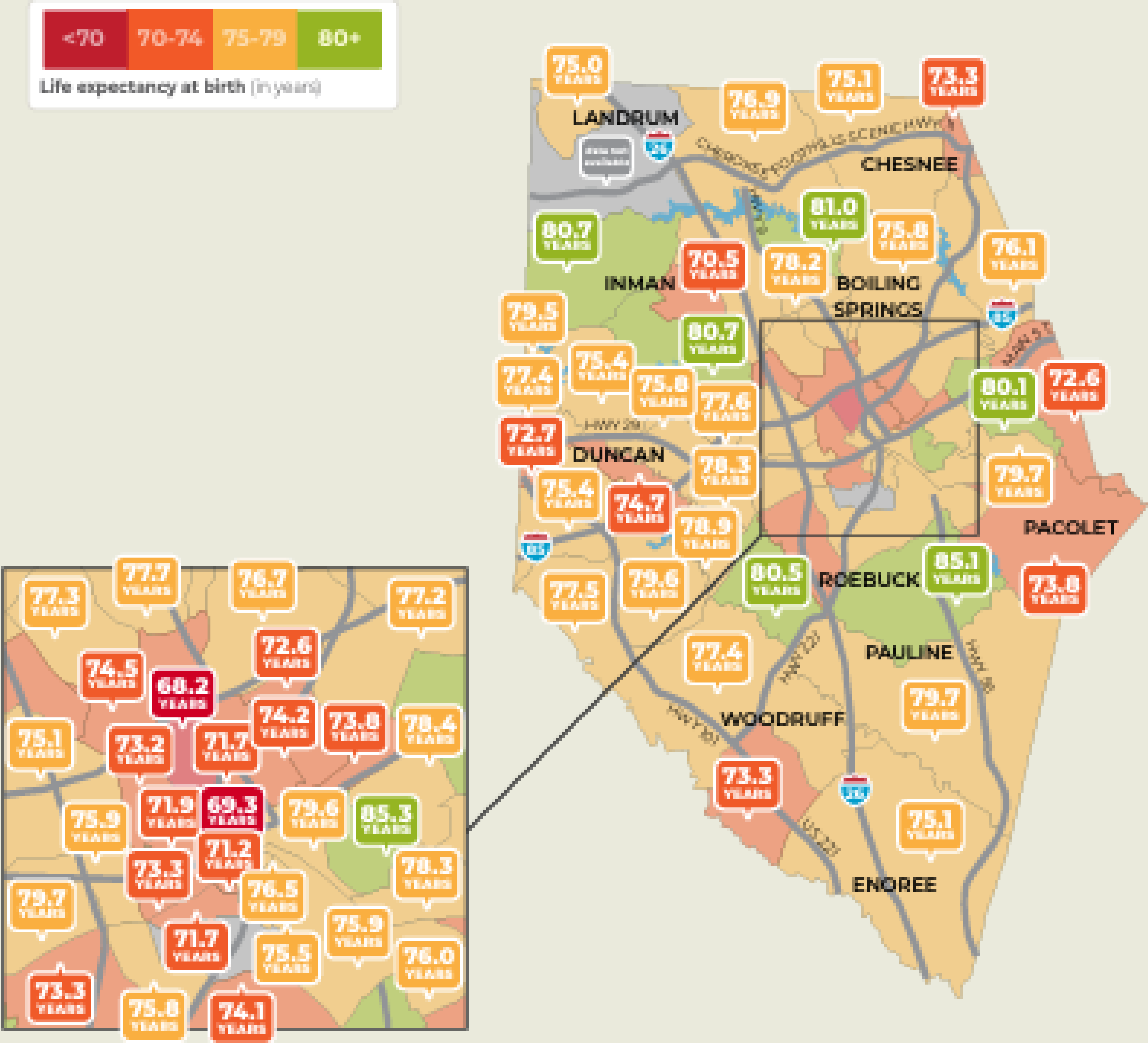
National Overall SVI Score

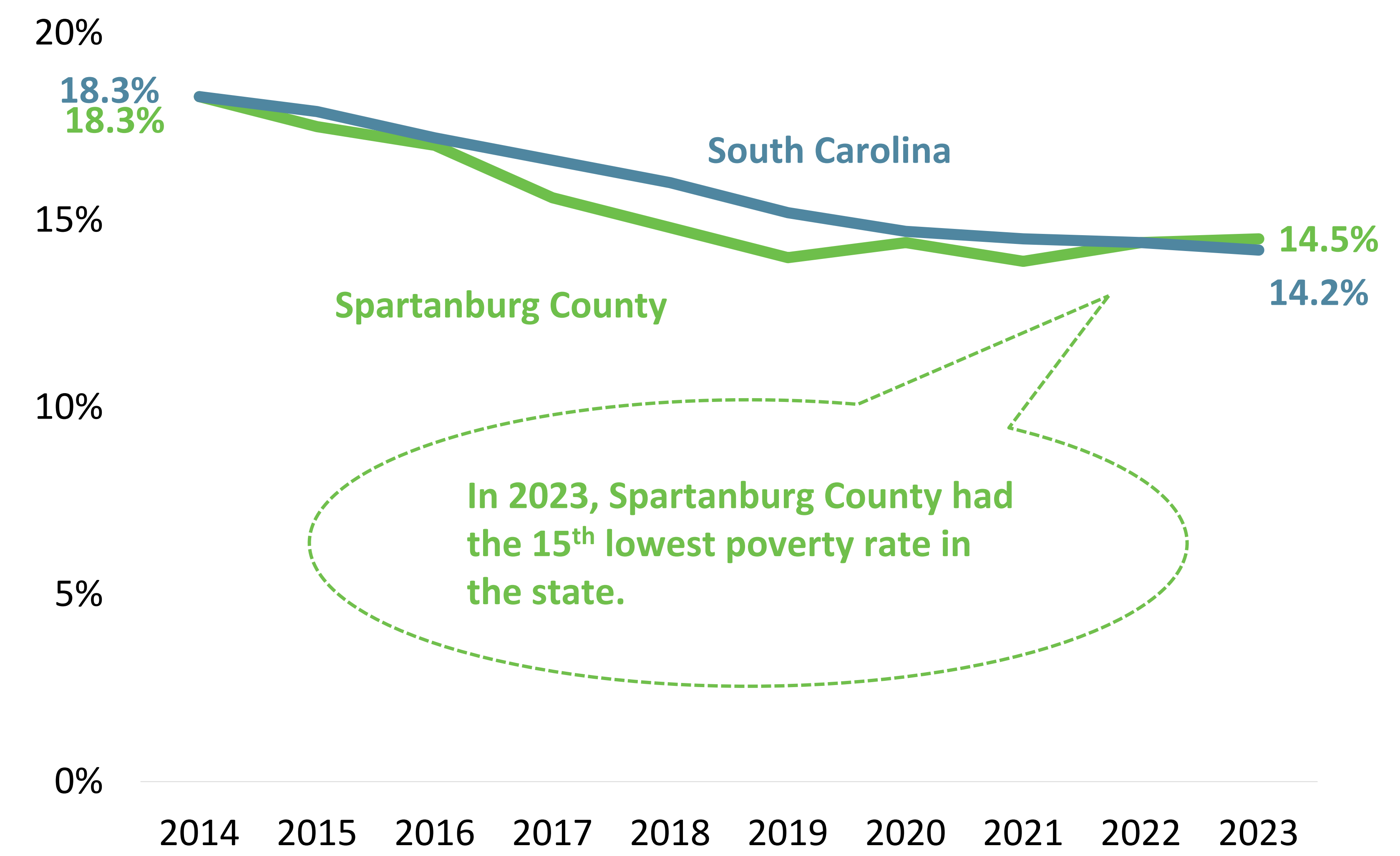

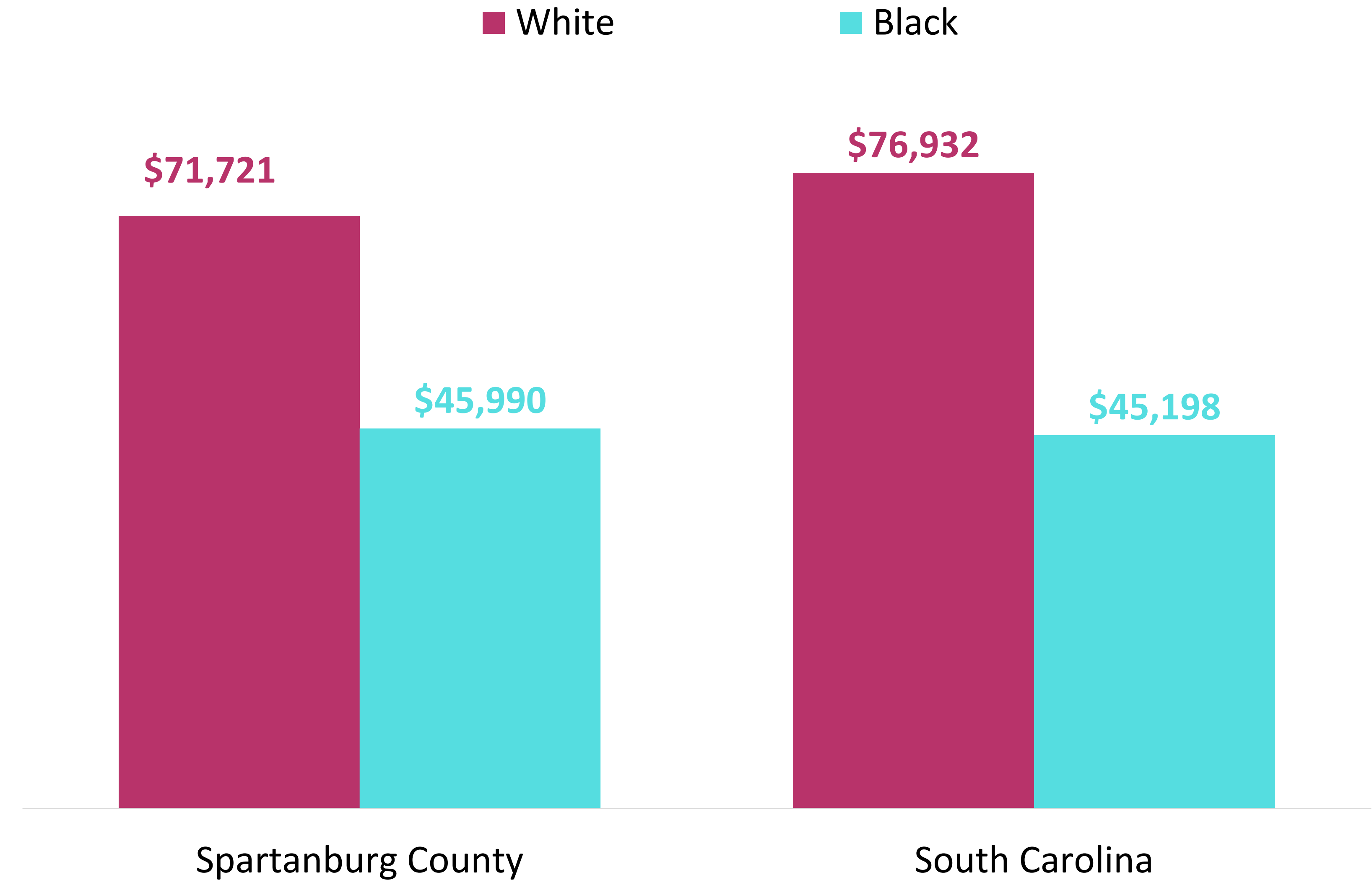

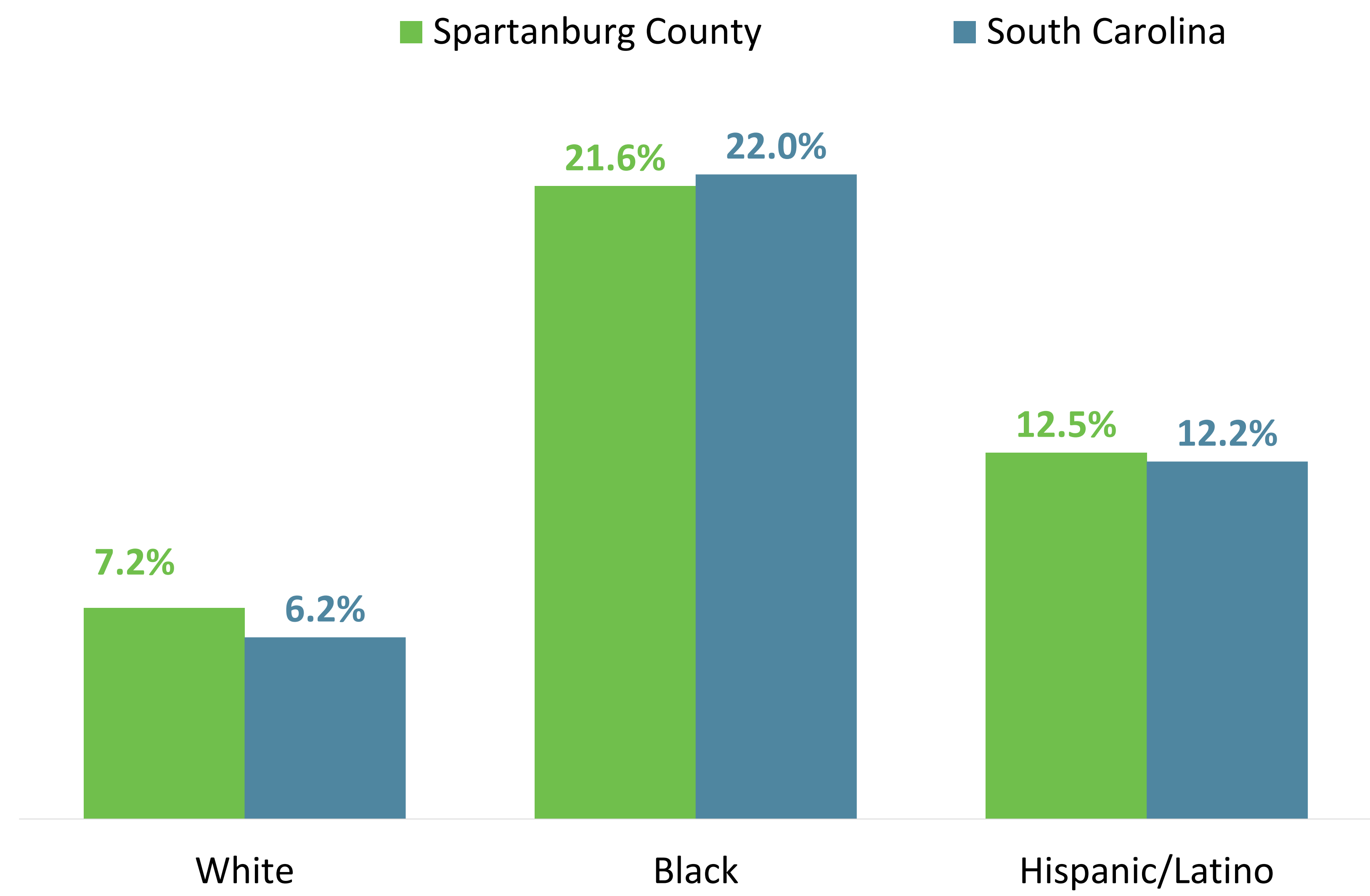

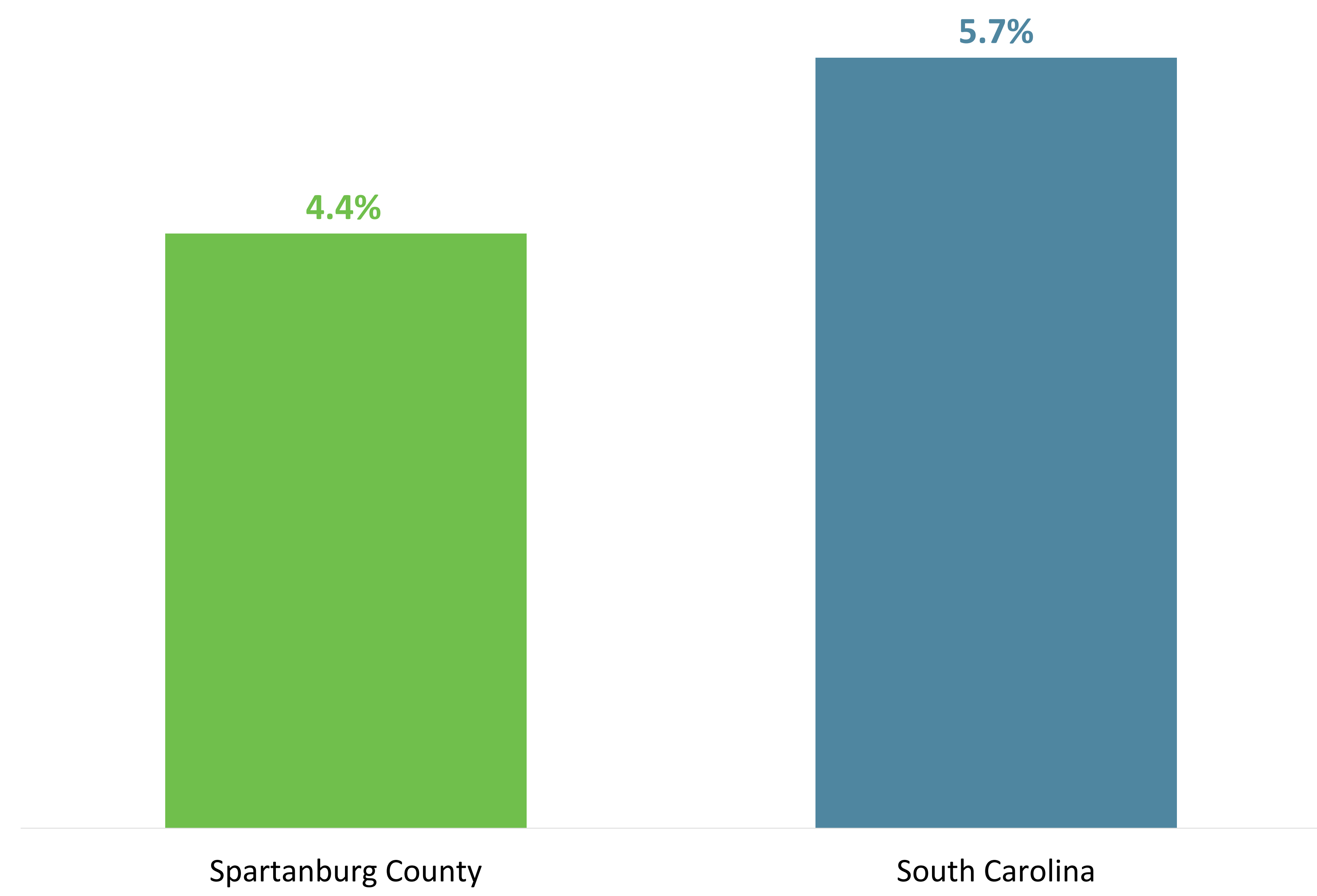
Households Receiving Food Stamps/SNAP, by Race/Ethnicity

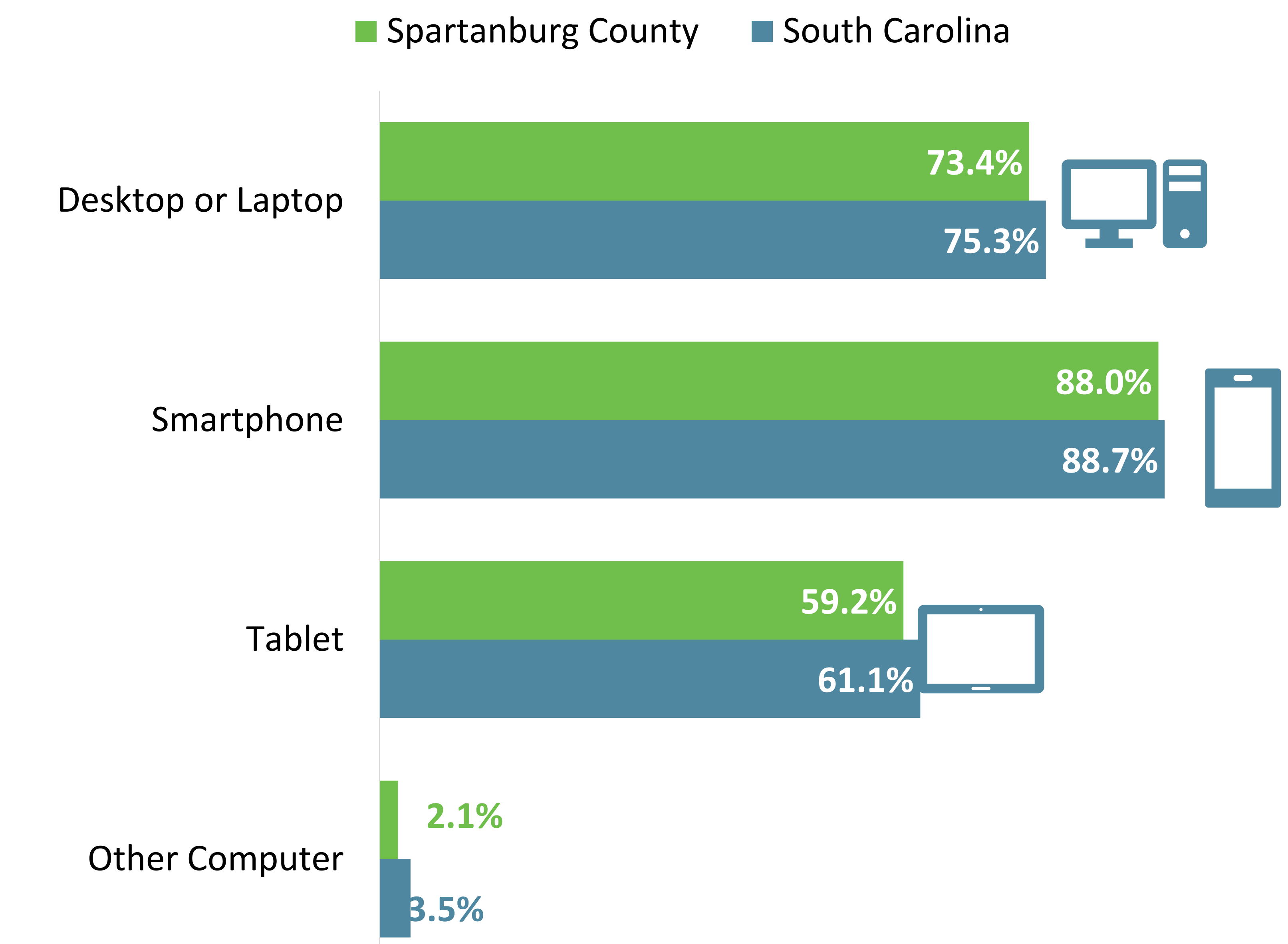

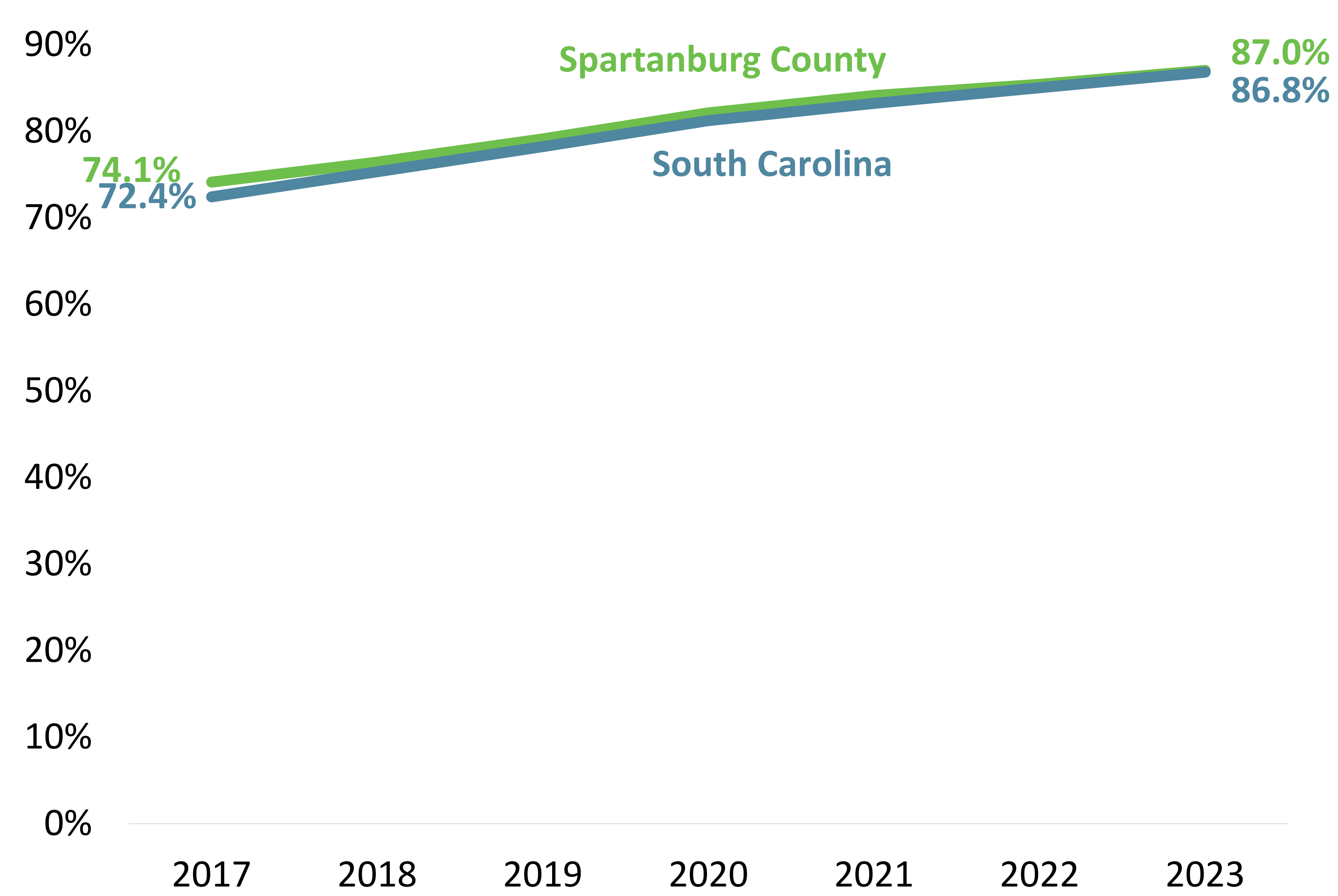

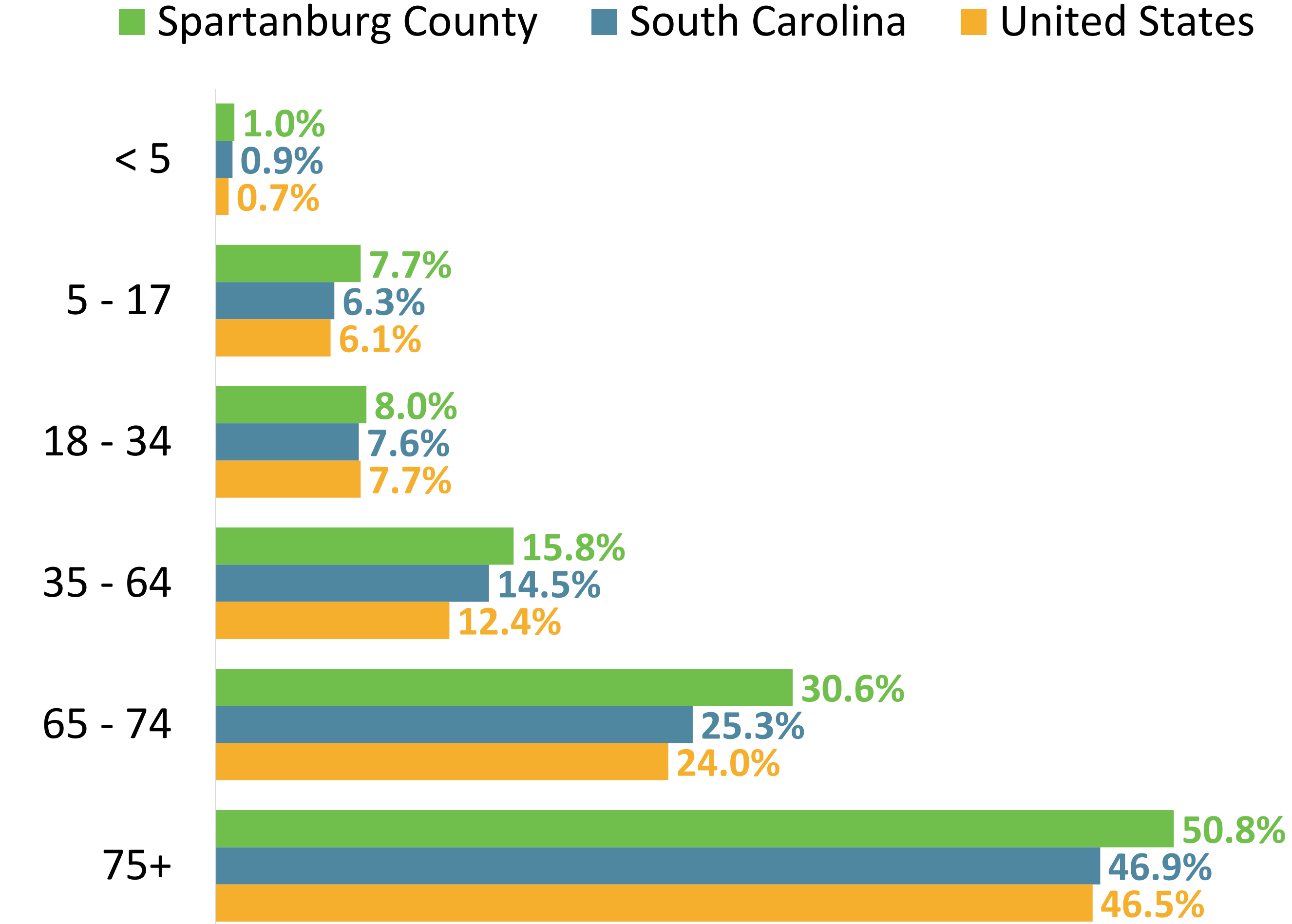

Population With a Disability, by Age Group

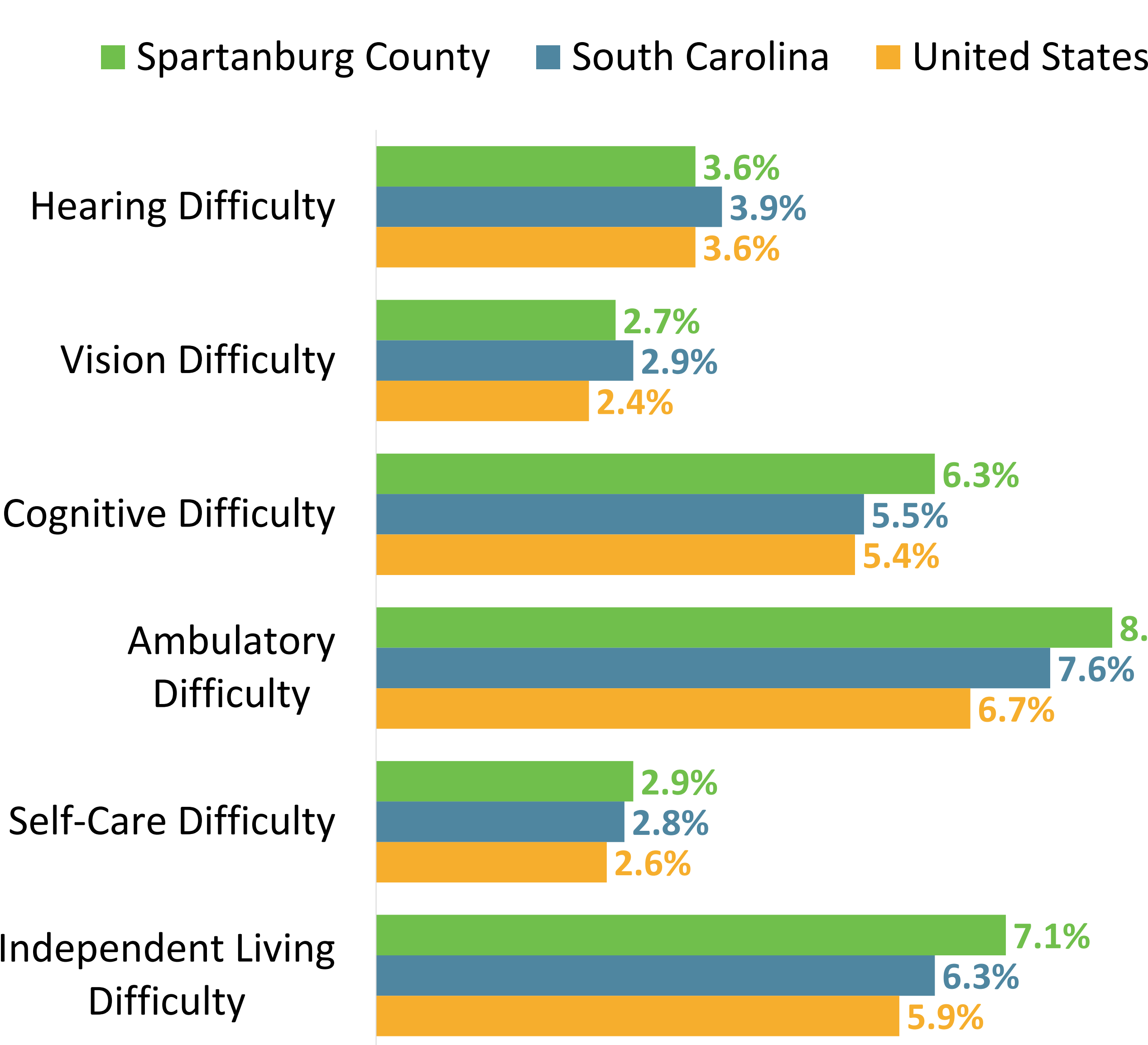

Population With a Disability, by Type

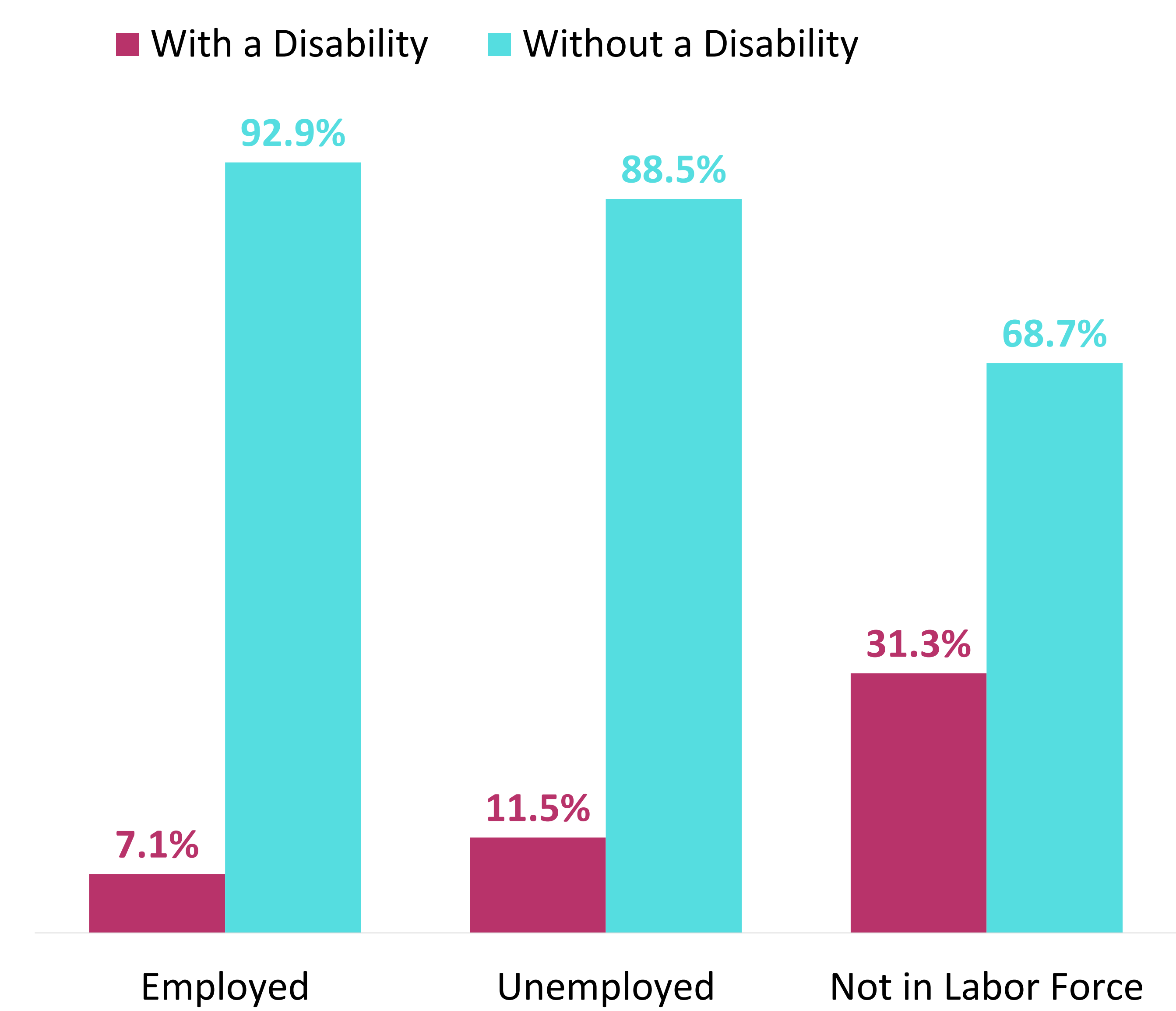

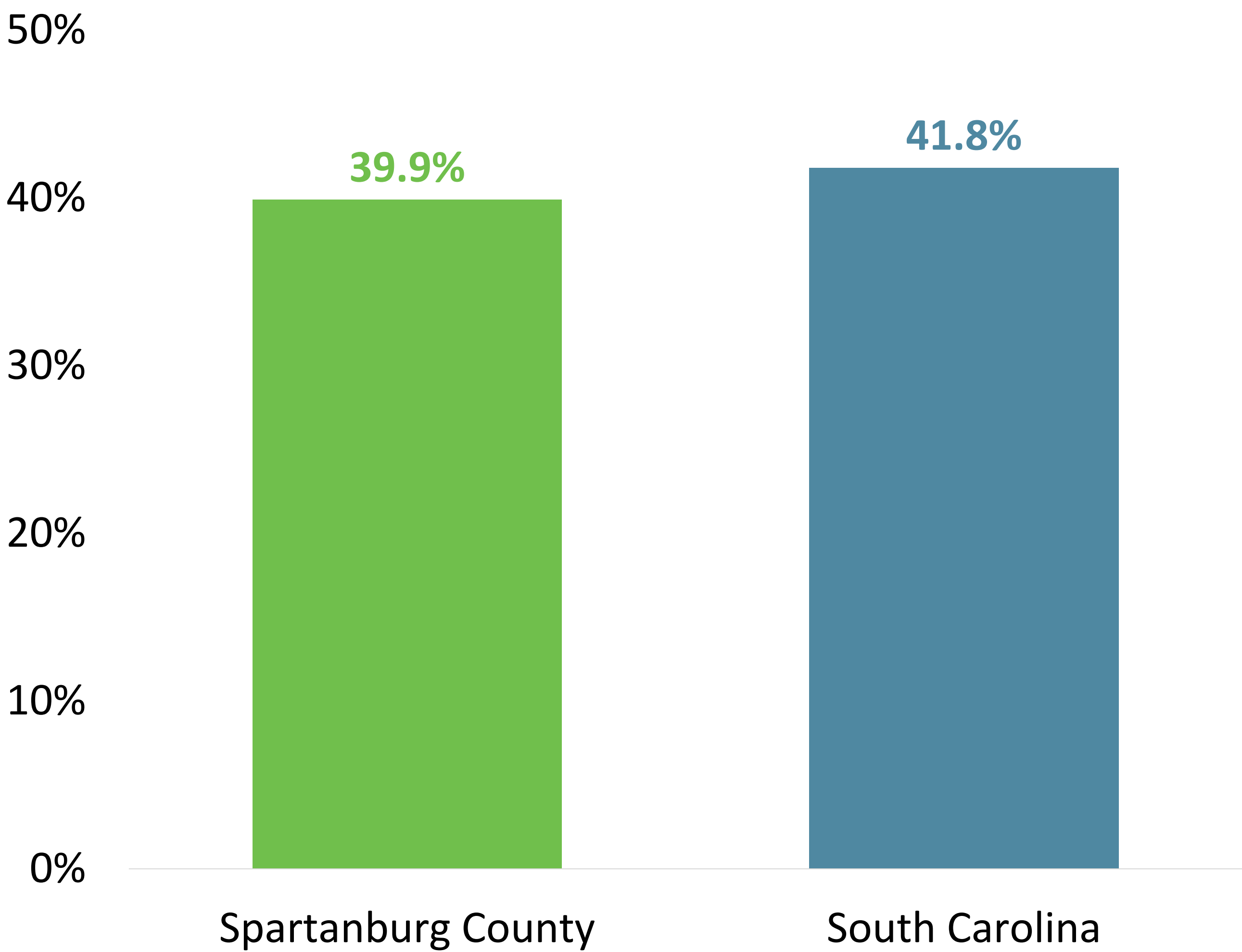

Severe Renter Cost Burden

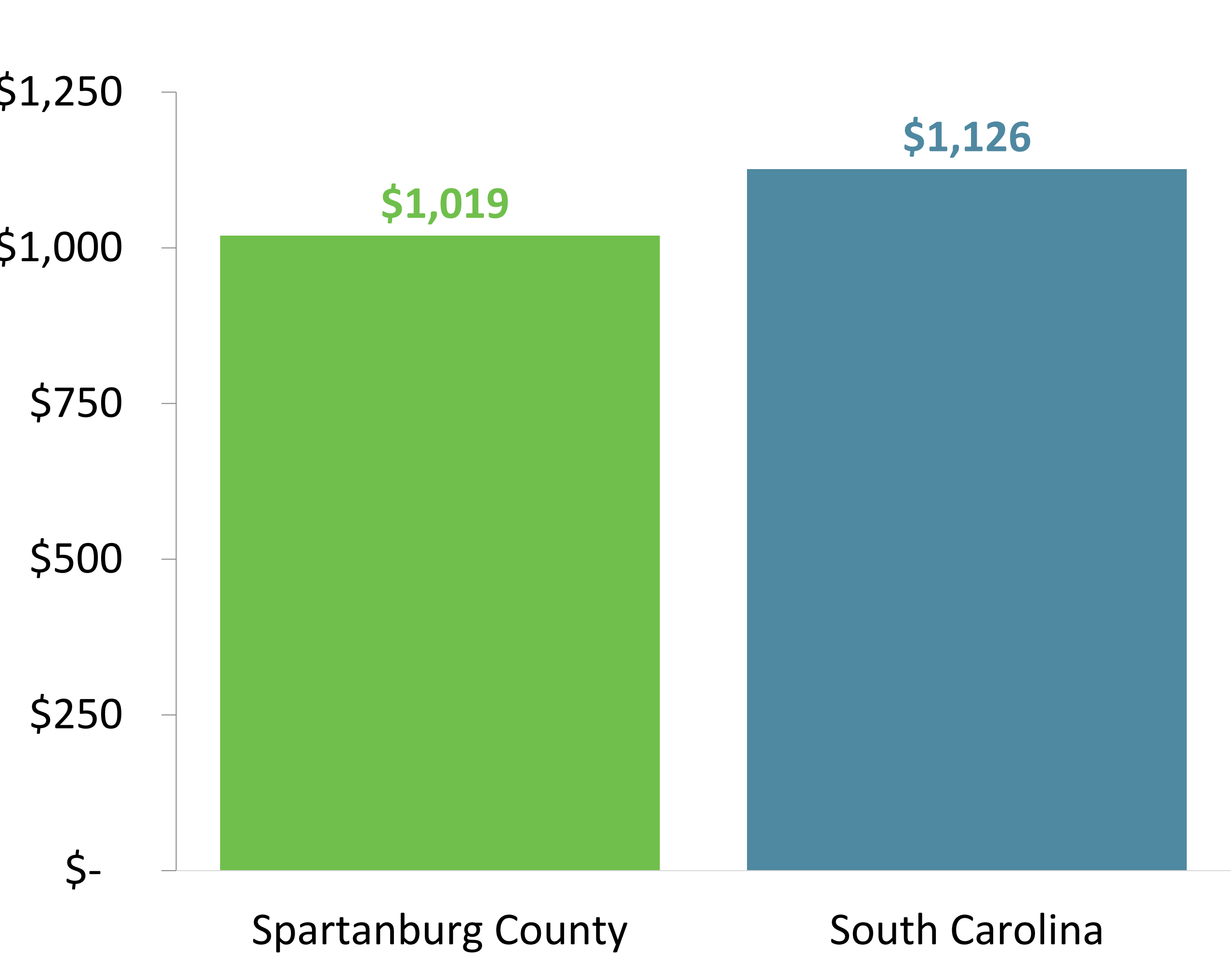

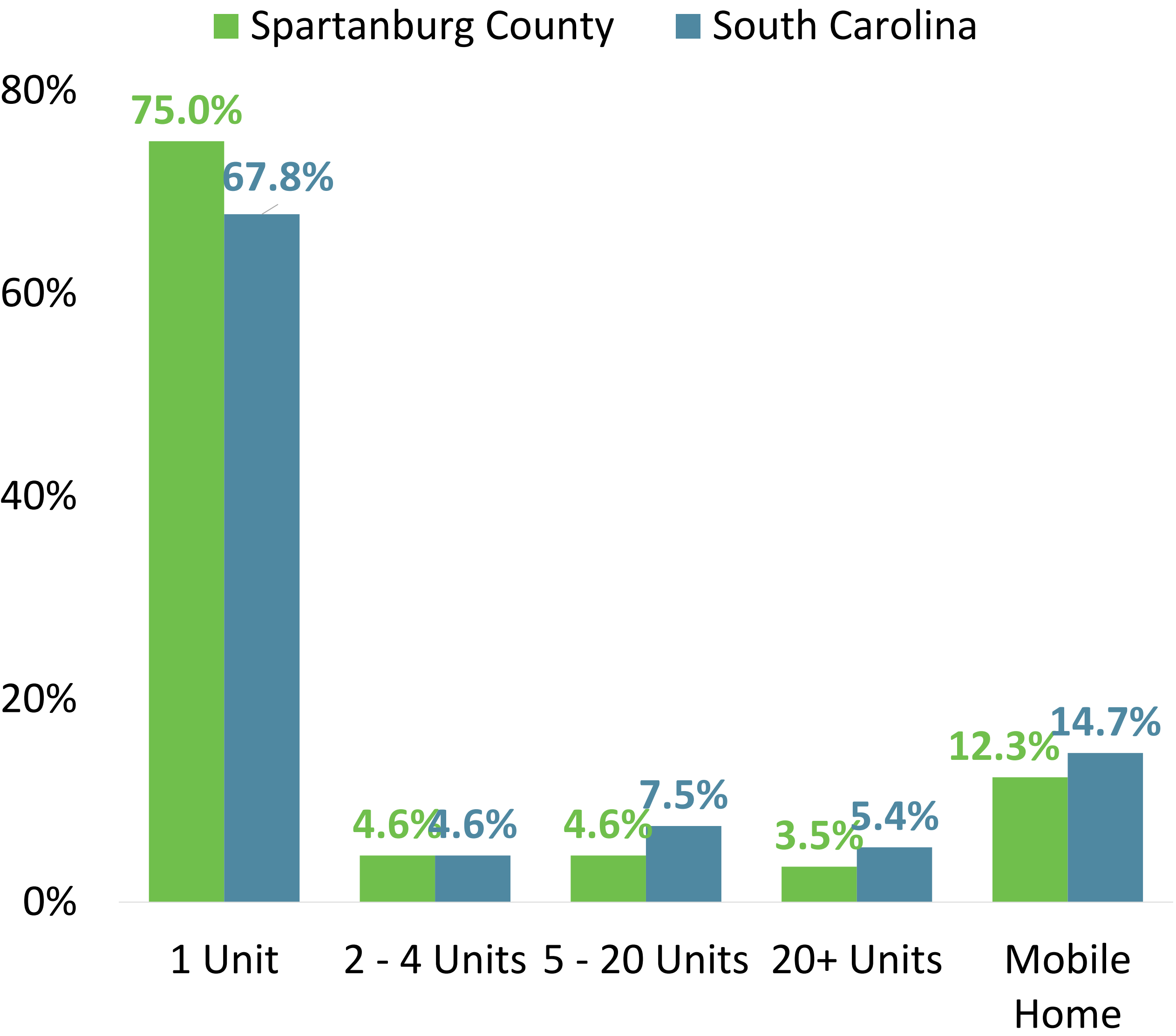

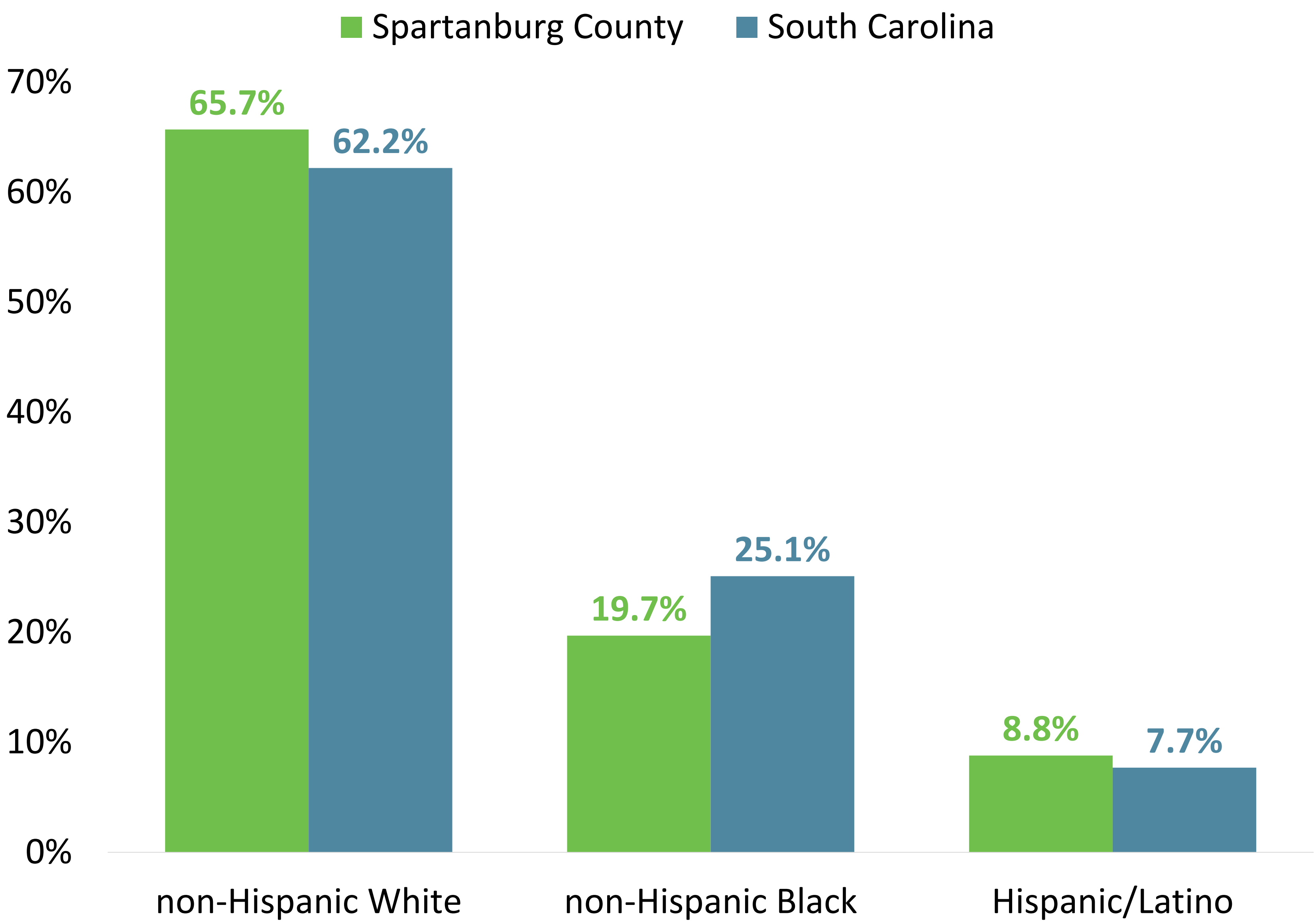

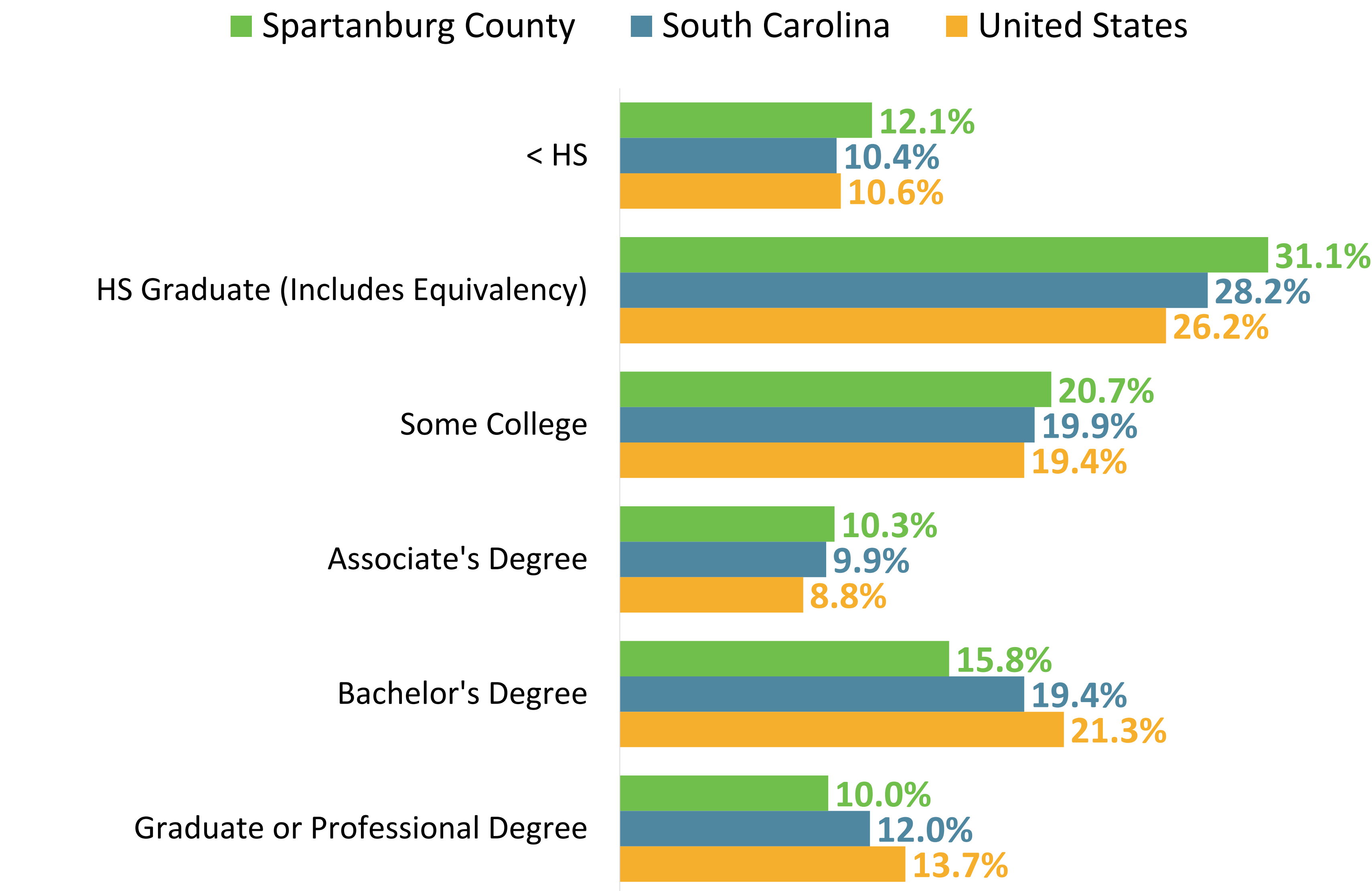

Educational Attainment Among Those 25+

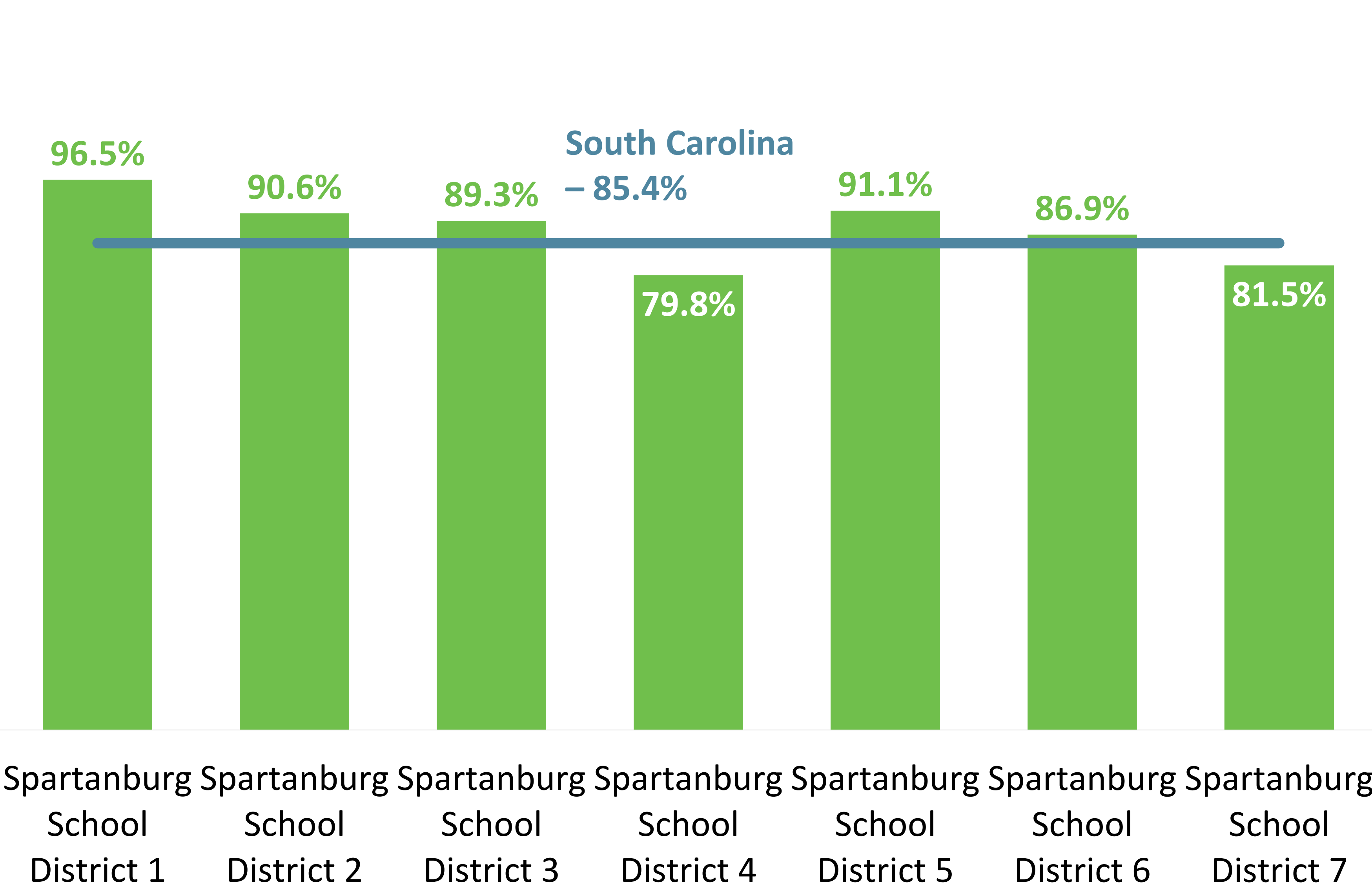

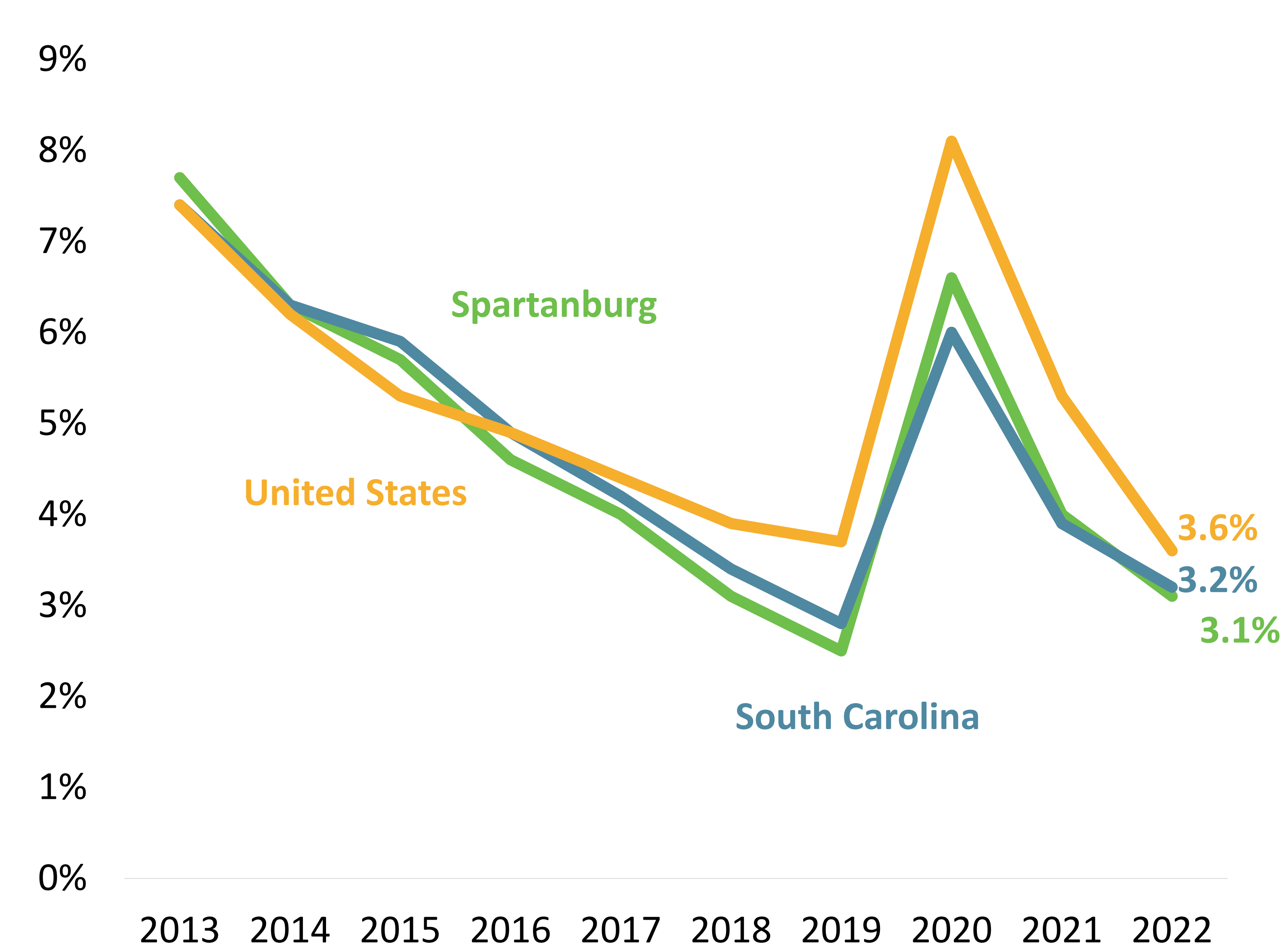

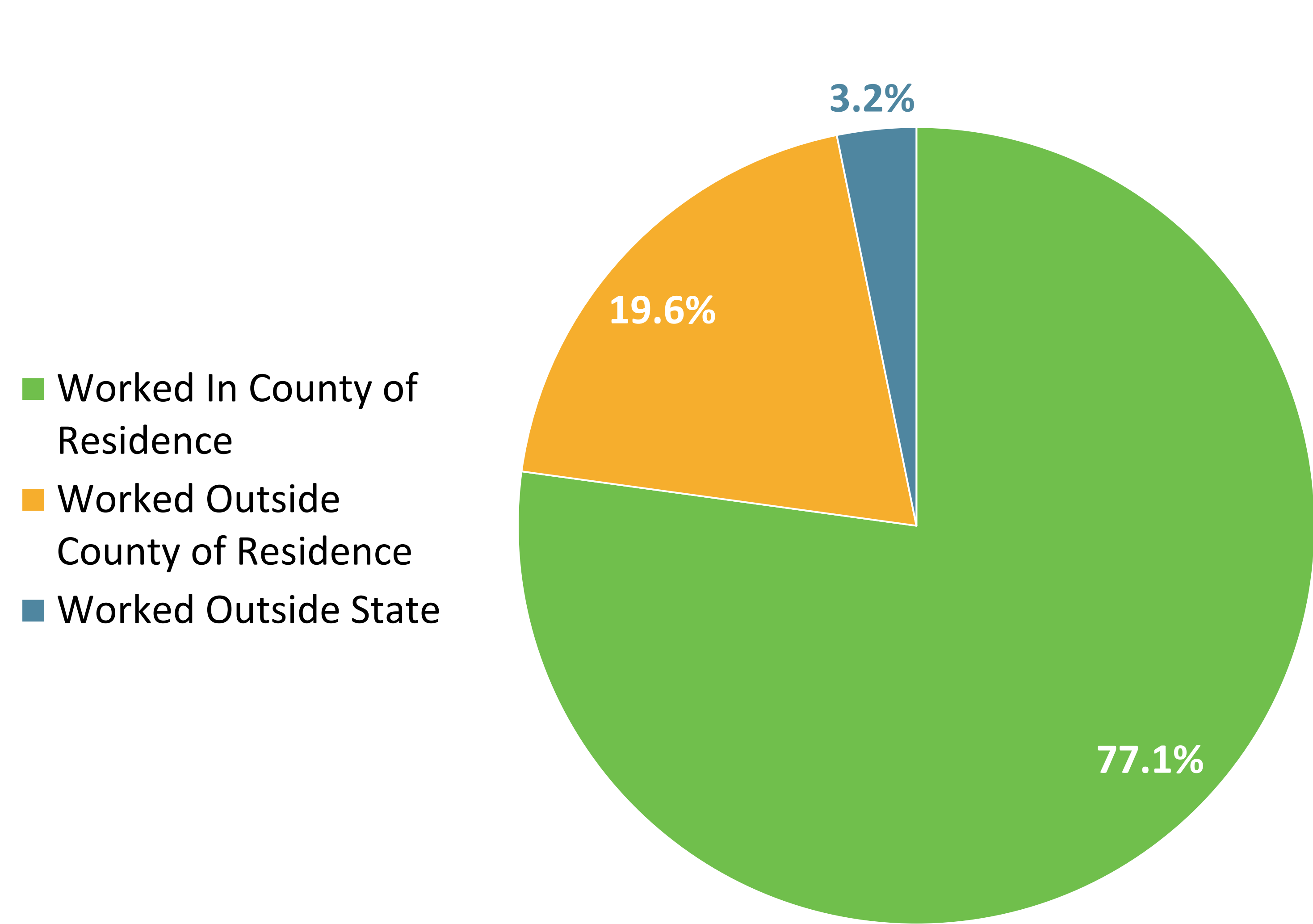

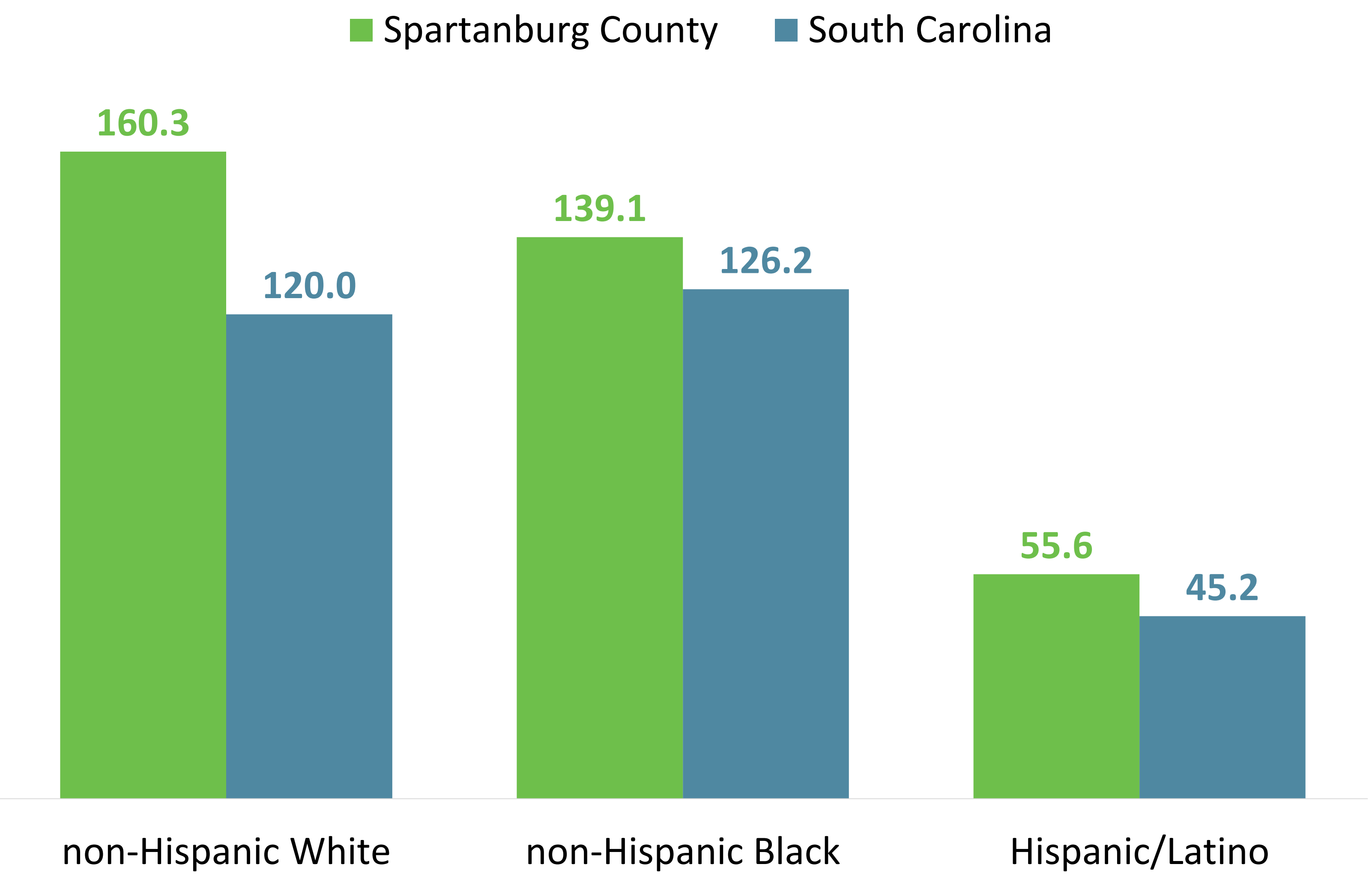

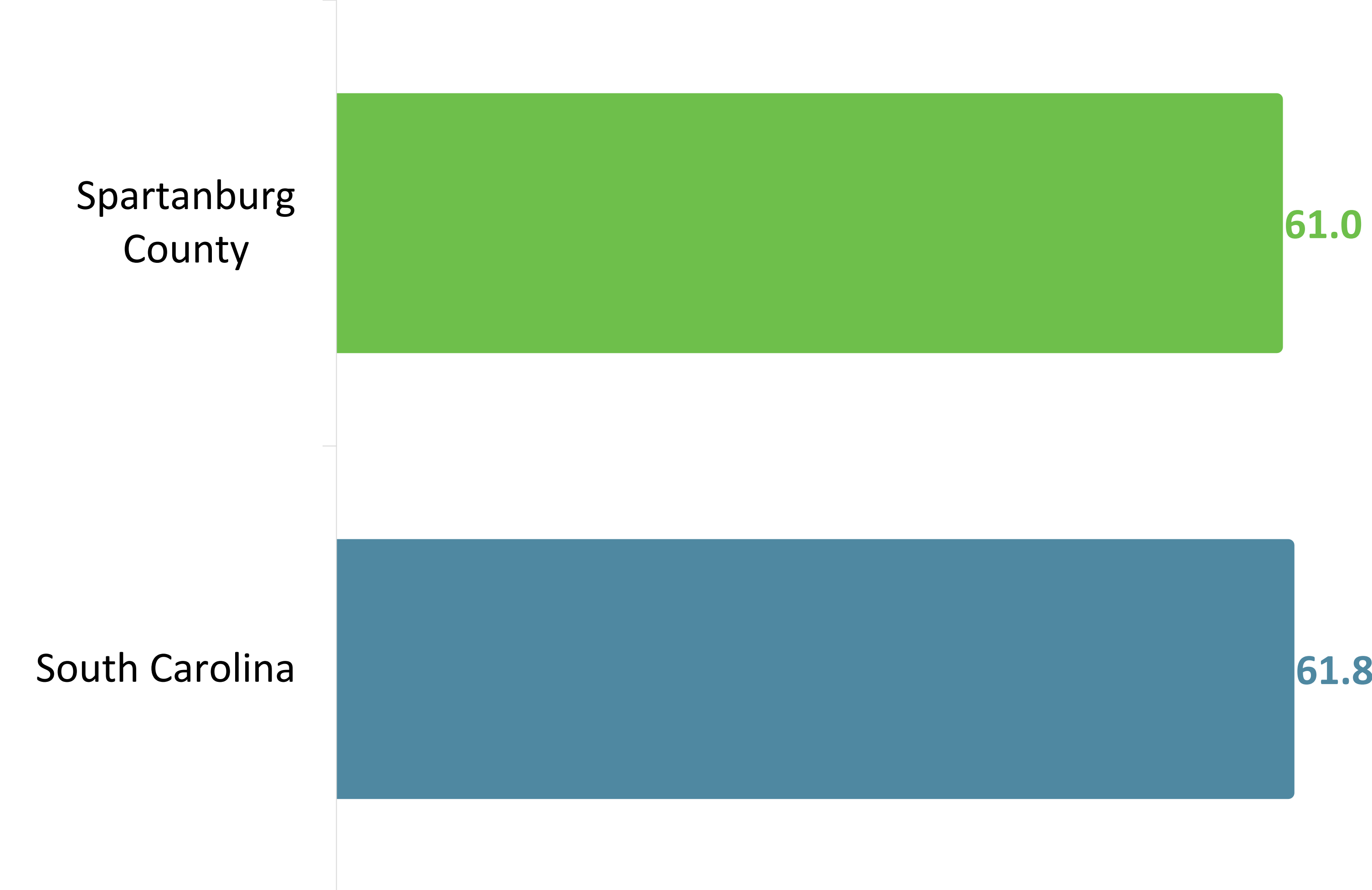

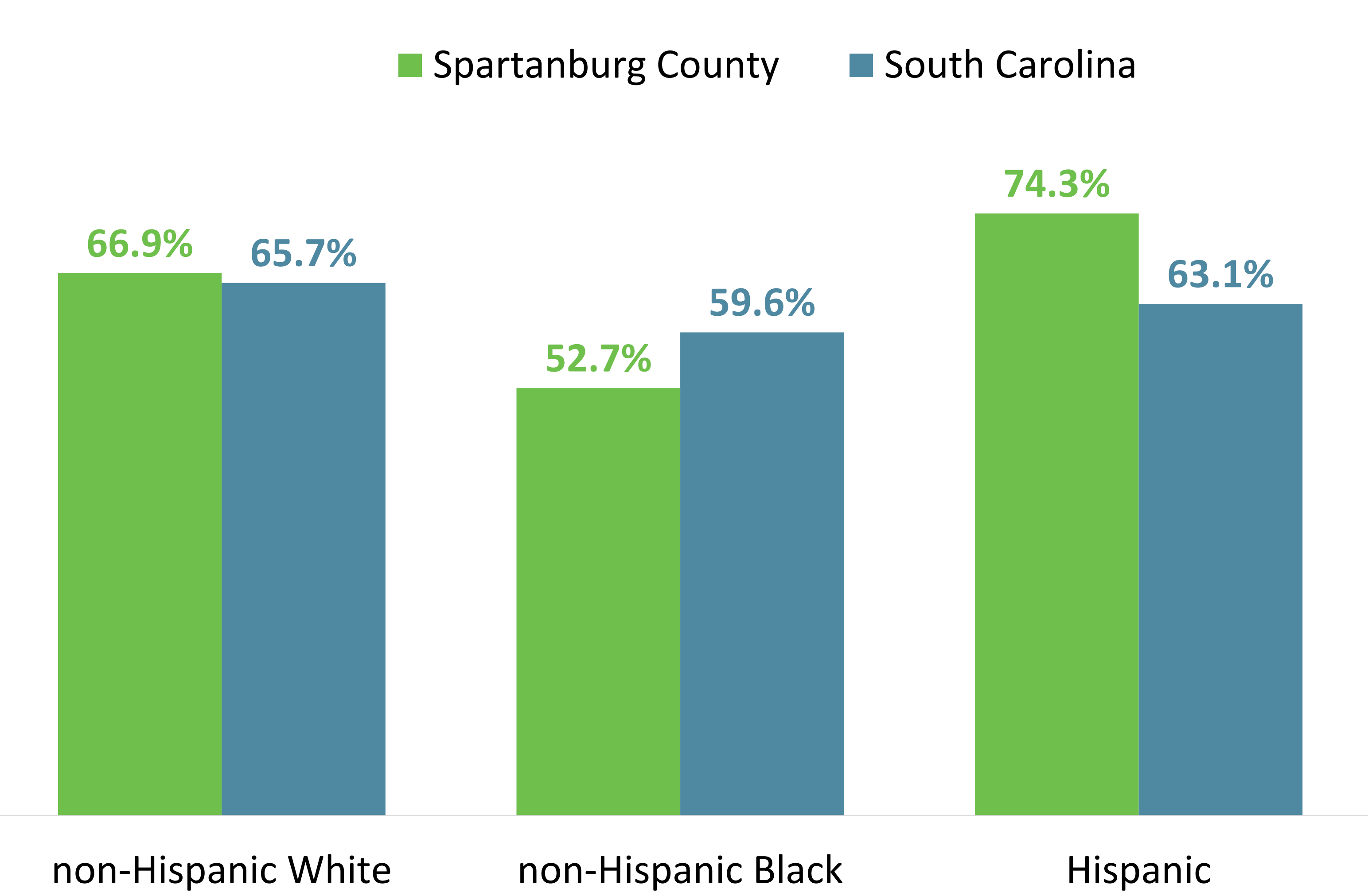

Adults 65 and Older Receiving a Flu Vaccine, by Race/Ethnicity

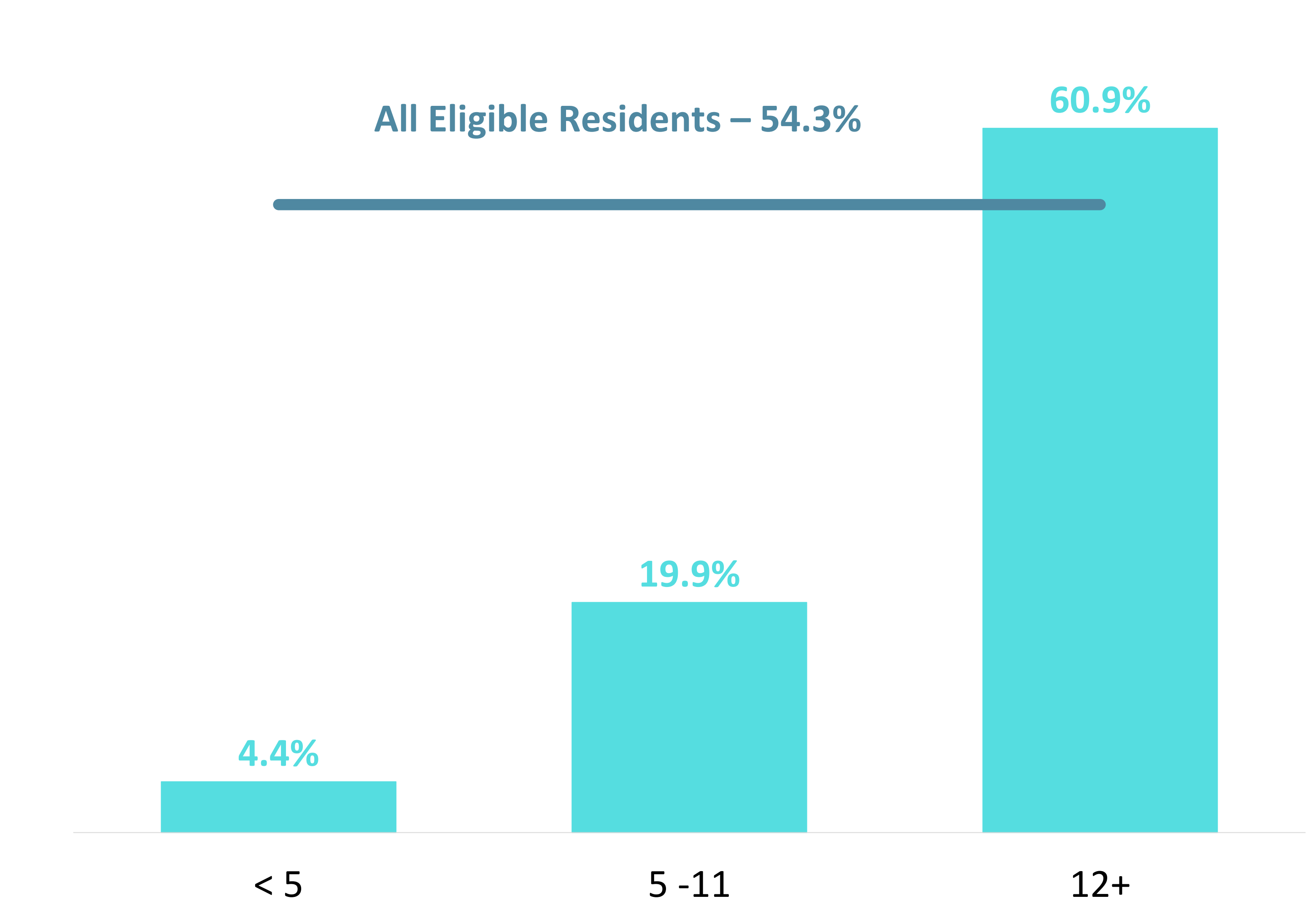

Complete Primary Series of COVID-19 Vaccine, by Age Group

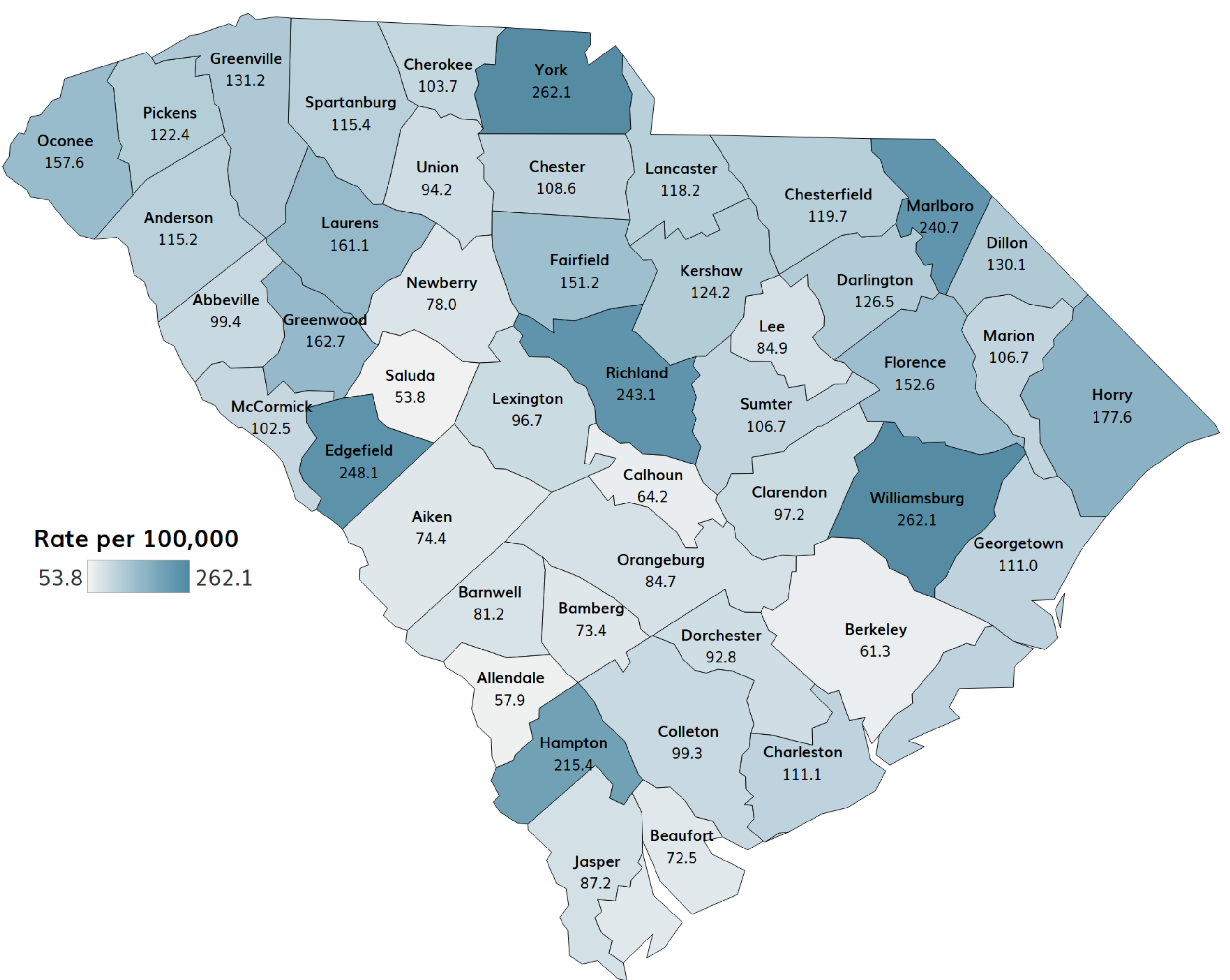

Chronic Hepatitis C, by County

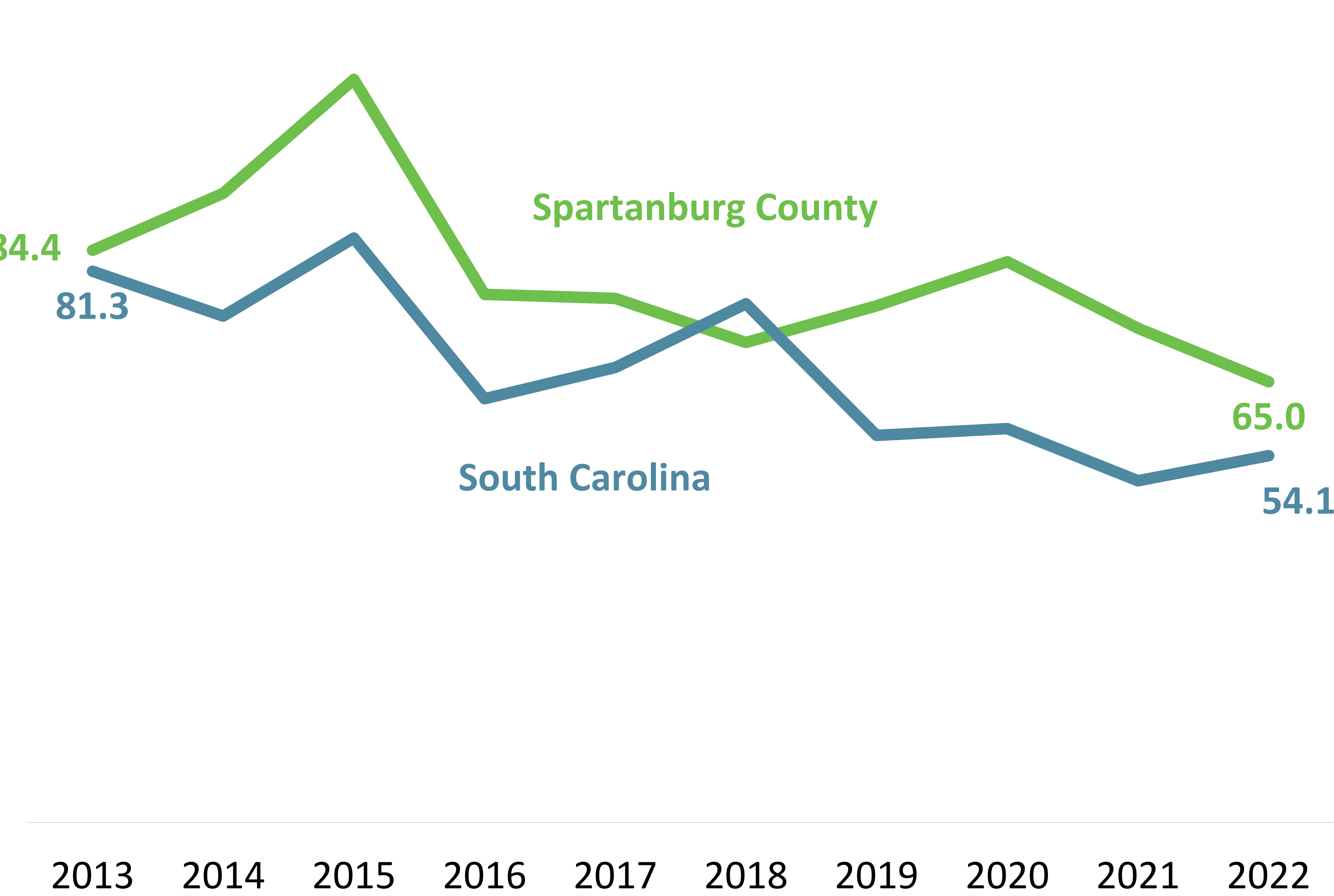

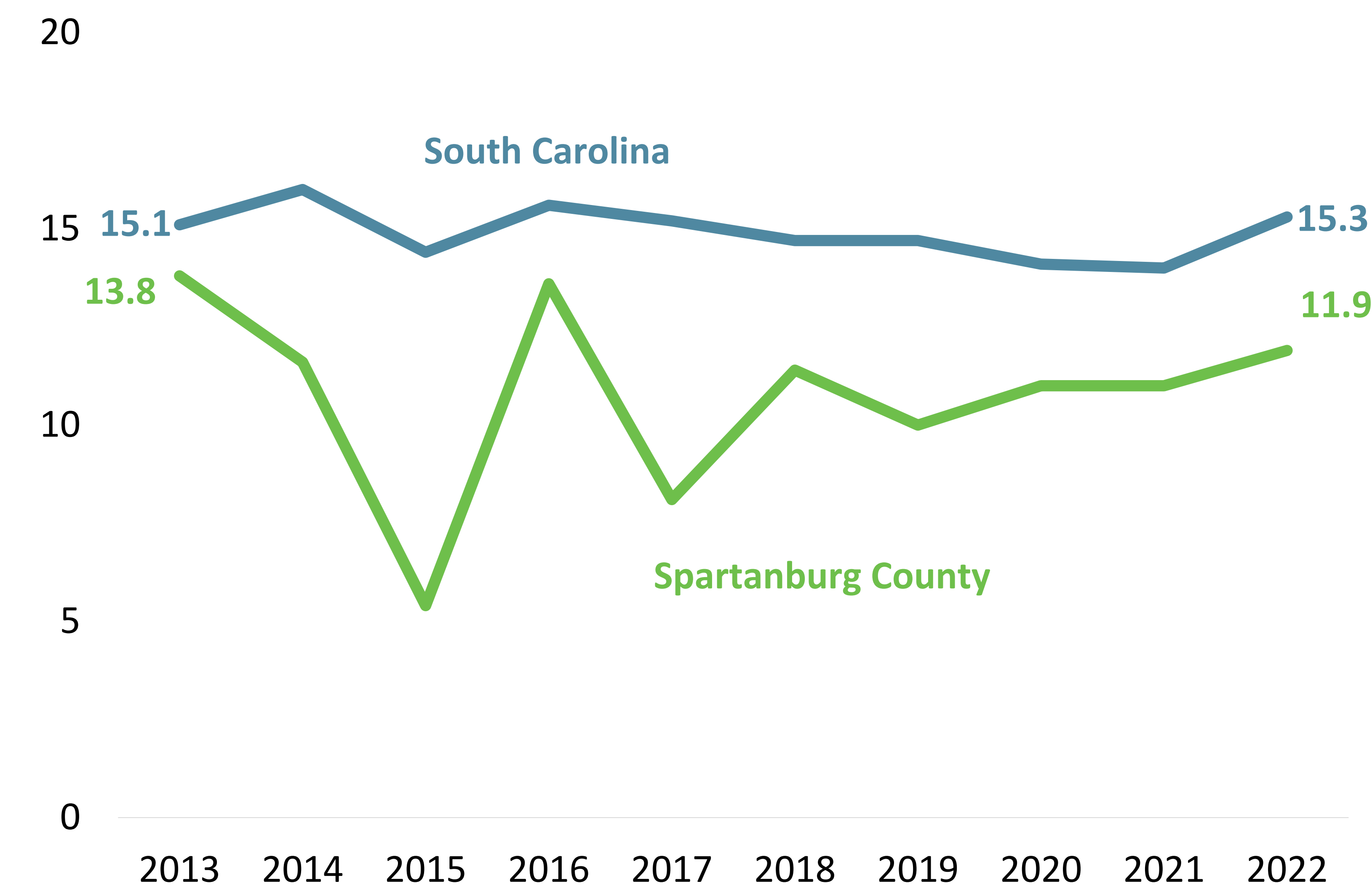

New HIV/AIDS Cases (Incidence)

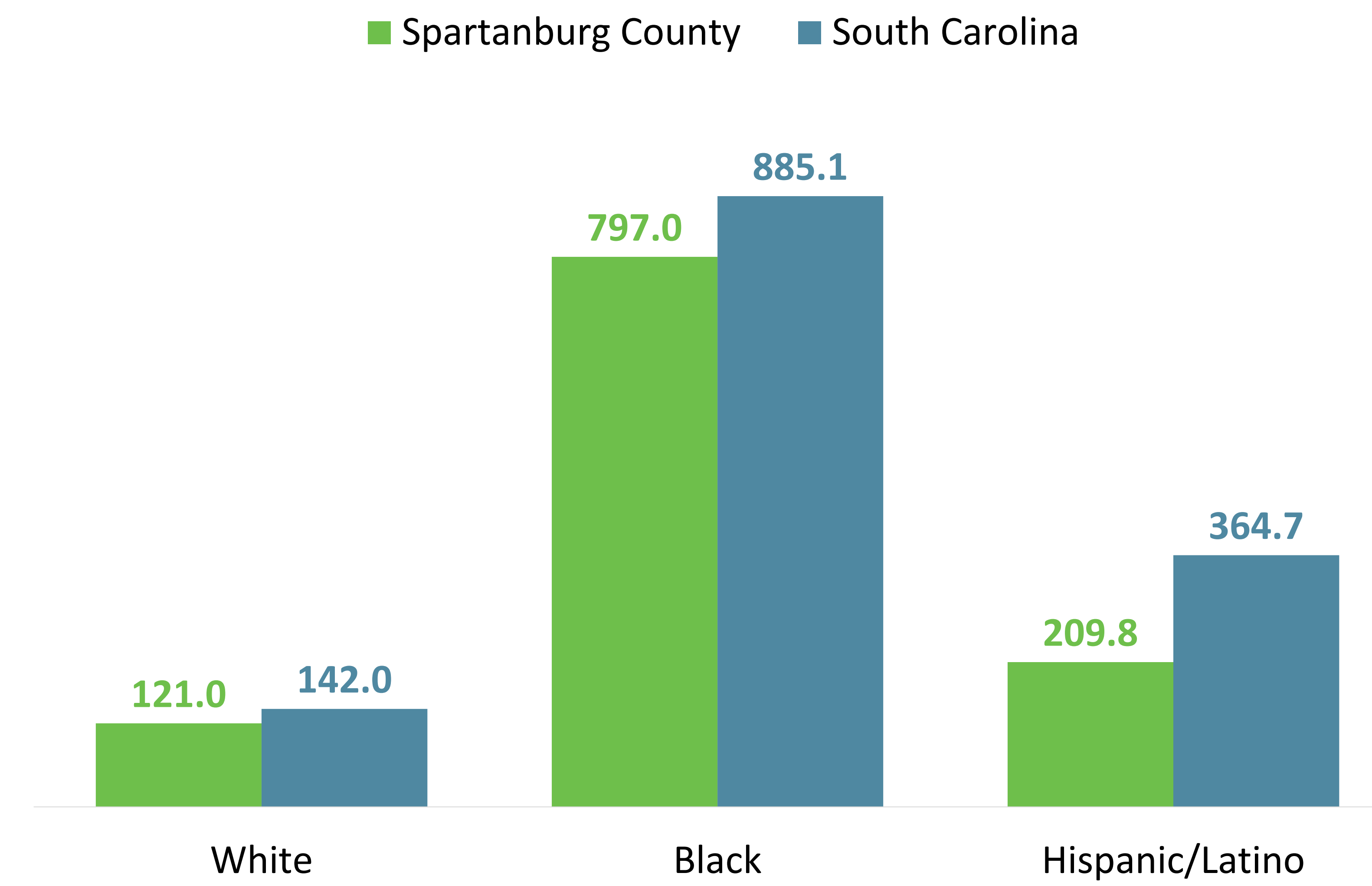

People living with HIV/AIDS (Prevalence), by Race/Ethnicity

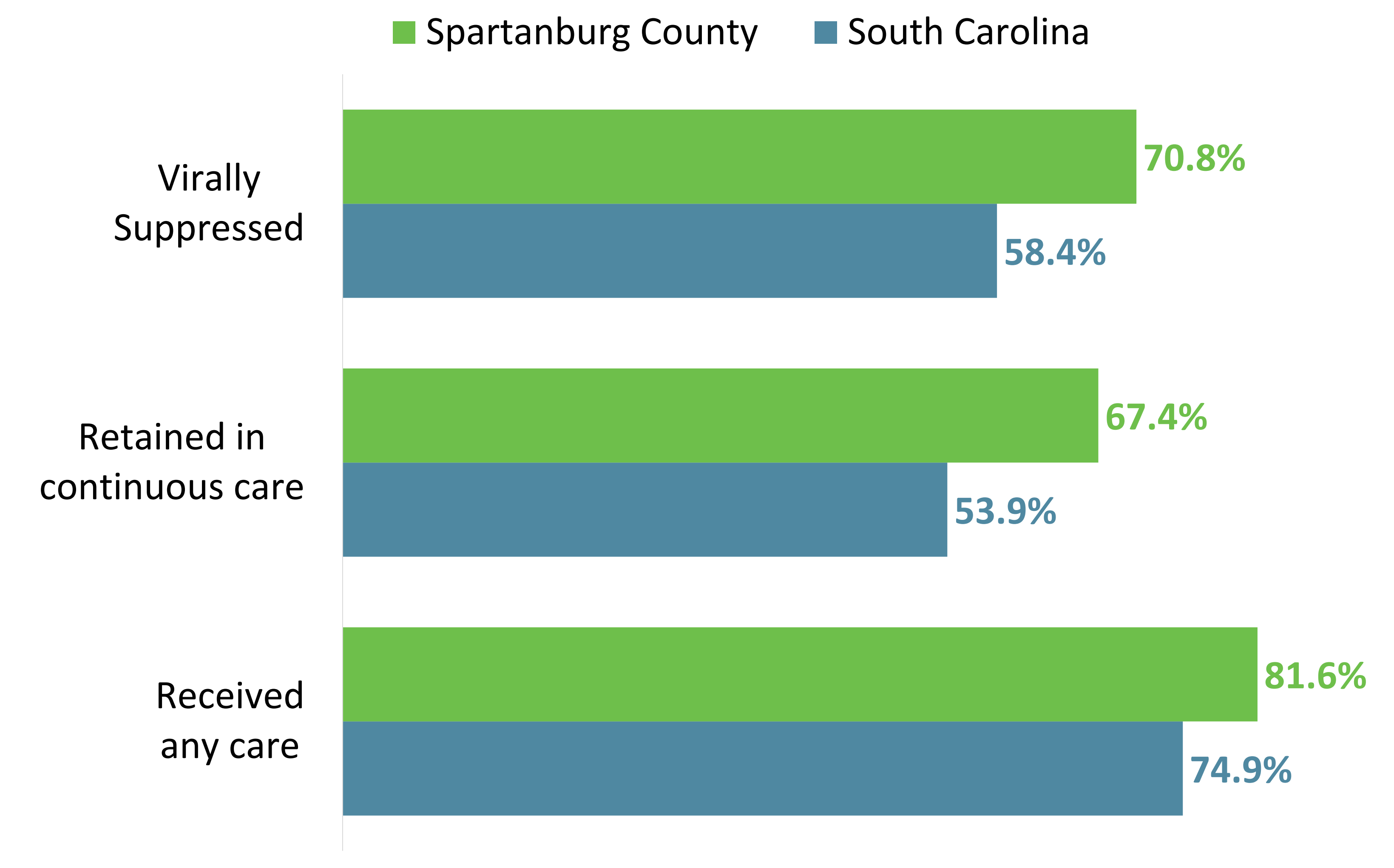

Continuum of Care Status

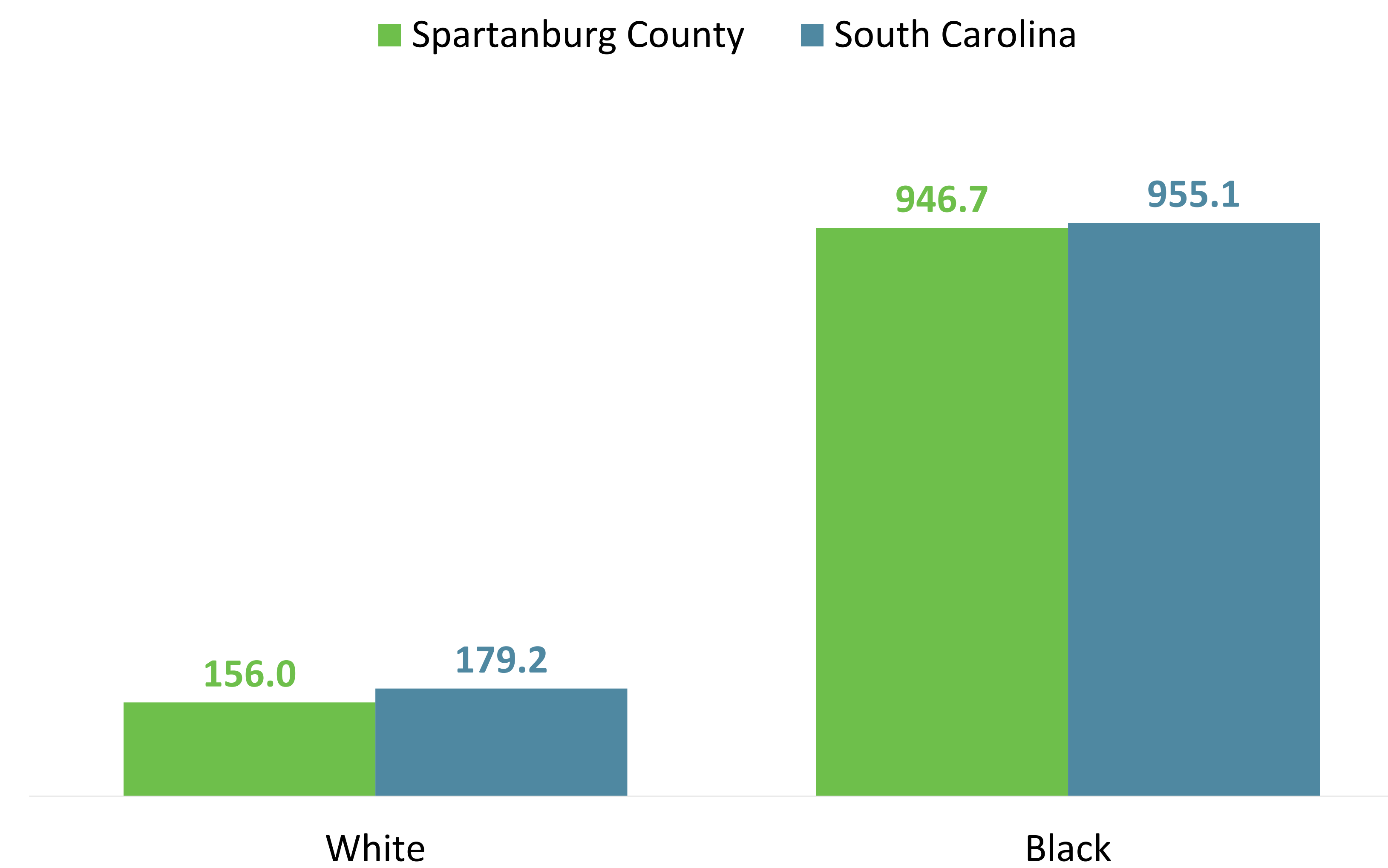

New Chlamydia Infections, by Race (Incidence)

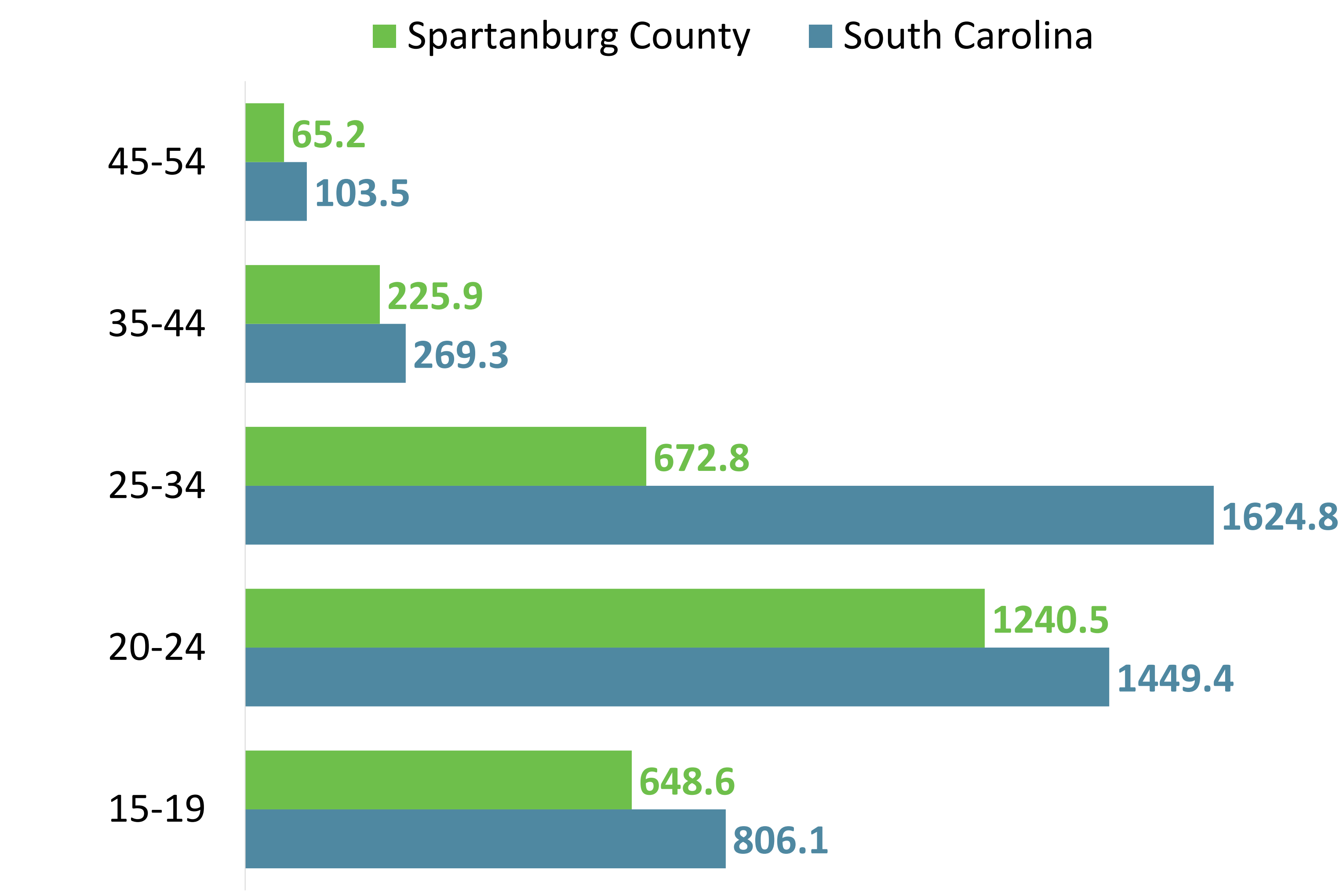

New Gonorrhea Infections, by Age Group (Incidence)

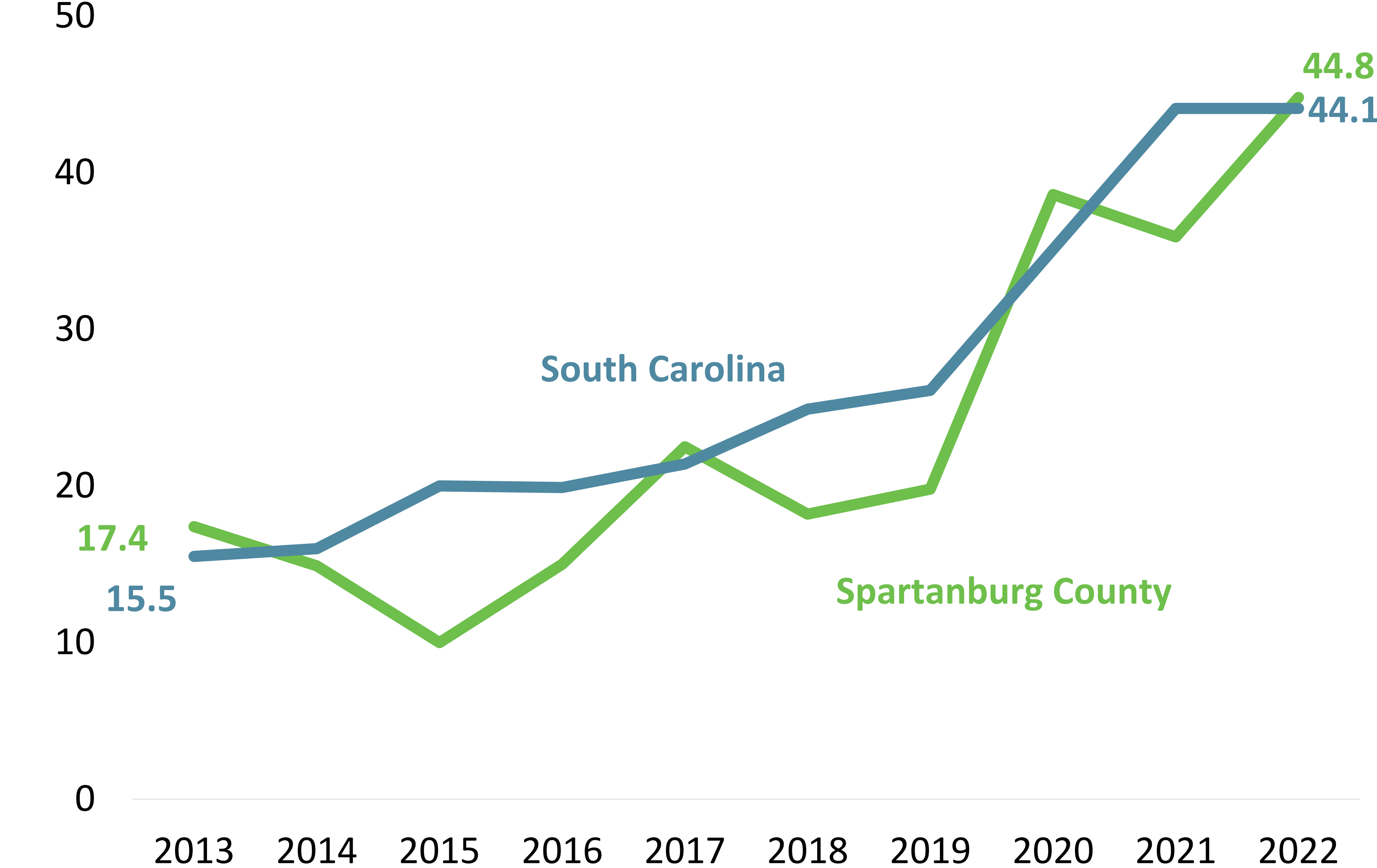

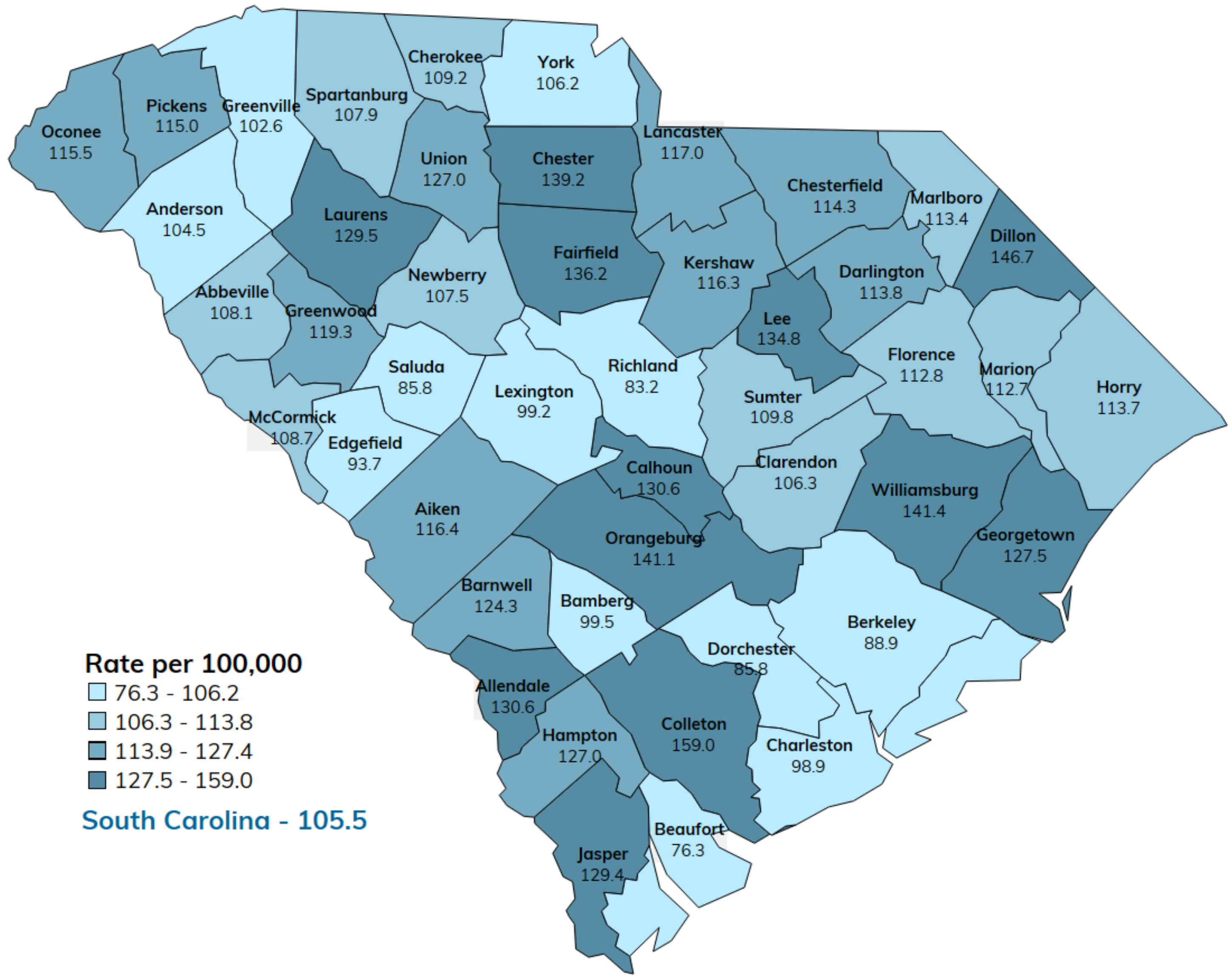

Overall Injury Deaths, by County

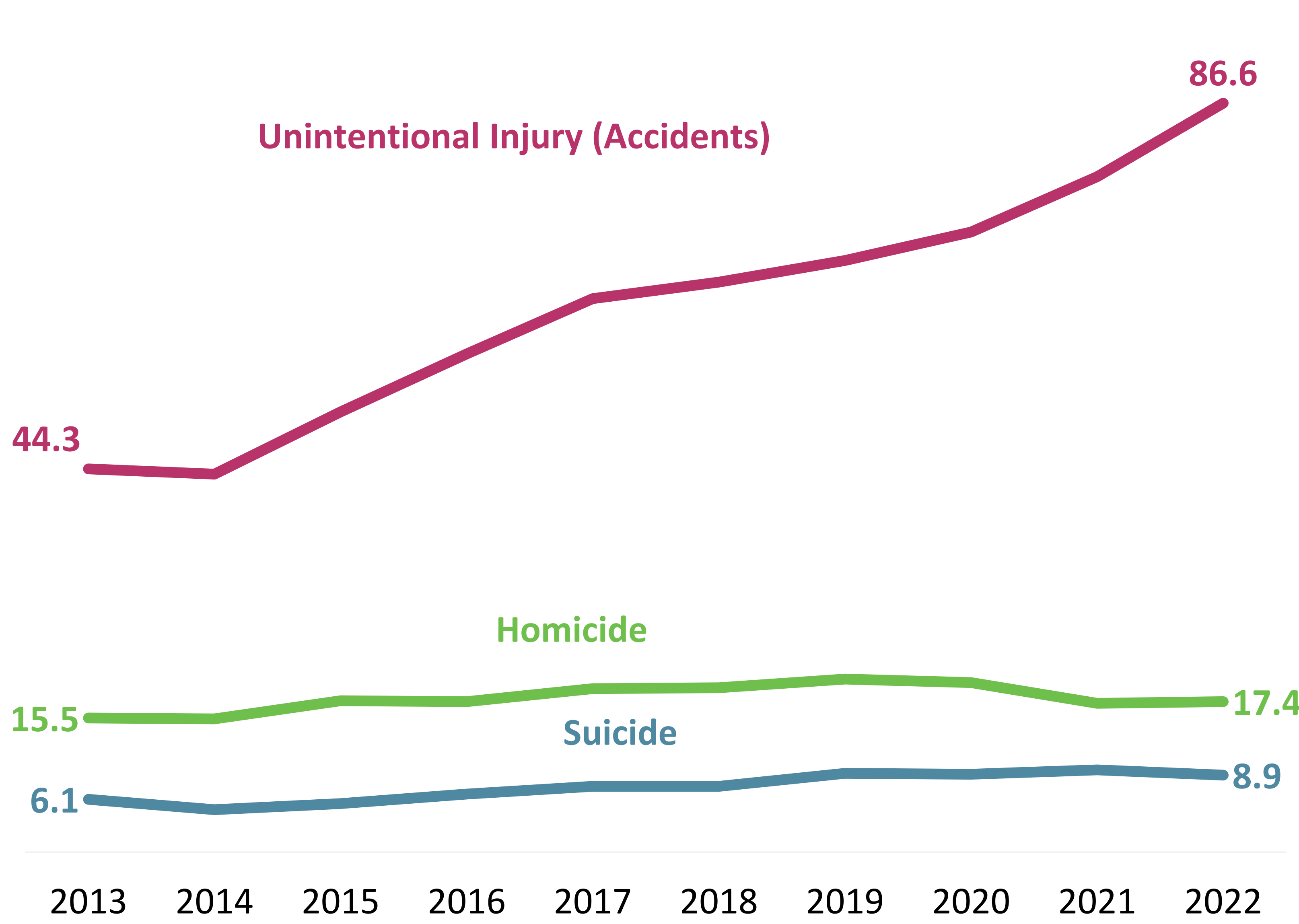

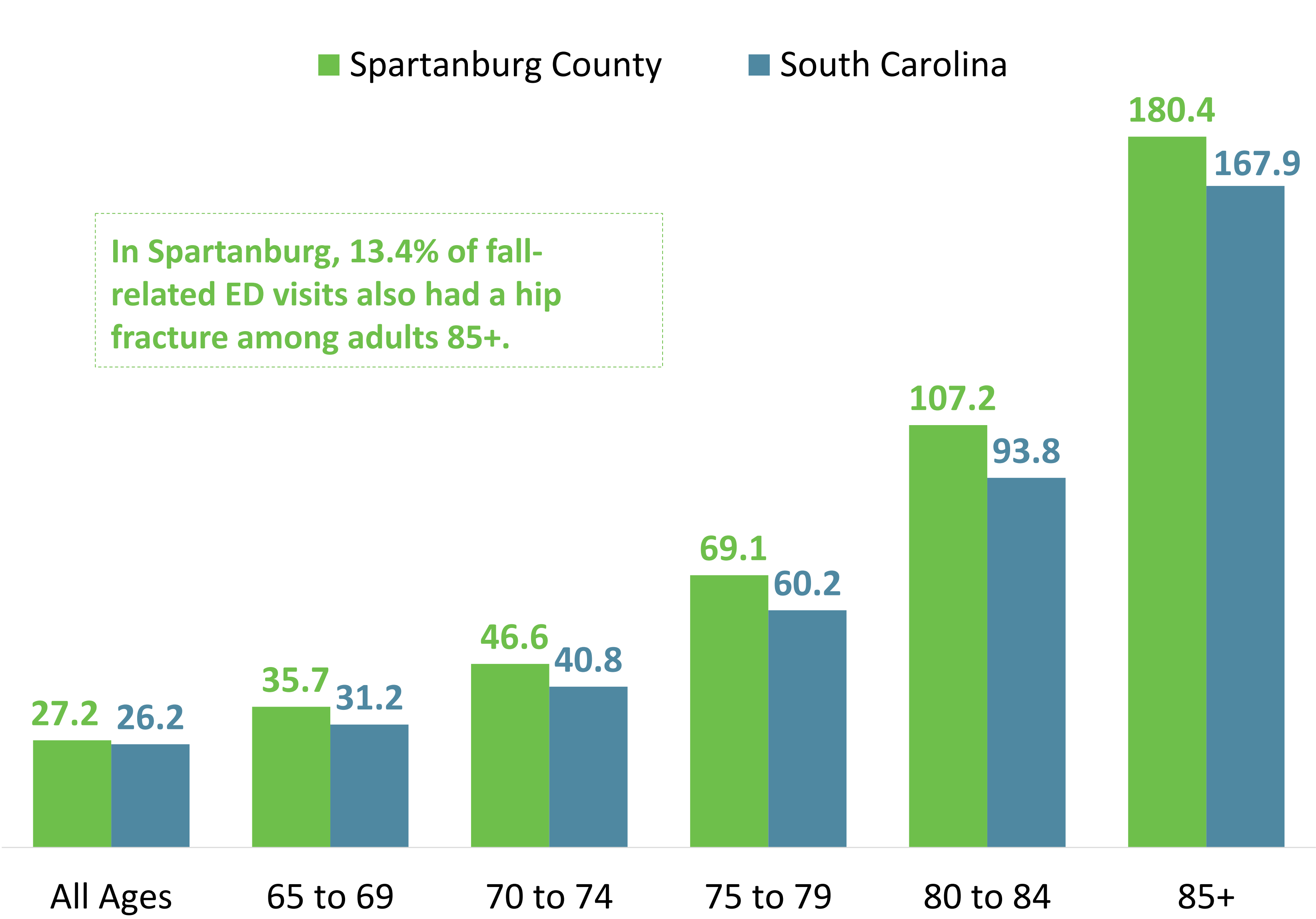

Fall-Related Emergency Department Visits, by Age Group

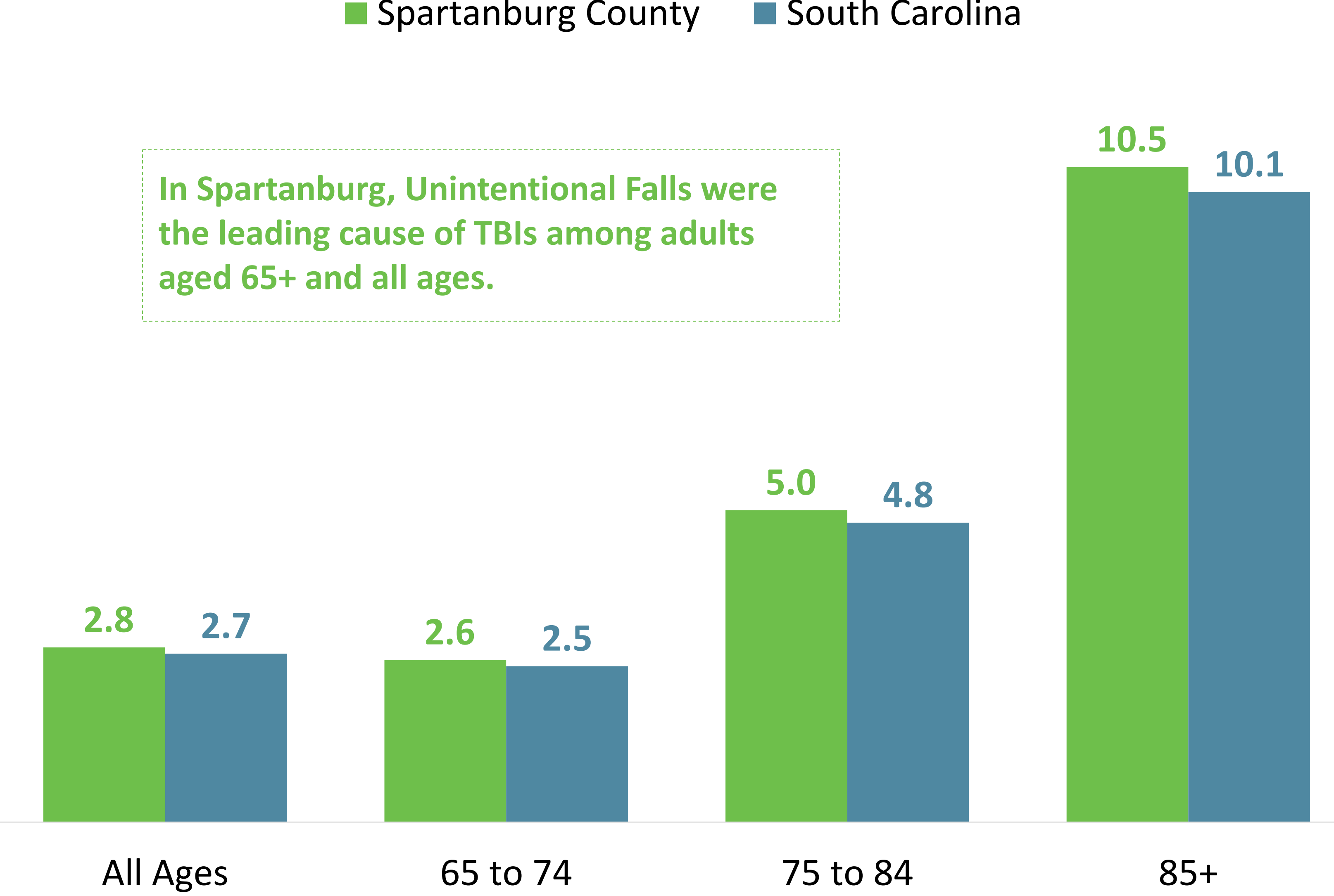

Traumatic Brain Injury-Related Emergency Department Visits, by Age Group

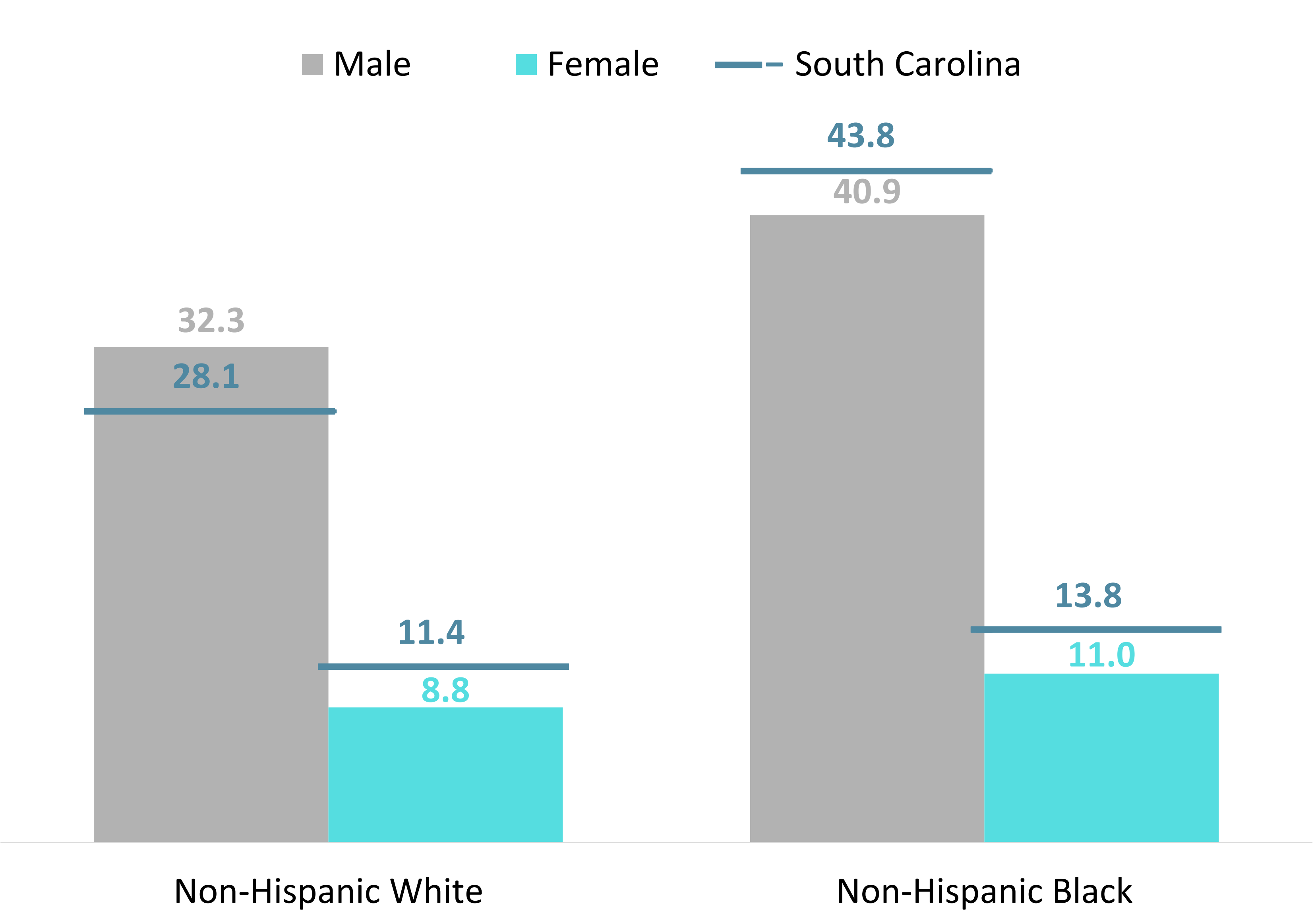

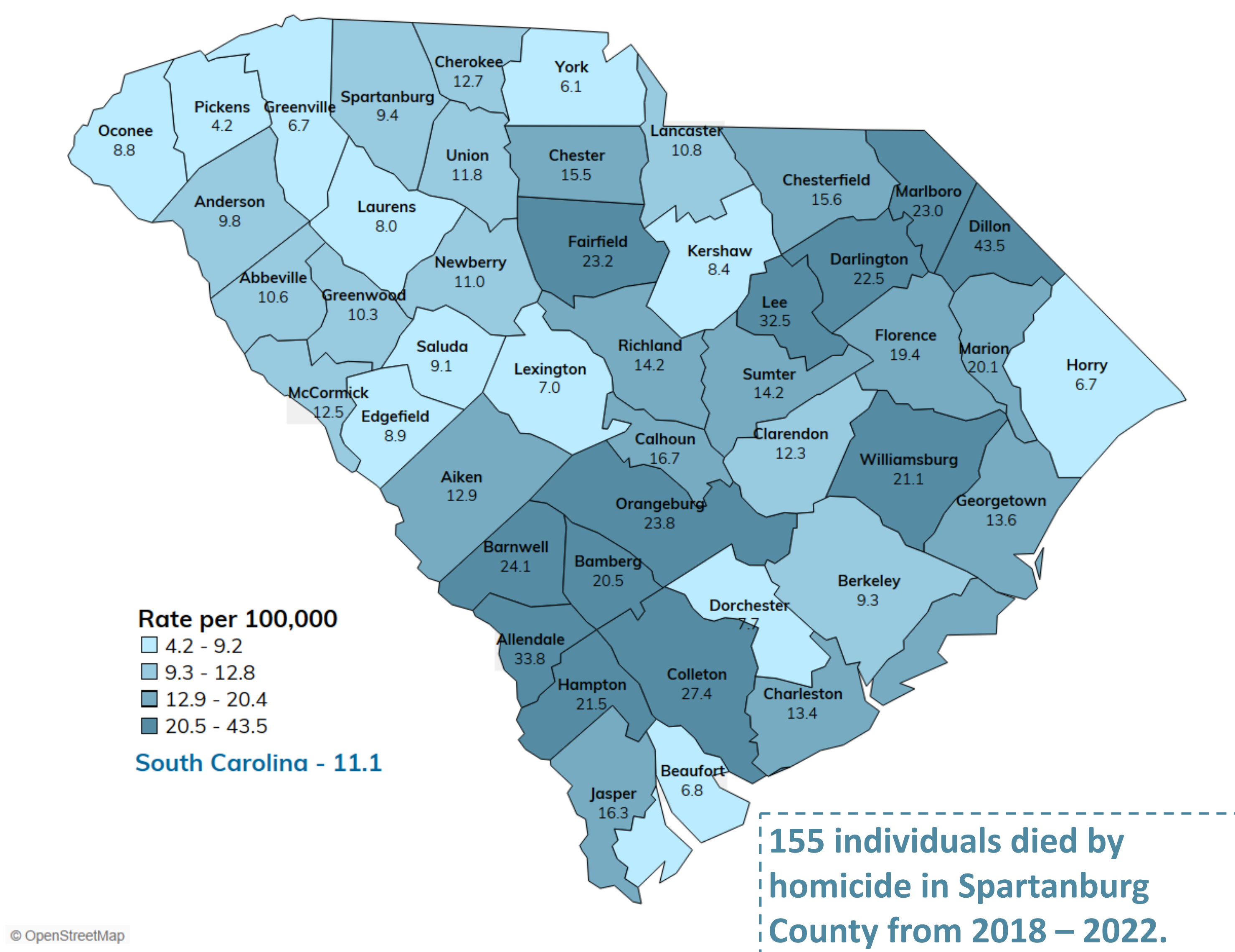

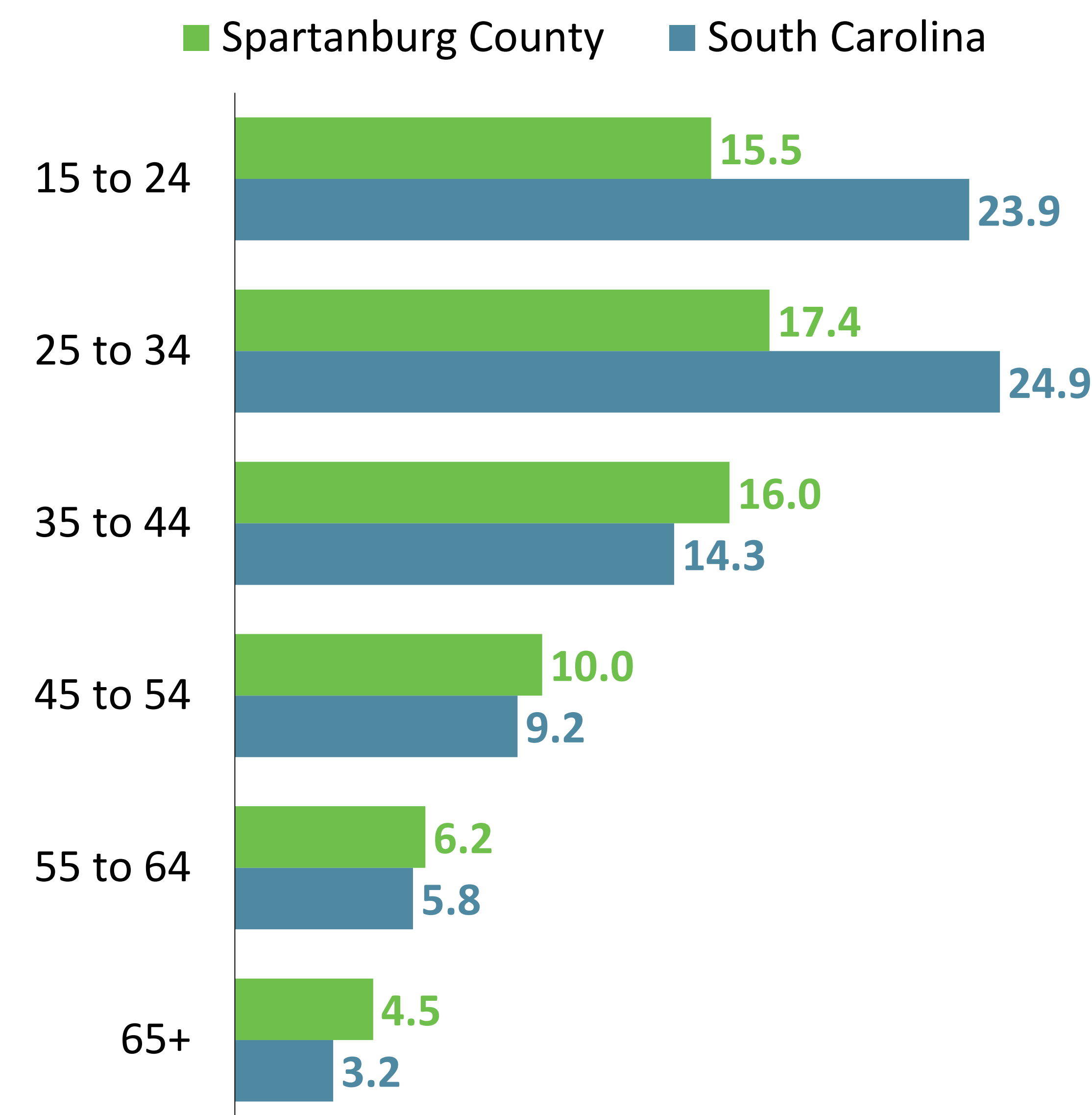

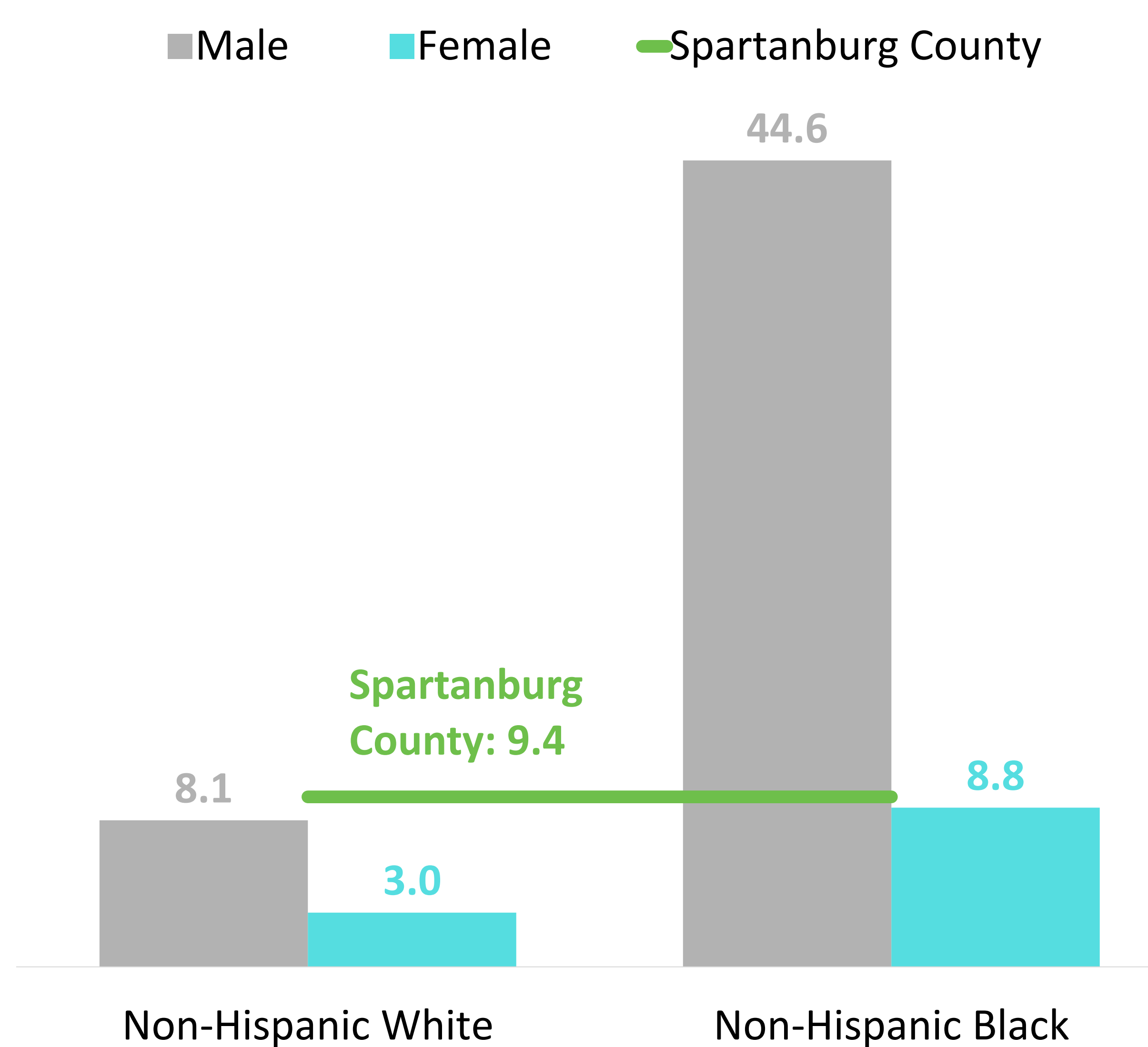
Homicides, by Age Group

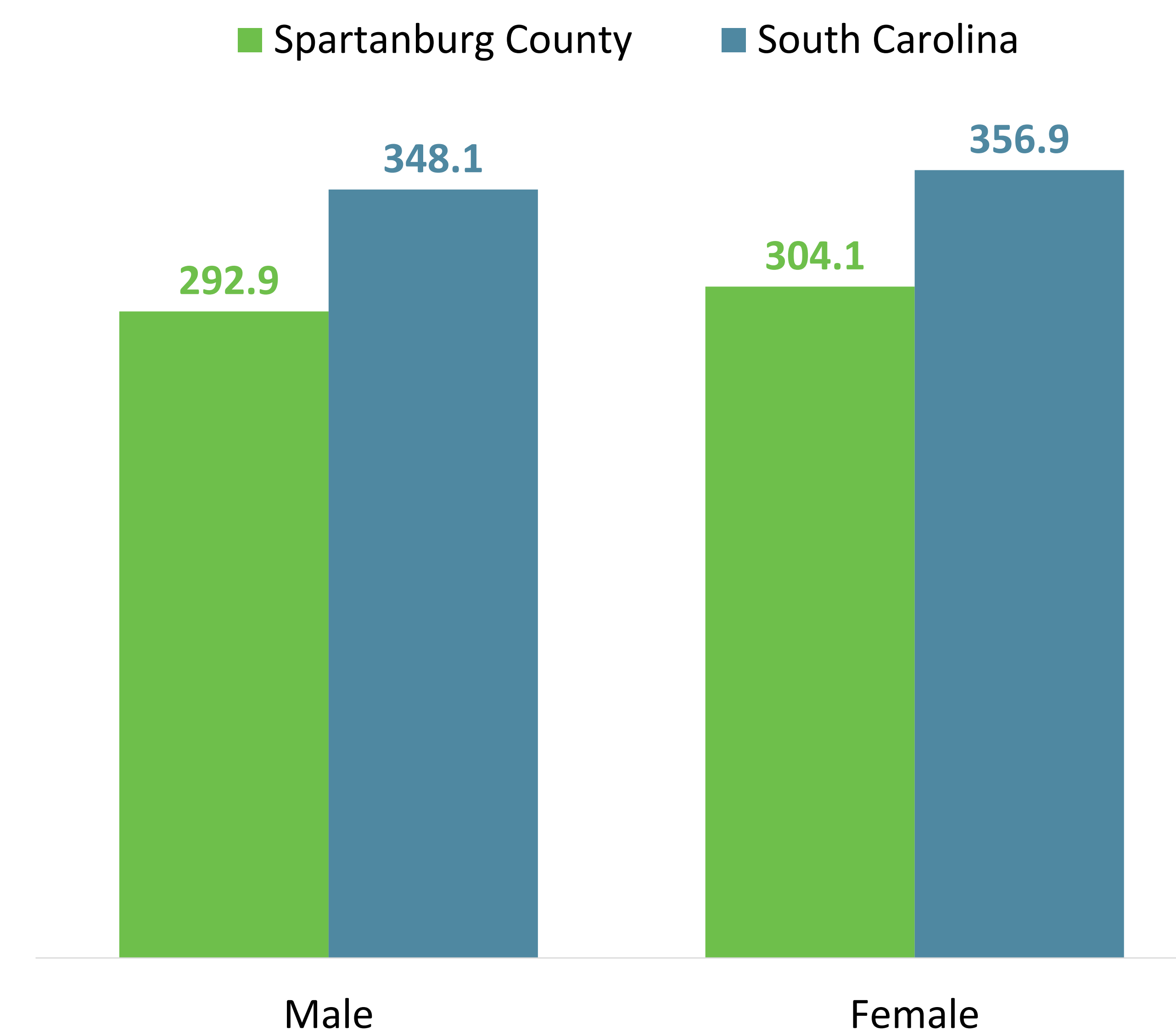

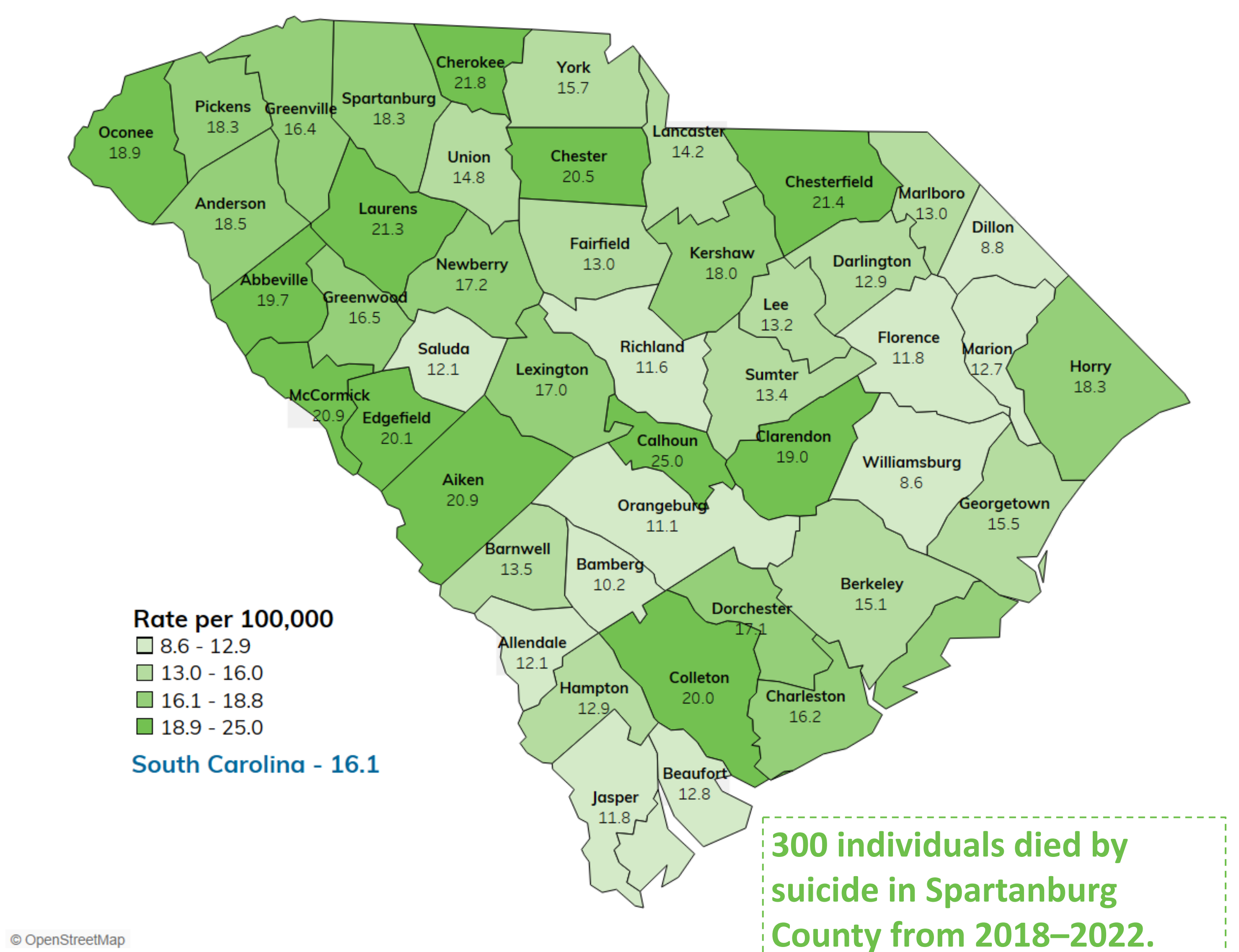

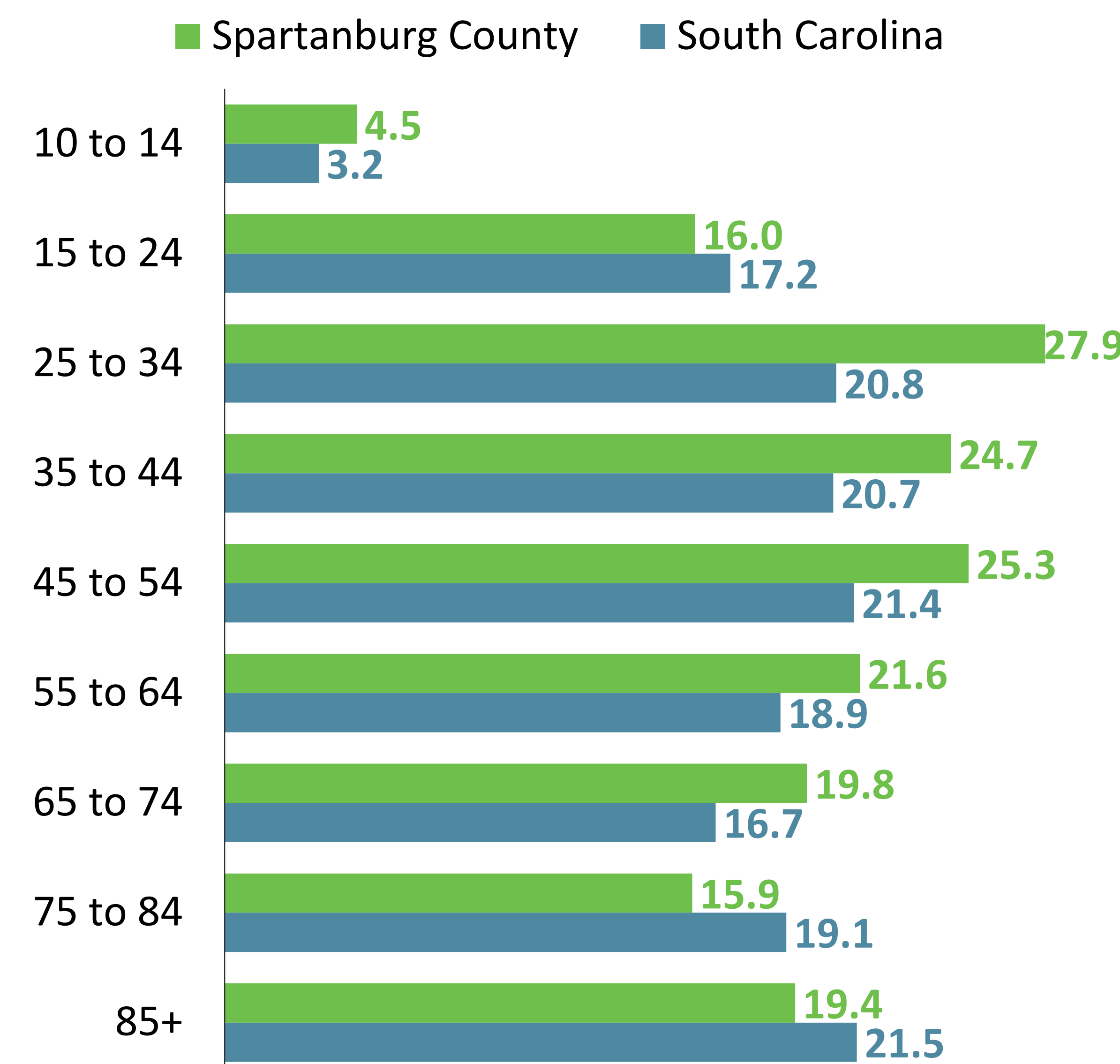

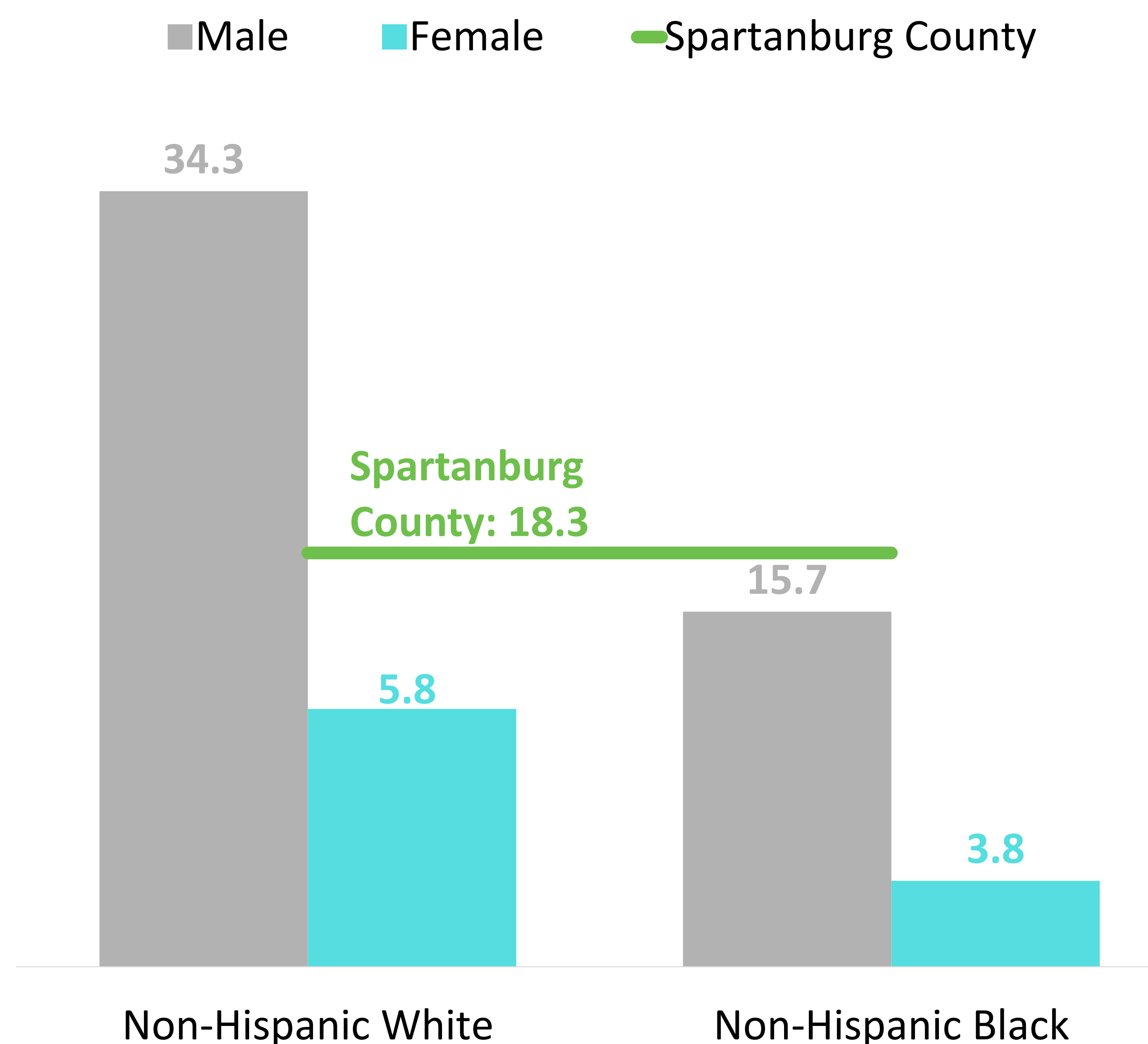
Suicides, by Age Group

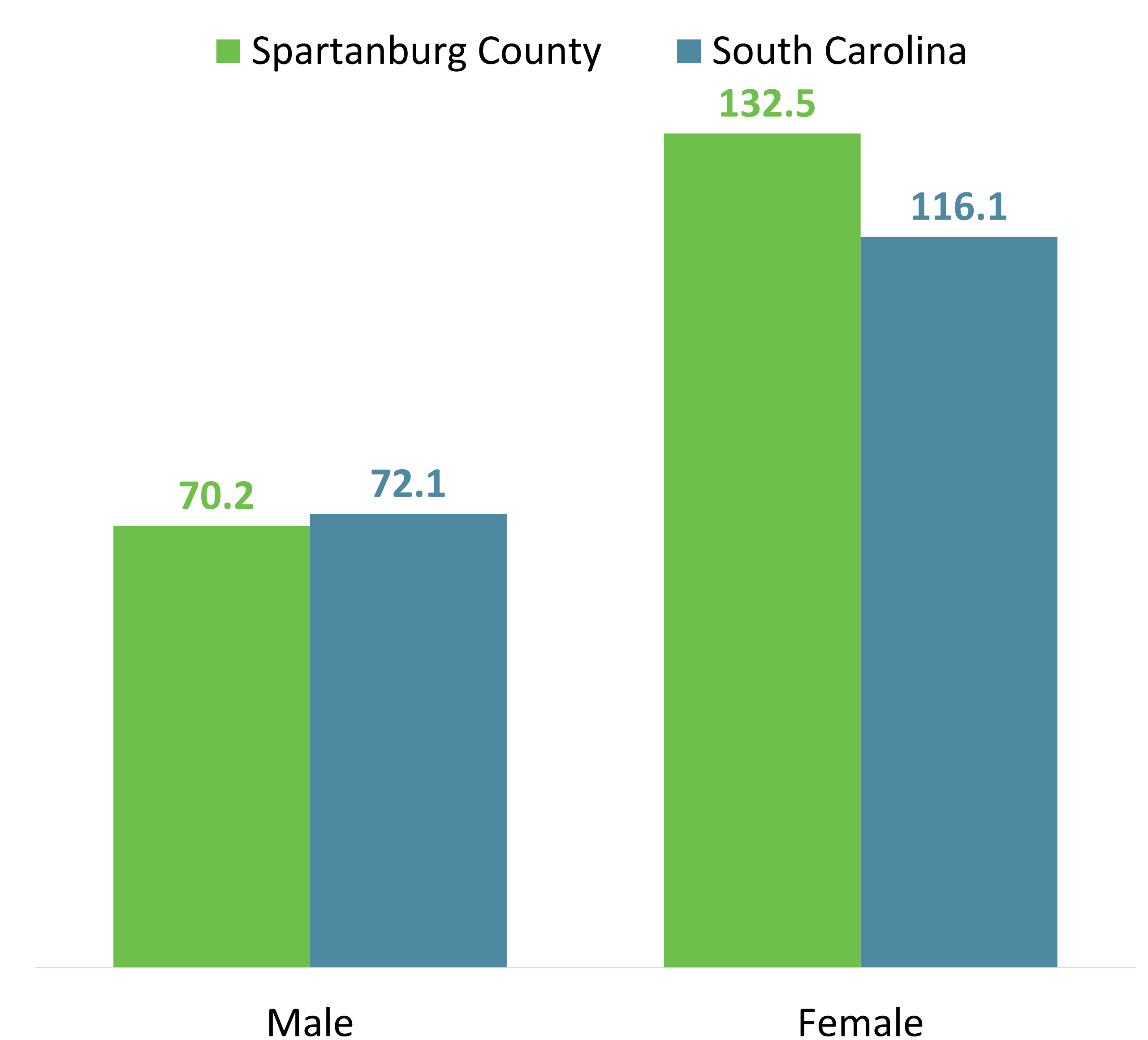

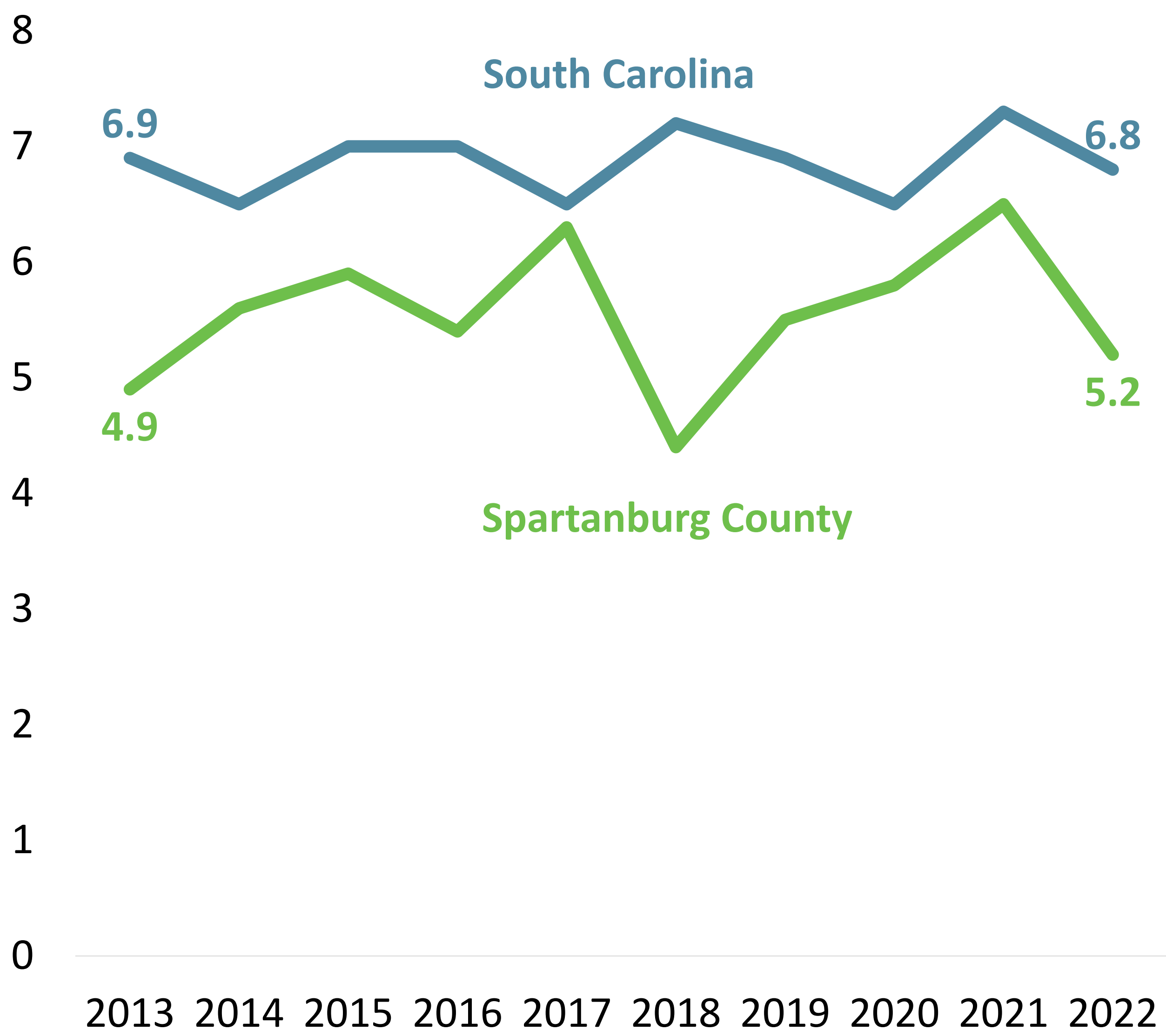

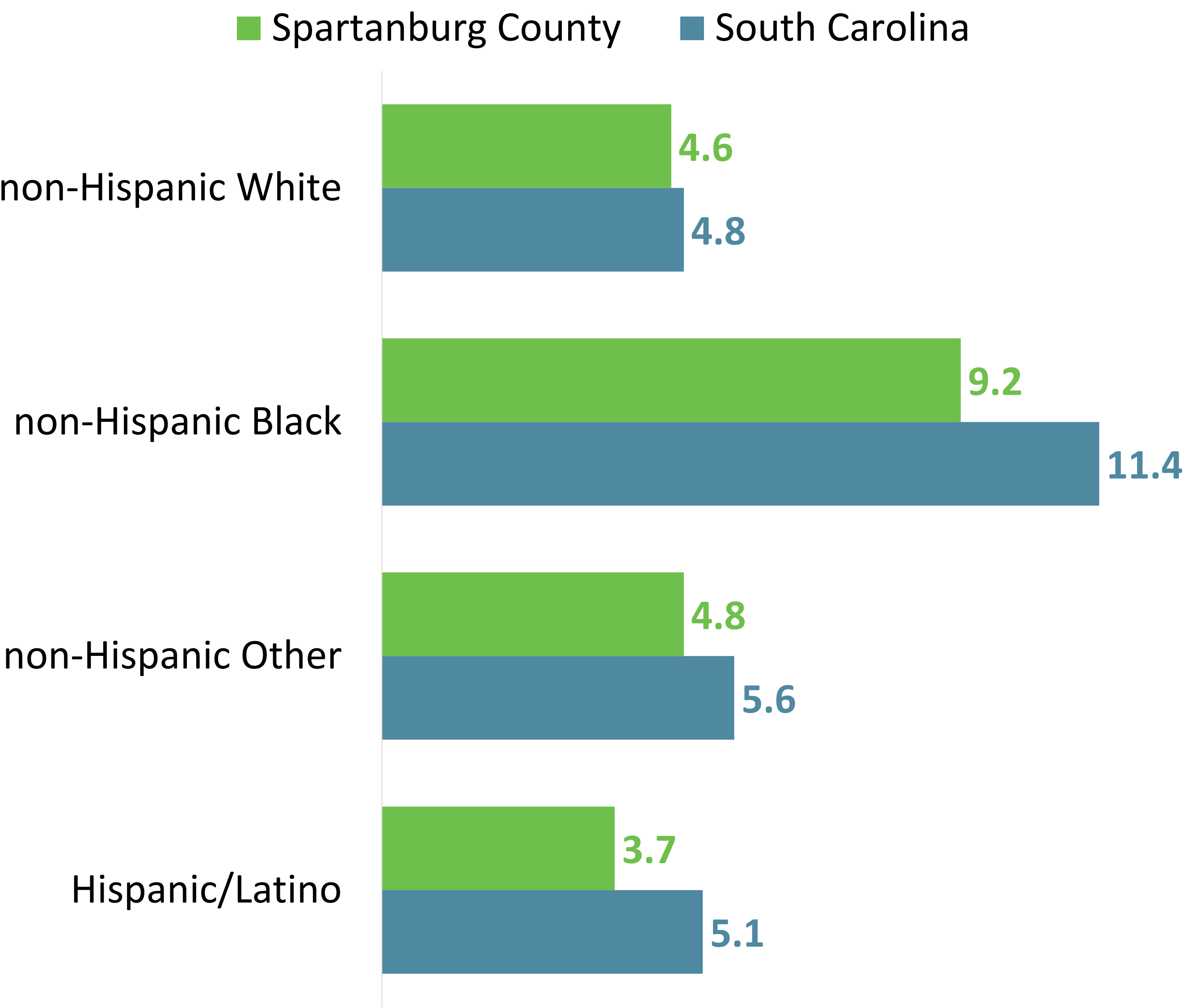

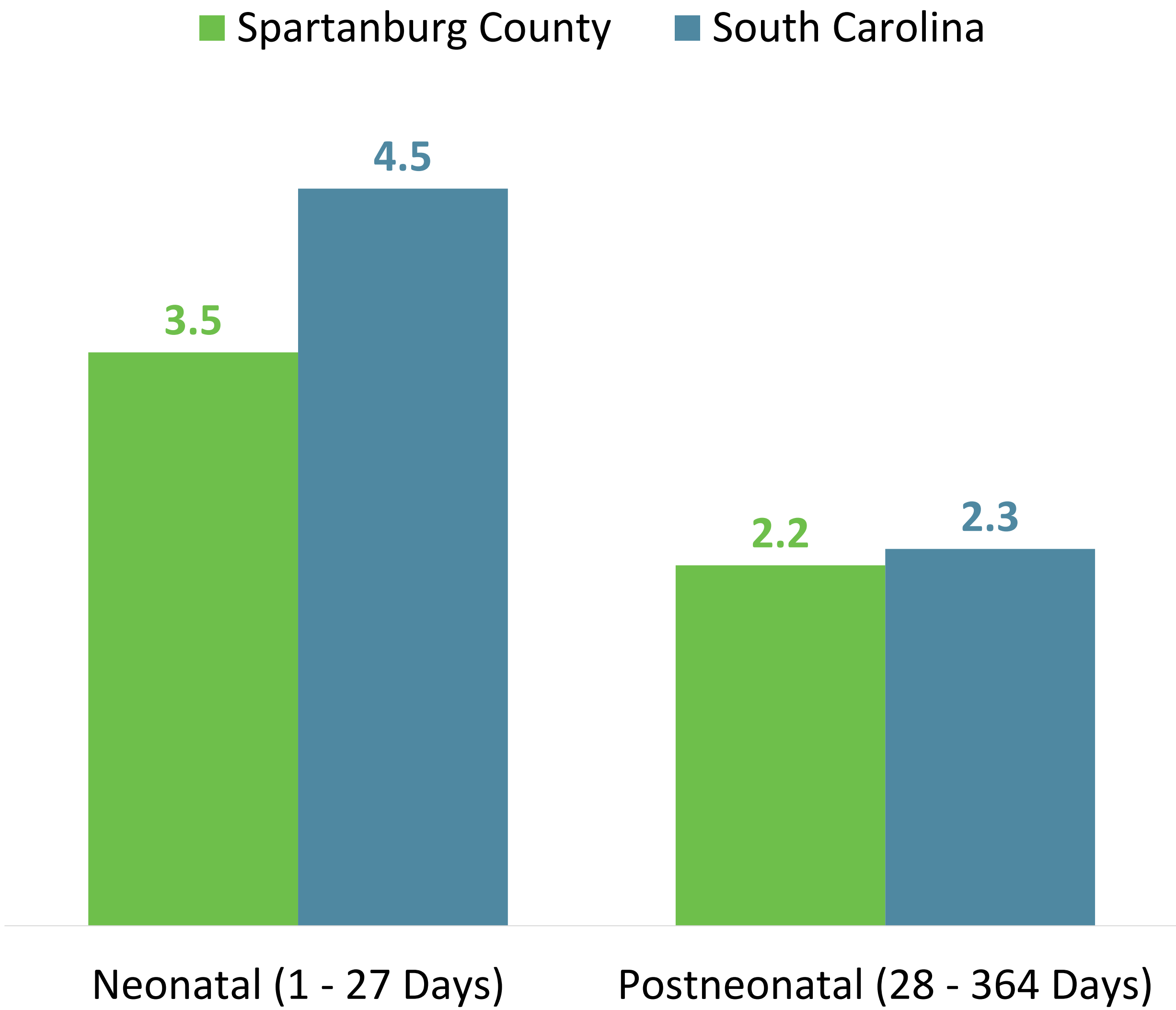

Five-Year Infant Mortality by Age of Infant at Death

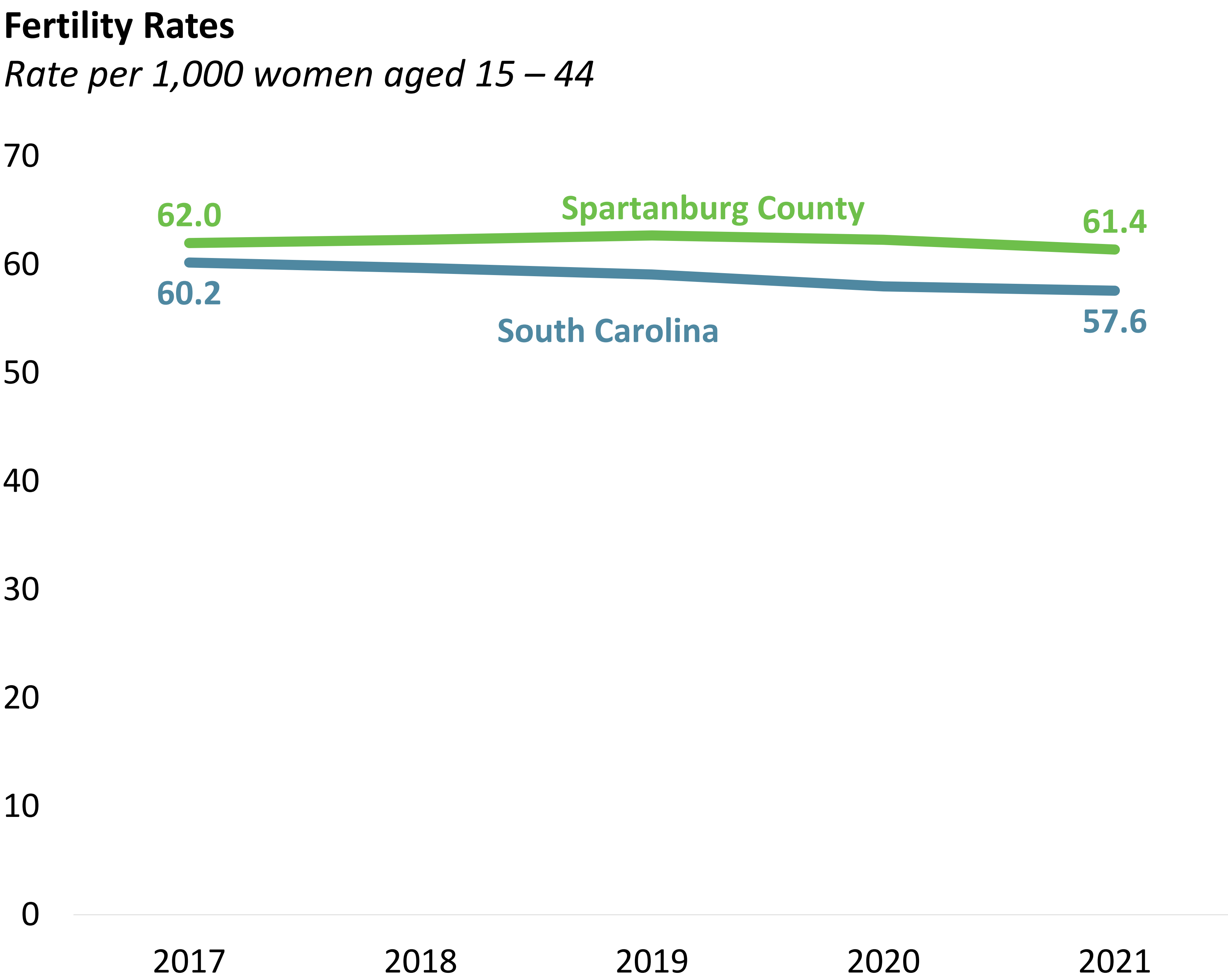

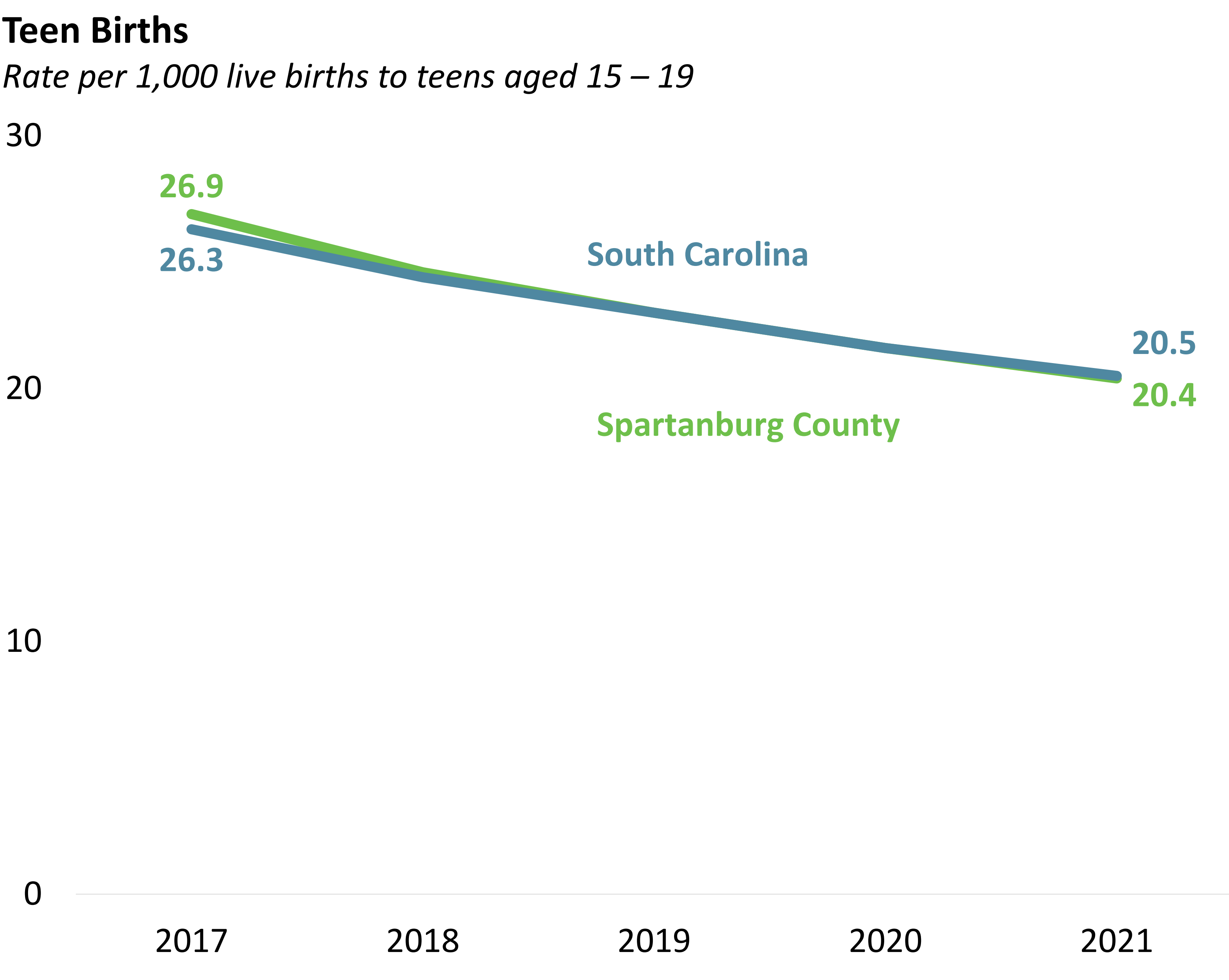

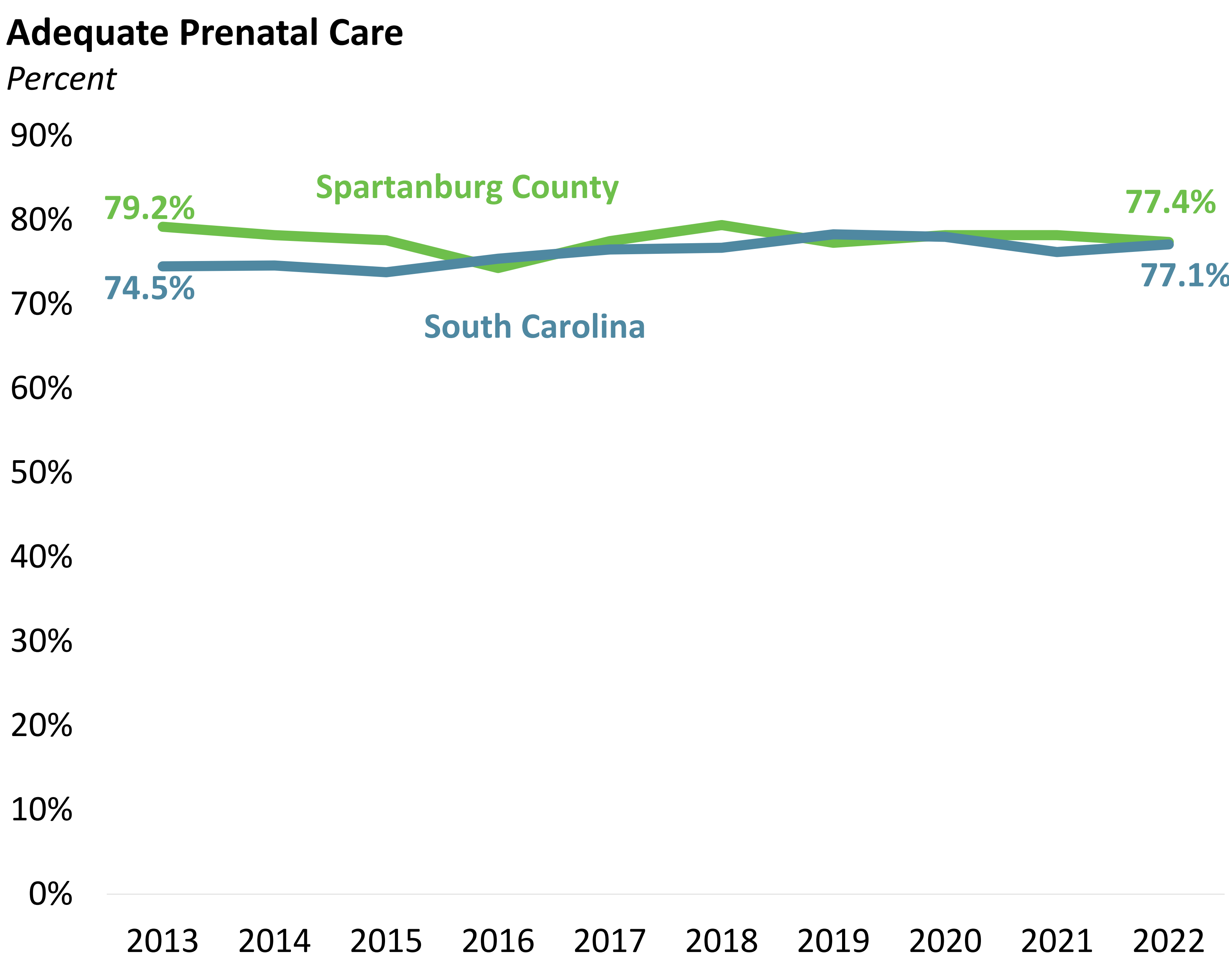

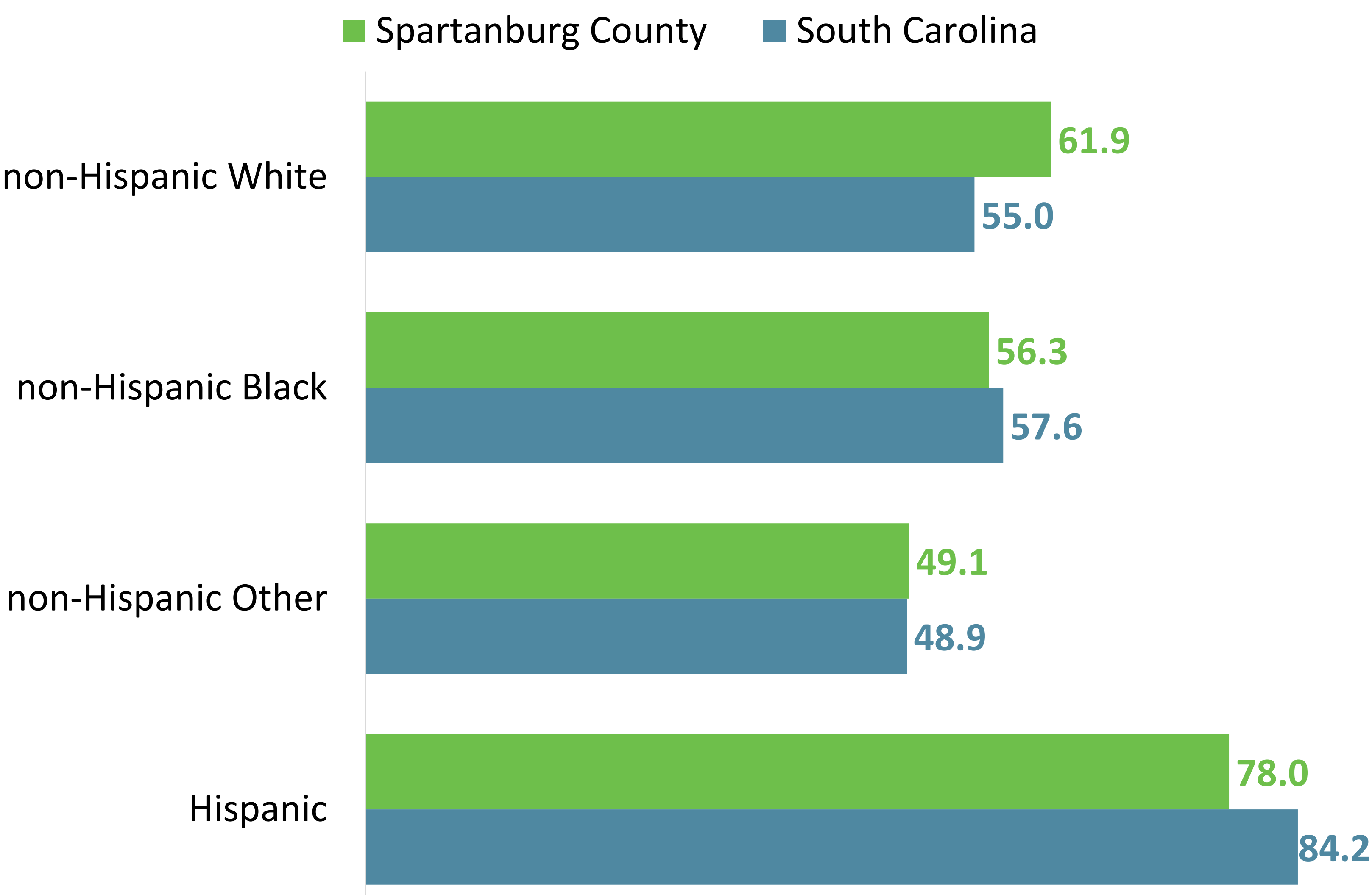

Fertility Rates, by Race/Ethnicity

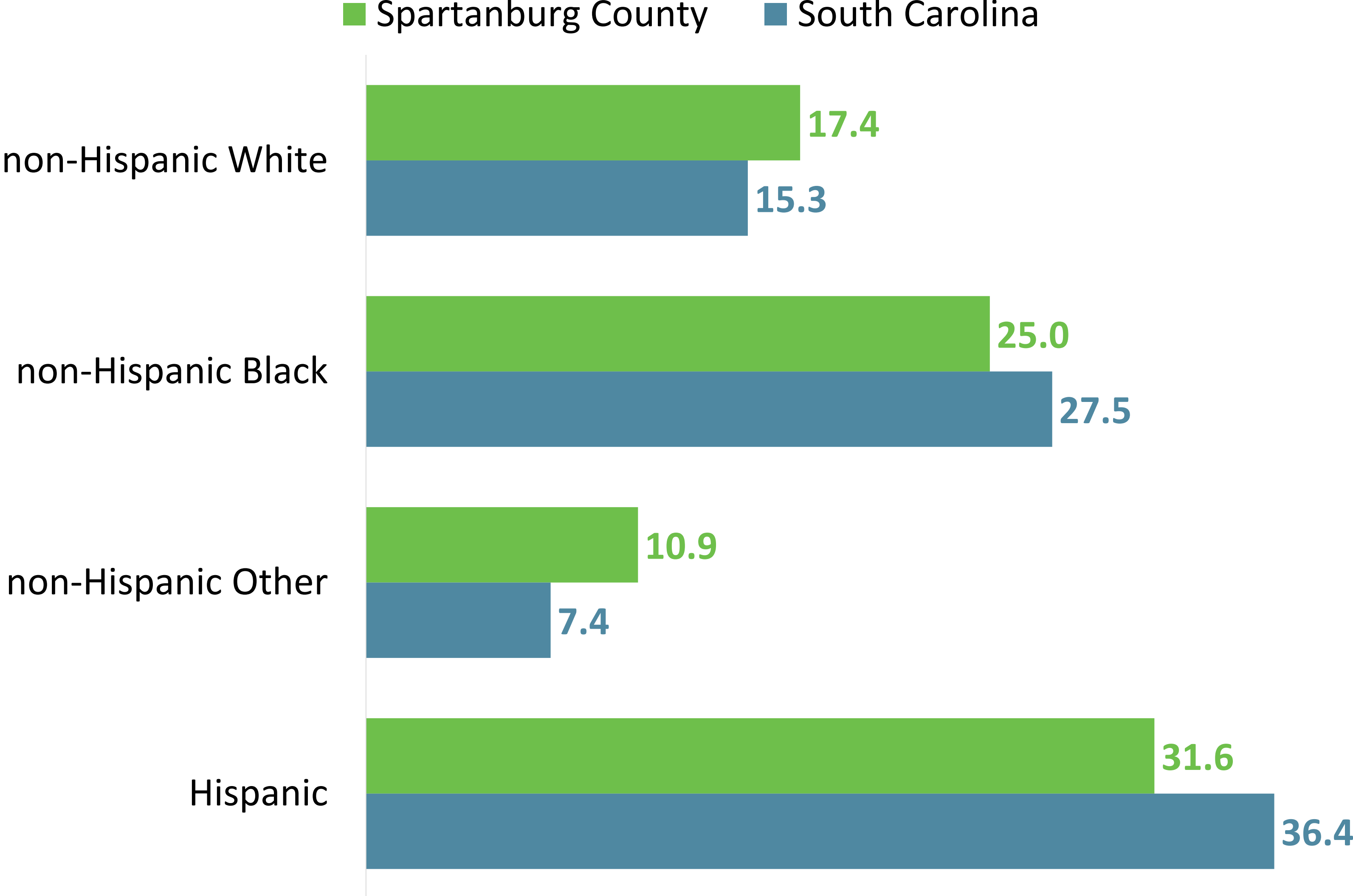

Teen Births, by Race/Ethnicity

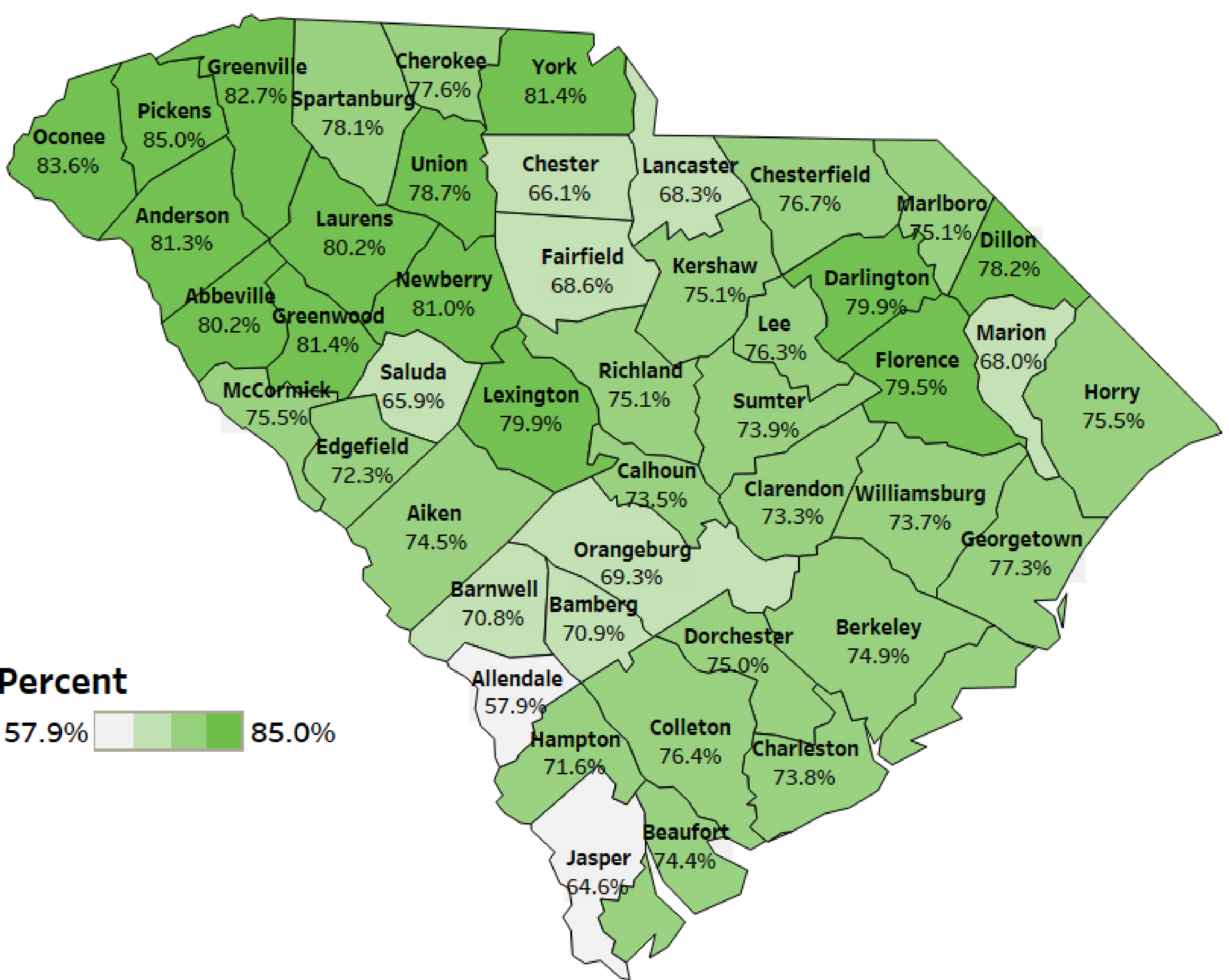

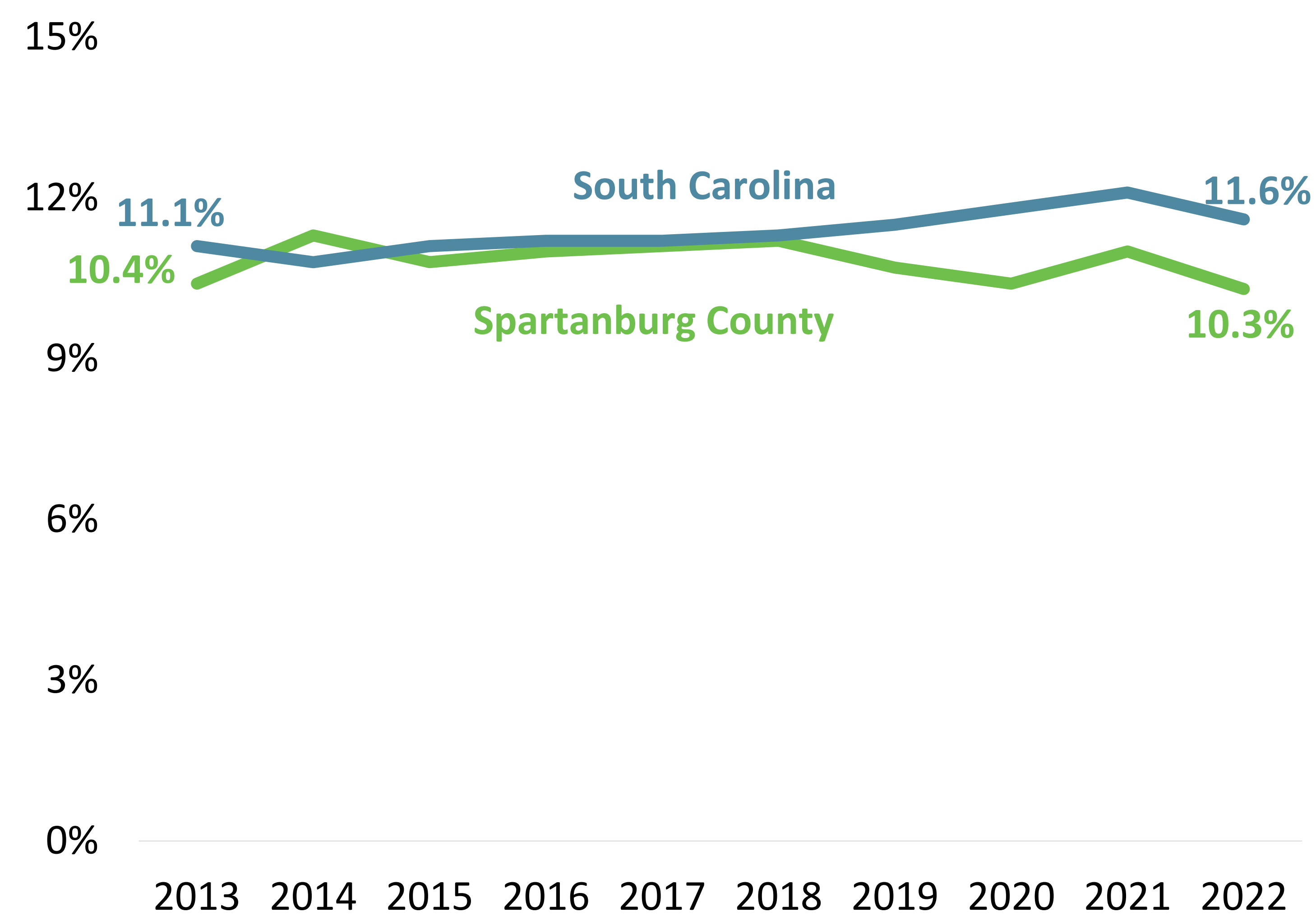

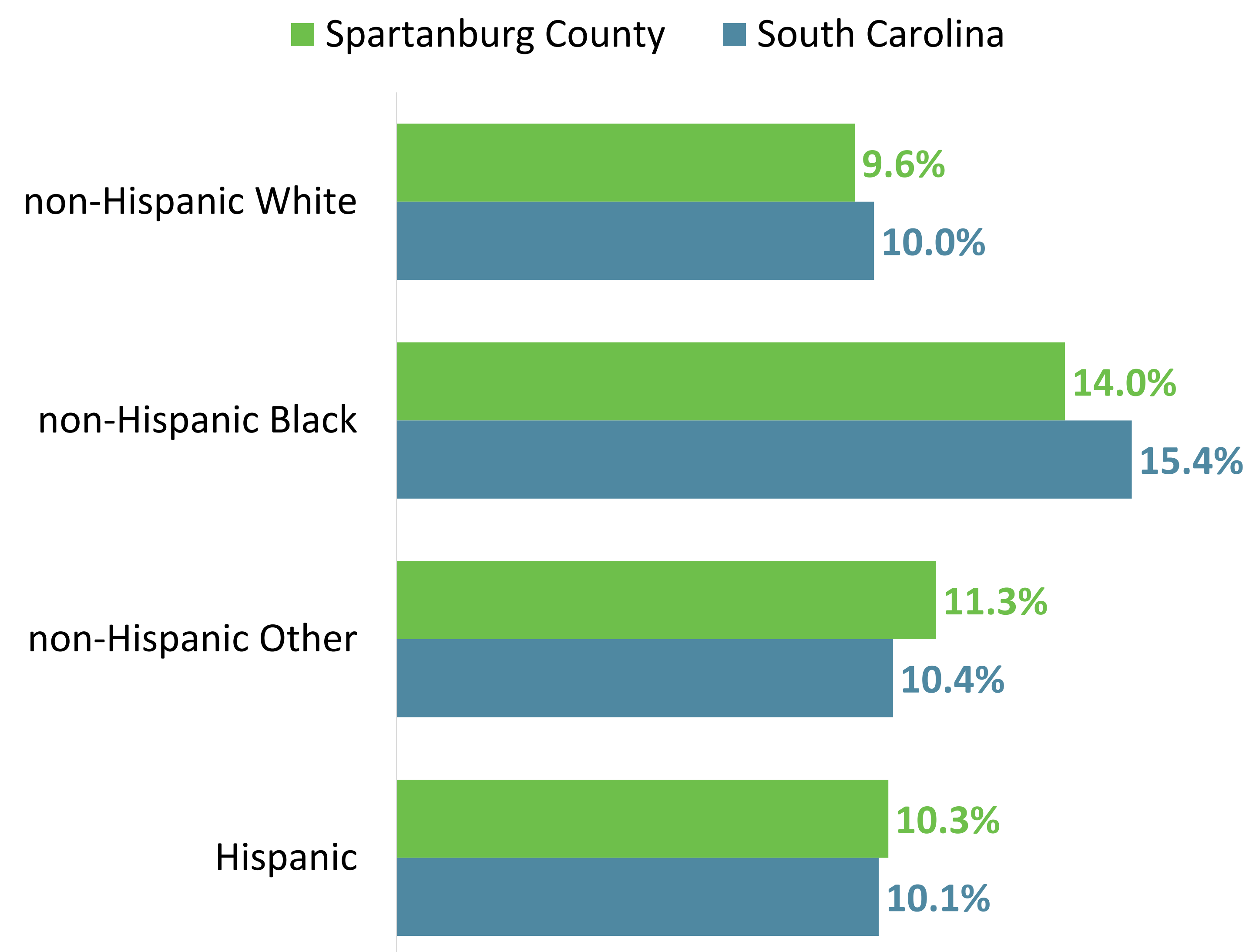

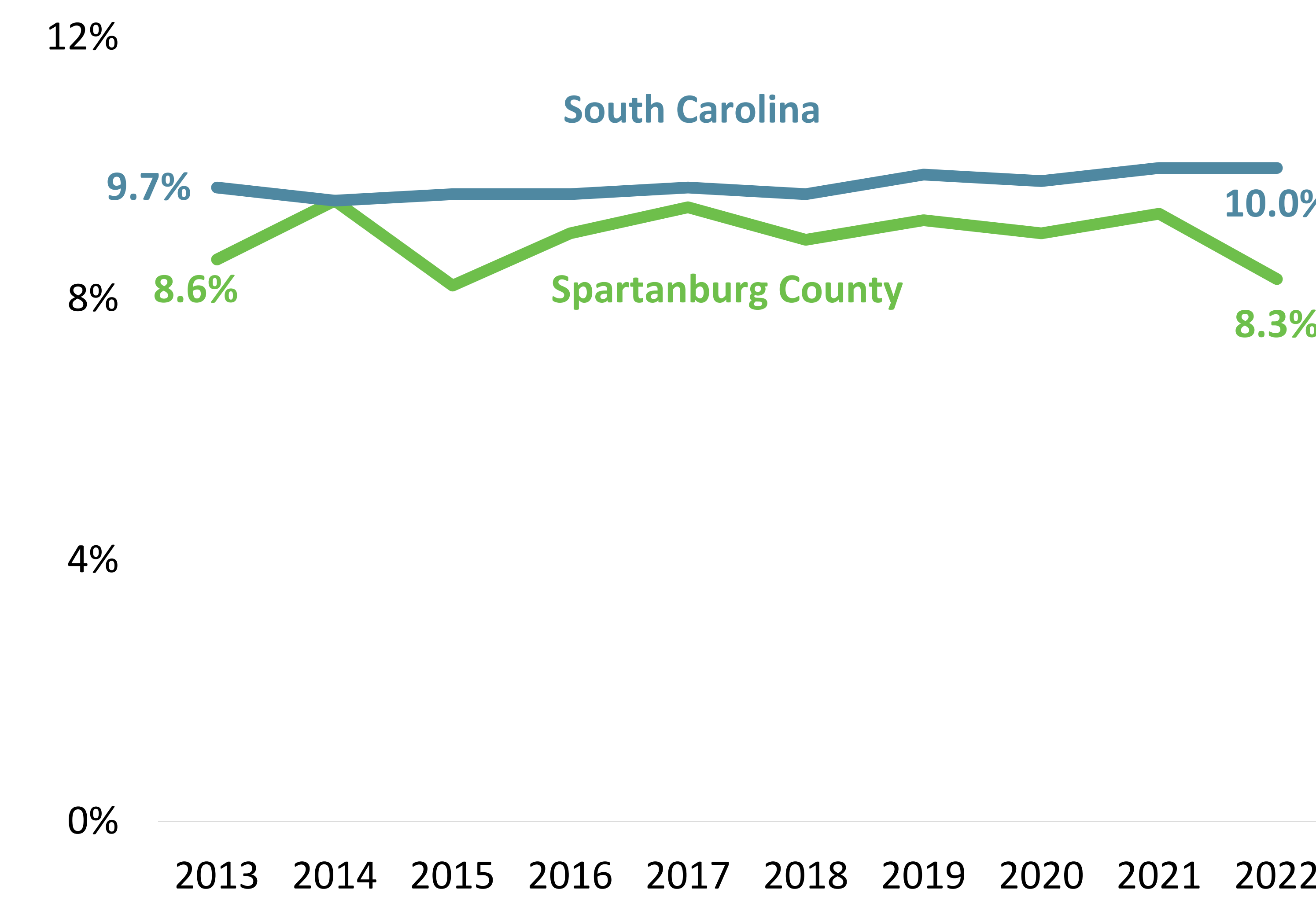

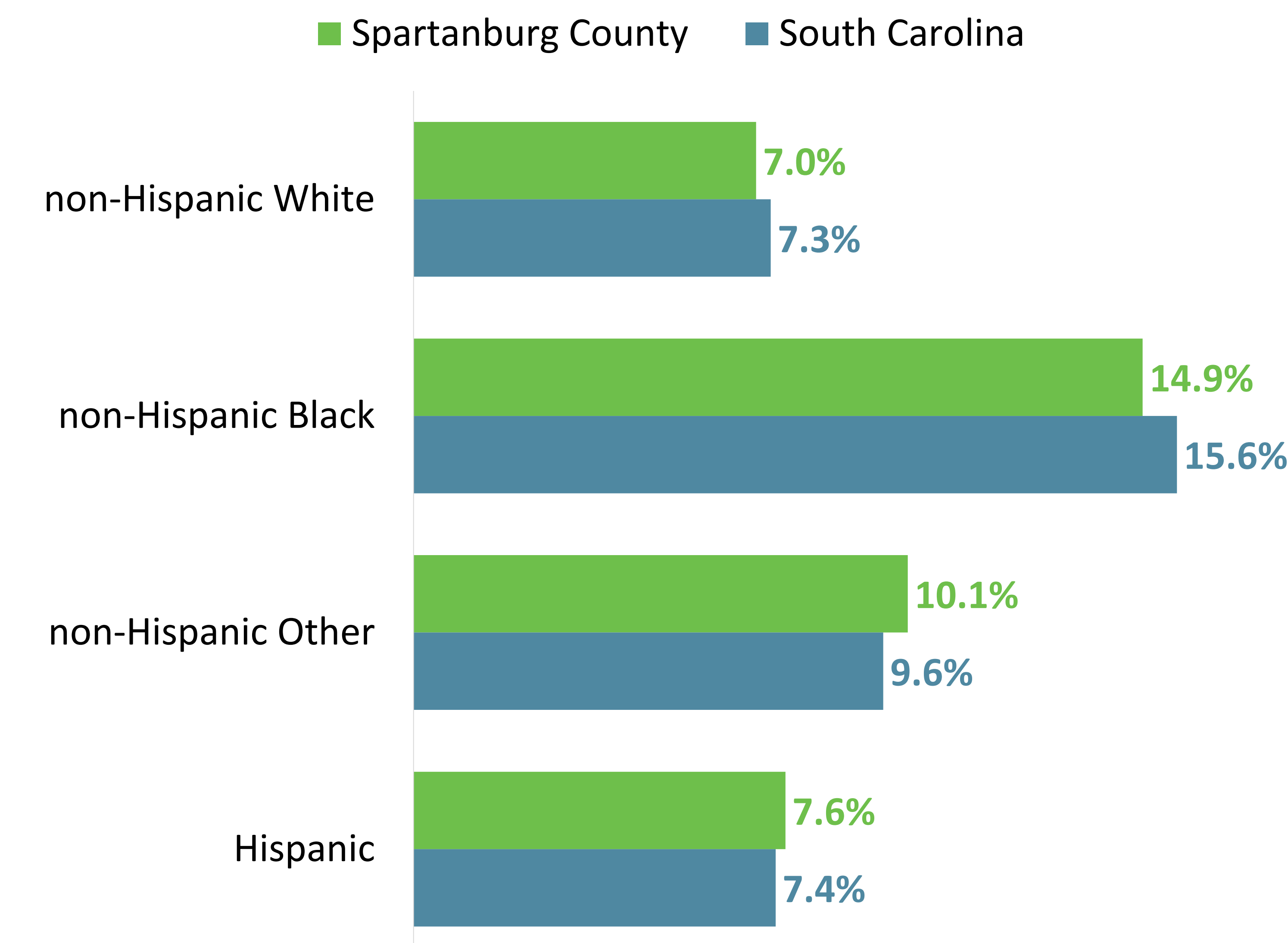

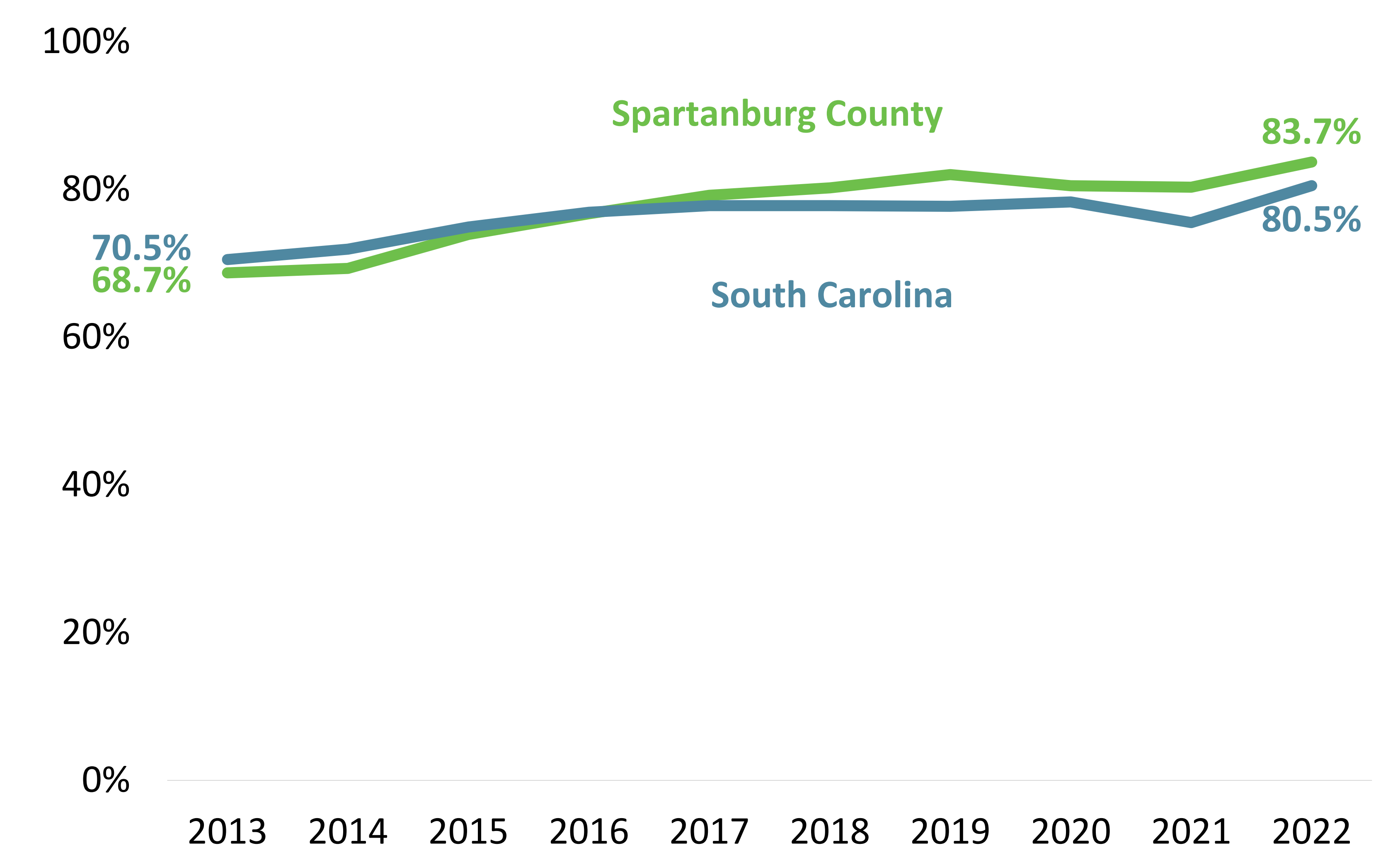

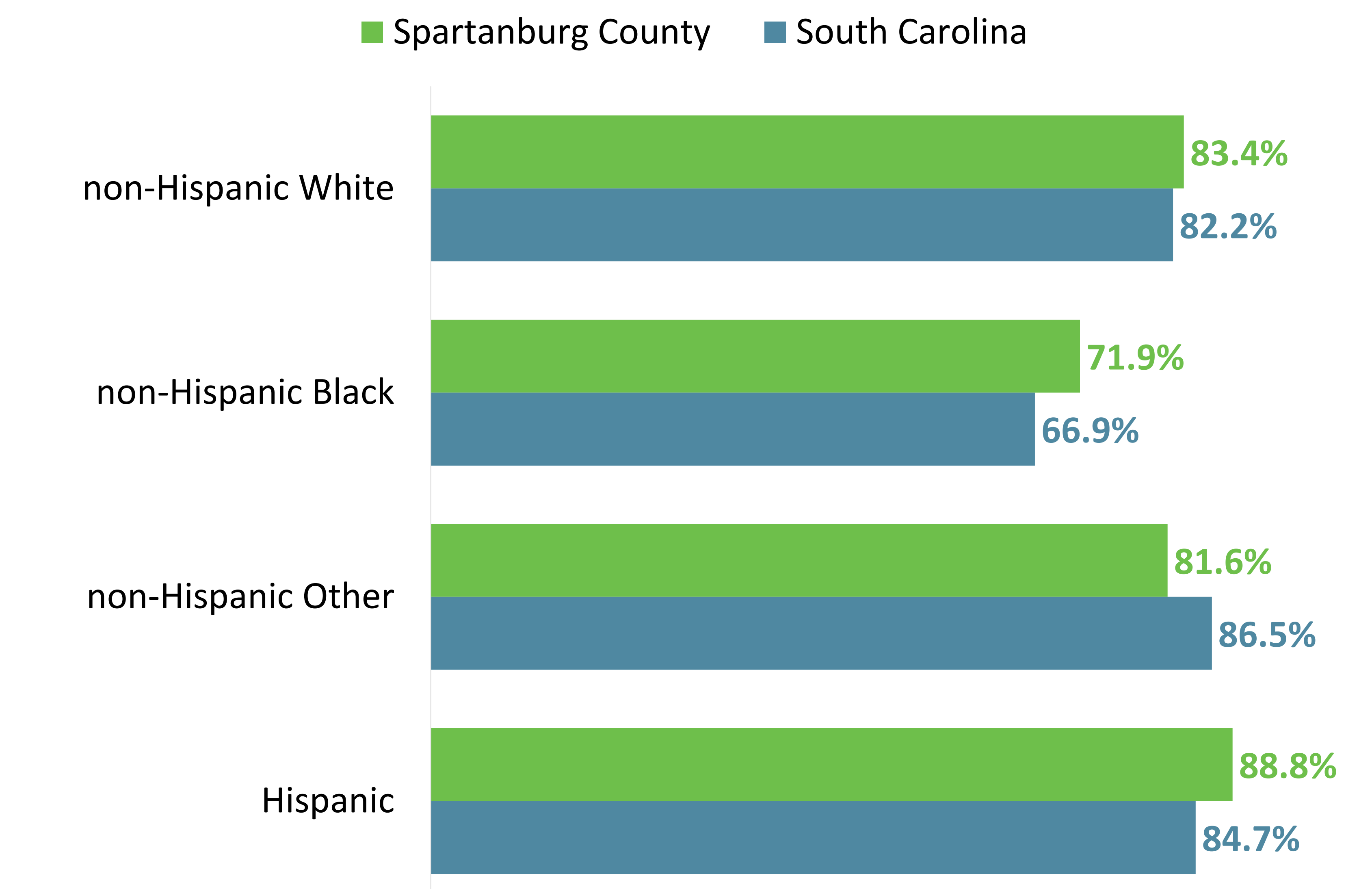

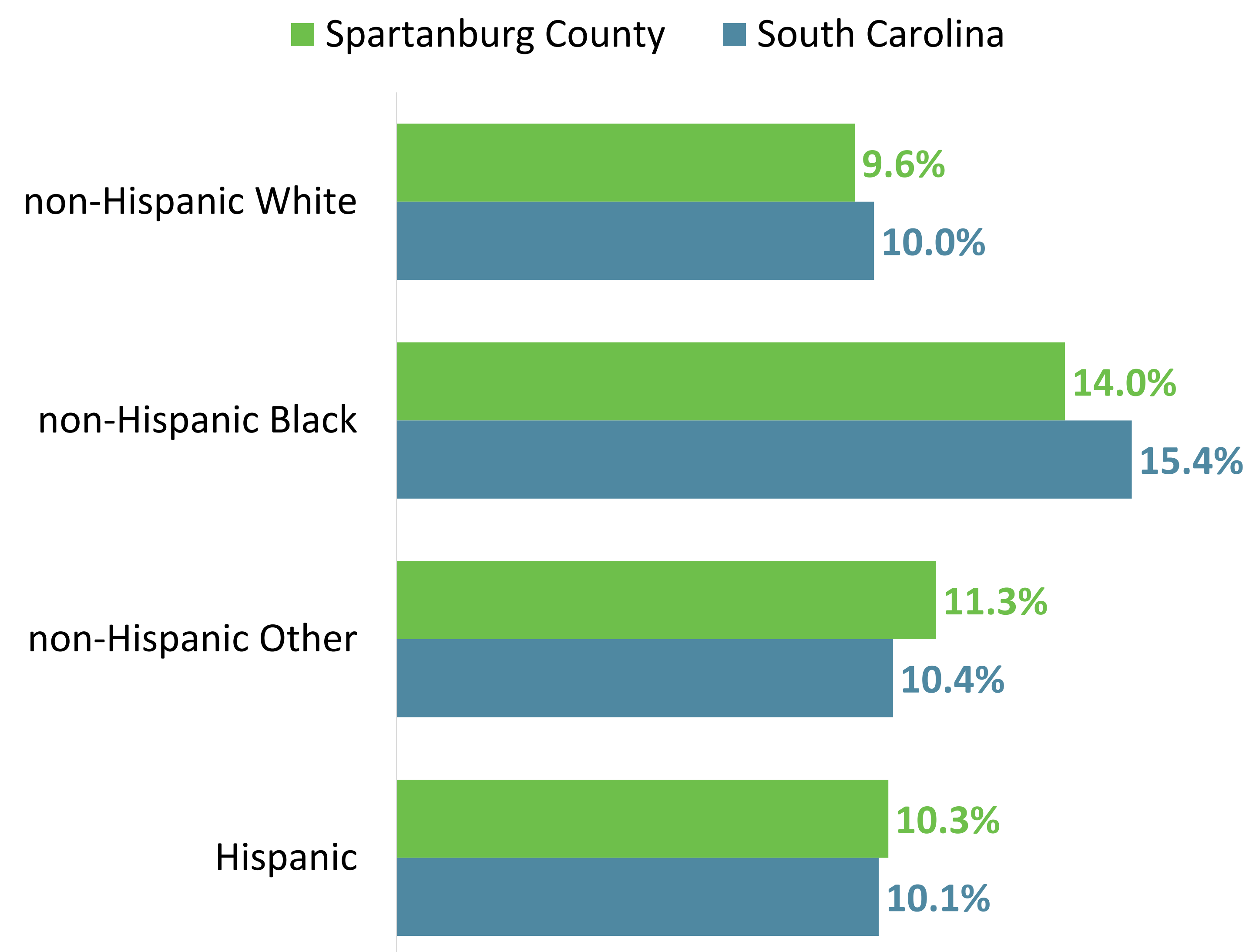

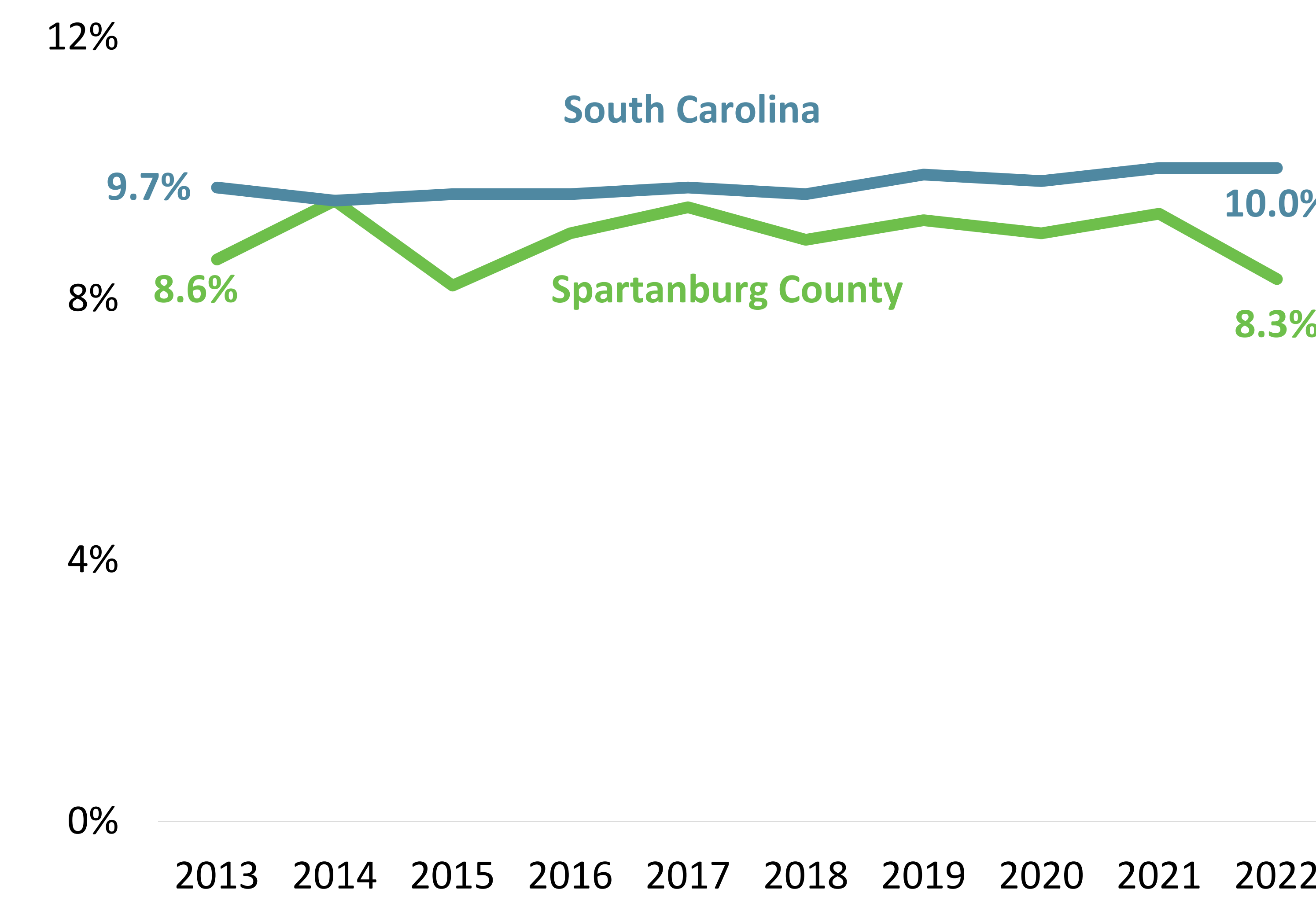

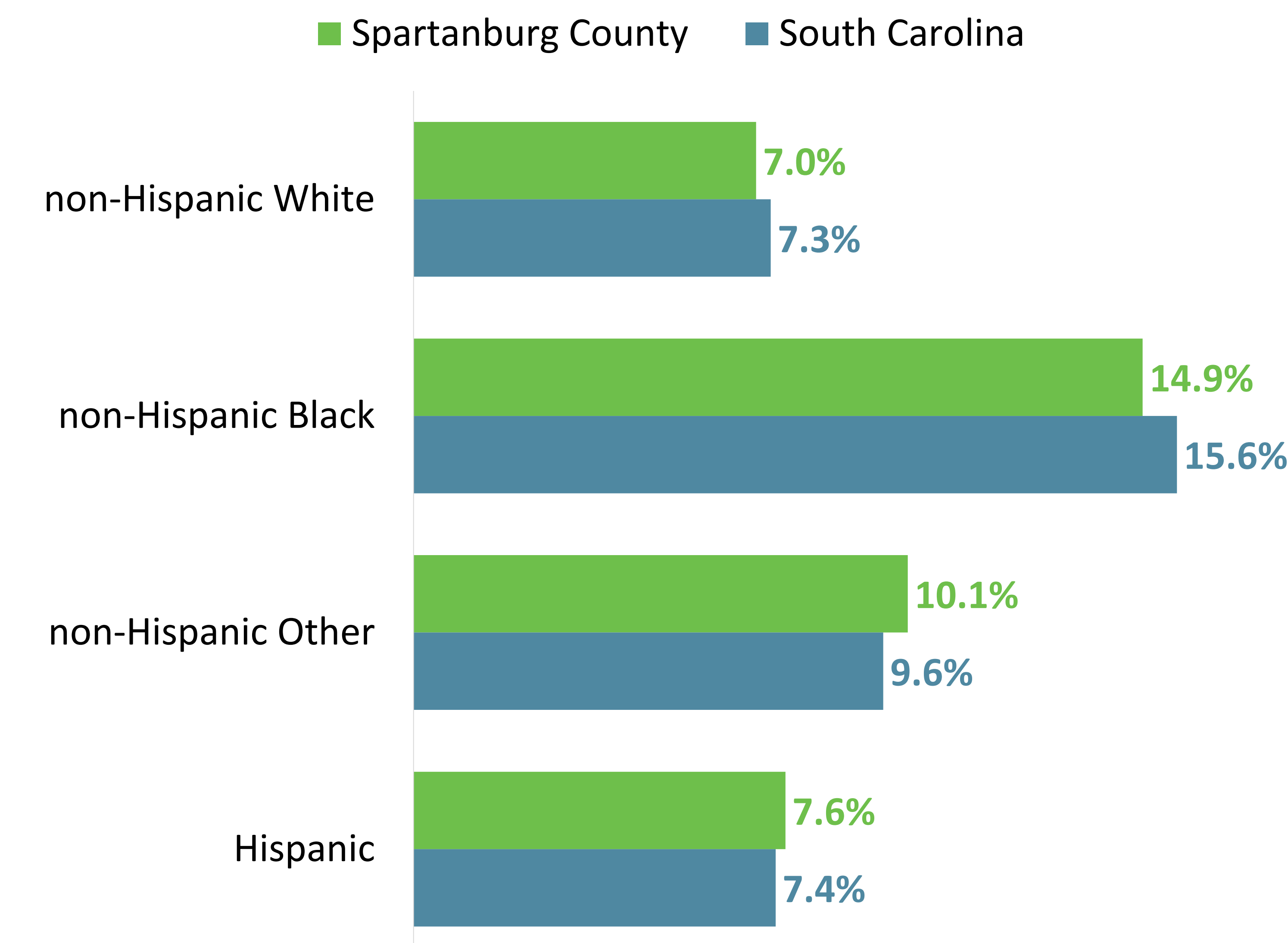

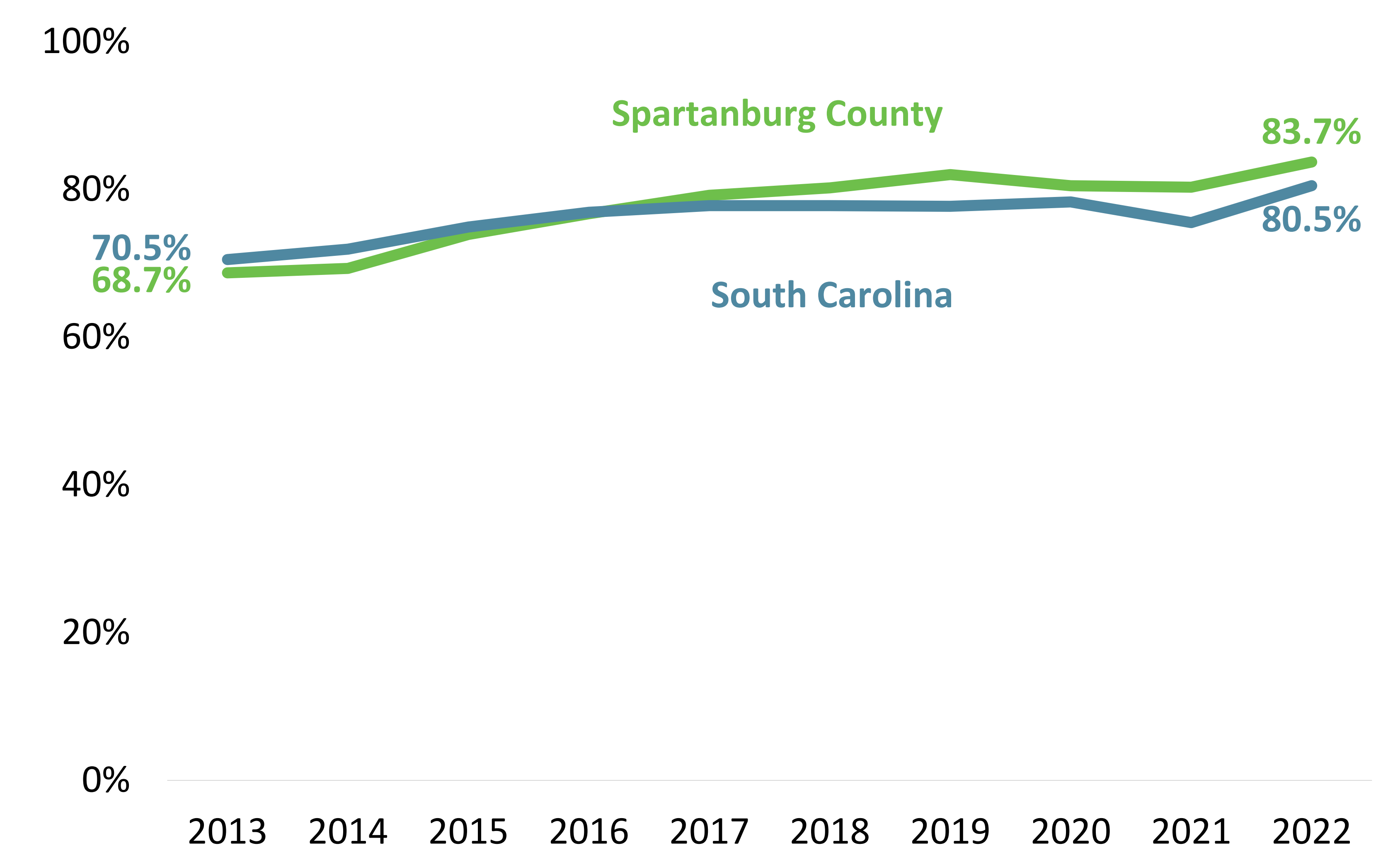

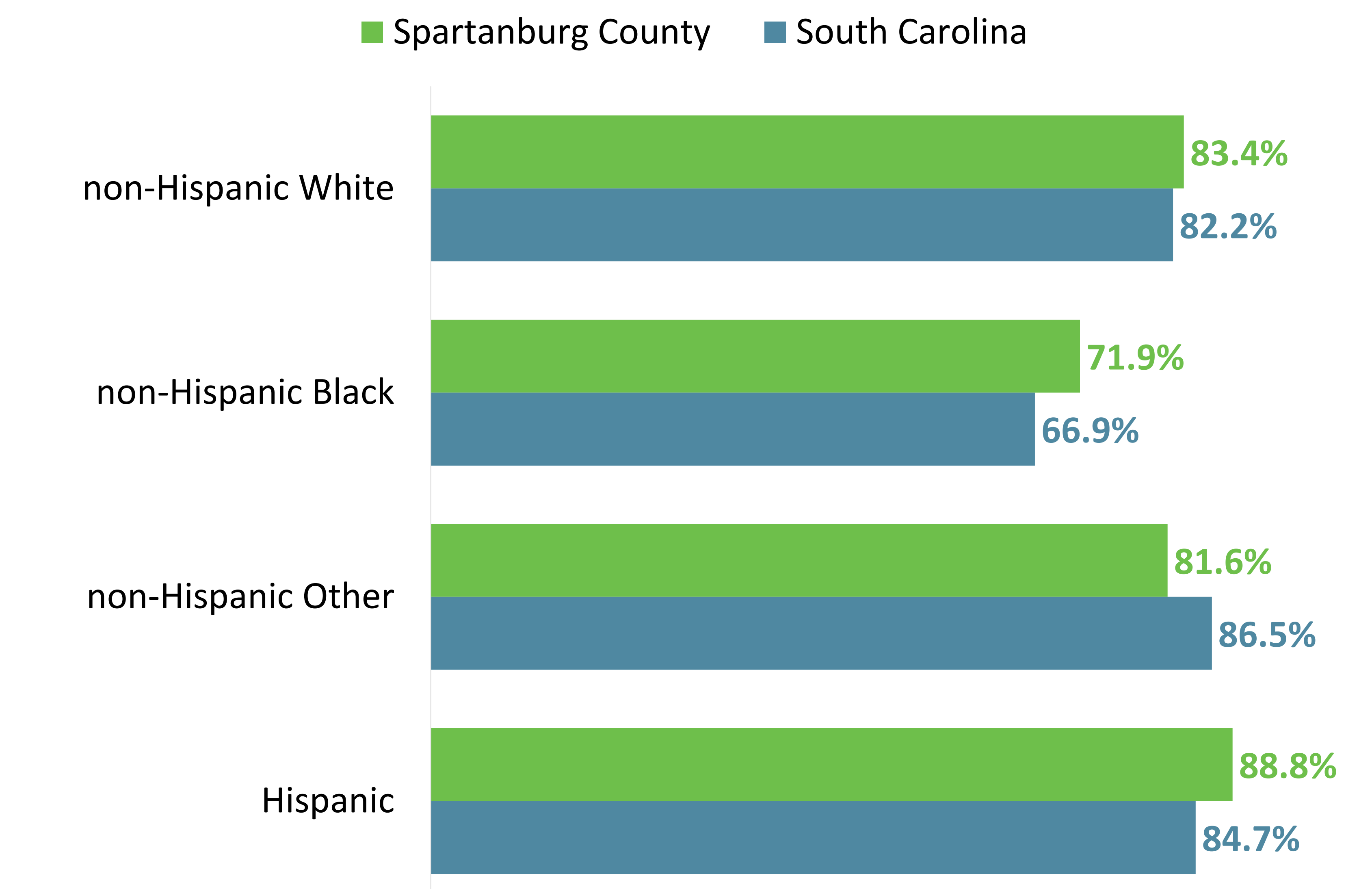
